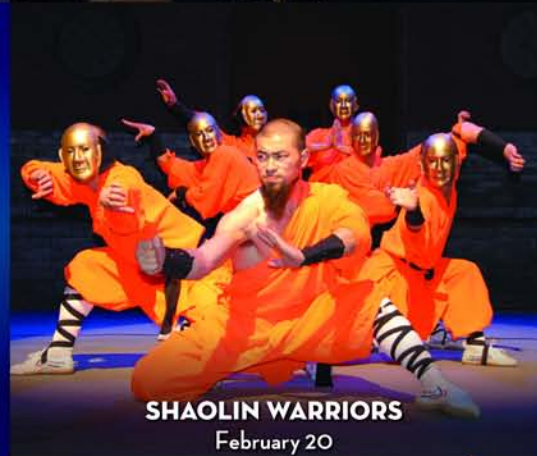

A Message from the General Manager

New Year, New Service

The beginning of a new year offers new opportunities to start afresh. One of our corporate resolutions is to strive to serve children better. In the last two decades, the status of children in our community has deteriorated. Approximately half are considered socioeconomically disadvantaged and qualify for free or reduced price meals at public schools. In many of these homes, free over-the-air TV is an educational lifeline.

More than a third of homes with children are "technology poor," with internet access only via a single shared smart phone. Alternatively, more than 40 percent live in a "technology rich" home with high-speed internet access, multiple desktop and tablet computers, and individual smartphones. As an educational nonprofit television service committed to serving ALL children with 21st century technology solutions, we have a challenge!

Our free over-the-air broadcasting services are remarkably effective. Nielsen data shows that Vegas PBS weekday children's programs command 73 percent of ALL local TV viewing between 8 a.m. and 4 p.m. in homes with a child aged 2-11. Talk about market share! Yet research also shows that children watch TV at all hours of the day. With so many parents working second and third shift in the 24-hour Las Vegas economy, a safe and educational place on TV for latchkey kids is essential.

I am thrilled to announce that Vegas PBS will launch VEGAS PBS KIDS, a 24-hour children's educational channel, on January 16. If you use an antenna, it will be channel 10.3 replacing Vme. It will be Cox Cable channel 113 and CenturyLink Prism channel 11. The service will also be streamed for internet and mobile device viewing. Although negotiations are ongoing, neither Direct TV or Dish will carry the service at its launch.

An important extension of the service will be a large number of enhanced interactive educational games for mobile devices, and parent engagement resources to assist parents in extending the lessons embedded in the TV programs. Through these new 24/7 services, Vegas PBS will help level the playing field for all children – making our educational content available to more Southern Nevada families than ever before, and giving parents (and grandparents or caregivers) more free opportunities to actively engage with their kids and the digital media they enjoy.

The academic success of ALL children is essential to the long-term strength of our community and our nation. That is why your annual financial support of free, over-the-air educational television is so important. As we enter the new year, your support will be delivering educational services in an even more impactful way through the nation's only free 24/7 educational service for families, allowing them to watch and learn together – anytime and anywhere.

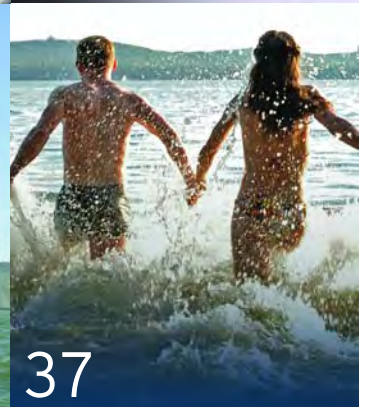

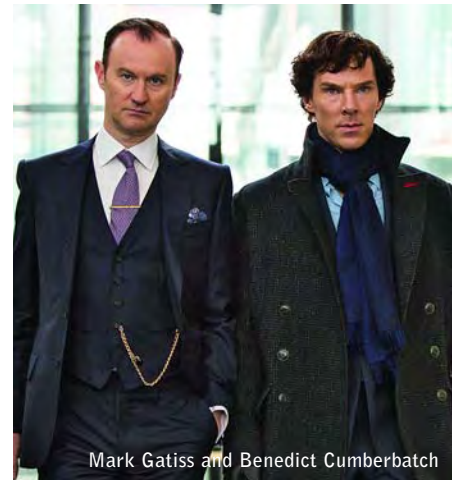

Secrets of Henry VIII's Palace

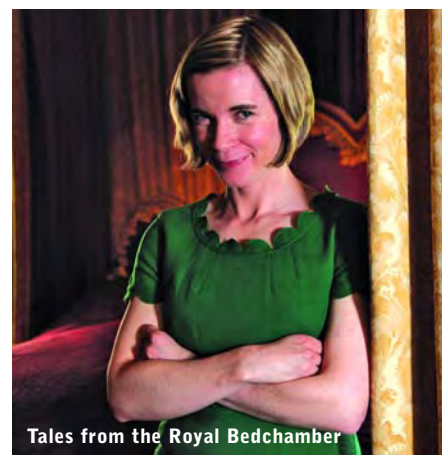
Sunday, January 29 at 1 p.m.

American Experience: The Assassination of Abraham Lincoln

On April 14, 1865, Abraham Lincoln was assassinated at Ford's Theatre in Washington, DC. Over the next twelve days, as a fractured nation mourned, the largest manhunt ever attempted closed in on his assassin: the twenty-six-year-old renowned actor John Wilkes Booth. This film features actor Will Patton (*A Mighty Heart*) as the voice of the assassin and is narrated by Academy Award-winning actor Chris Cooper (*Seabiscuit*). Interviews with the nation's foremost Lincoln scholars recount a great American drama: two tumultuous months when the joy of peace was shattered by the heartache of Lincoln's death.

Carole King: The Library of Congress Gershwin Prize In Performance at the White House

Friday, January 6 at 9 p.m.

Taped in the East Room of the White House, President and Mrs. Obama hosted the concert event in honor of singer-songwriter Carole King's receipt of the Library of Congress Gershwin Prize for Popular Song. King's career is unparalleled. To date, more than 400 of her compositions have been recorded by more than 1,000 artists. The evening includes performances by King, as well as by Gloria Estefan, Billy Joel, Jesse McCartney, Emeli Sandé, James Taylor and Trisha Yearwood. **Following at 10 p.m. is Carole King: American Masters.** Delve into King's extraordinary life and career with unseen and rare performances and home movies with a new, exclusive interview.

Great Performances: Bel Canto from Chicago Lyrics Opera

Friday, January 13 at 9 p.m.

This opera adaptation of Ann Patchett's best-selling novel is a gripping contempo-

rary story inspired by the hostage crisis in Lima, Peru. On December 16, 1996, the Túpac Amaru Revolutionary Movement took nearly 500 people hostage in the Japanese embassy and held 72 for more than four months. The hostages, of many nationalities, had been attending a party. Curated by Renée Fleming, the production features a score by the remarkable, young Peruvian composer Jimmy López and a libretto by Pulitzer Prize-winning playwright Nilo Cruz, and dramatizes the tensions and unexpected alliances that form between the terrorists and their hostages. Australian-born American soprano Danielle de Niese portrays the story's central figure, the fictional soprano Roxanne Coss, under the baton of Lyric music director Sir Andrew Davis with direction by Kevin Newbury.

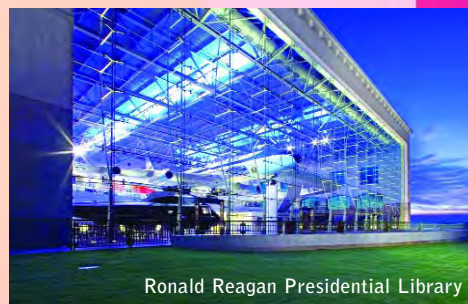

Nature: Snowbound: Animals of Winter

Think Wednesday

Every Wednesday Evening in January

Nature: Meet the Coywolf Wednesday, January 4 at 8 p.m.

The coywolf, a mixture of western coyote and eastern wolf, is a remarkable new hybrid carnivore that is taking over territories once roamed by wolves. Its appearance is very recent — within the last 90 years — in evolutionary terms, a blip in time. Beginning in Canada, the story of how it came to be is an extraordinary tale of how quickly adaptation and evolution can occur, especially when humans interfere. *Repeats Sunday, January 8 at 9 a.m.*

NOVA: Vampire Sky Tombs Wednesday, January 4 at 9 p.m.

A team of scientists and explorers probe high altitude caves in the Tibetan Himalayas looking for clues to how humans found their way into this forbidding landscape and adapted their bodies to survive. Along the way, they discover evidence of ritual burials, thousands of years old: skeletons, mummies and evidence of practices designed to ward off ancient vampires and even zombies. *Repeats Sunday, January 8 at 10 a.m.*

Secrets of the Dead: Vampire Legend Wednesday, January 4 at 10 p.m.

Follow scientists as they uncover "deviant" burials dating back to medieval England, pointing to a belief that the dead

could rise from their graves. Predating Eastern European legend, these discoveries force a re-examination of modern vampire lore.

Nature: Snowbound: Animals of Winter Wednesday, January 11 at 8 p.m.

Travel across the snow globe with wildlife cameraman Gordon Buchanan to meet animal survivors of winter, from the penguins of Antarctica to the Arctic fox and the bison of Yellowstone. Snow looks magical, but it's a harsh reality to these animals. *Repeats Sunday, January 15 at 9 a.m.*



Secrets of the Dead: Vampire Legend

NOVA: The Nuclear Option Wednesday, January 11 at 9 p.m.

Five years ago, an earthquake and tsunami triggered the unprecedented trio of melt-downs at the Fukushima Daiichi nuclear power plant. NOVA investigates how the inherent limitations of renewable energy sources and the optimism of a new generation of nuclear engineers is seeding a renaissance in nuclear technology, all while the most recent disaster is still being managed. What are the lessons learned from Fukushima? And how might we be able to build a safe nuclear future? *Repeats Sunday, January 15 at 10 a.m.*

Nature: Moose: Life of a Twig Eater Wednesday, January 18 at 8 p.m.

High up in Canada's Rockies, a moose is born. At the best of times, the odds are stacked against this leggy 35-pounder surviving its first year; less than half usually do, but now populations across many parts of North America are in steep decline. This stunningly intimate nature documentary takes viewers deep inside the world of moose to experience a mother's love and a calf's first year of life up, close and personal. *Repeats Sunday, January 22 at 9 a.m.*

Nature: A Sloth Named Velcro Wednesday, January 25 at 8 p.m.

Sloths, once largely ignored, have become a hot topic of scientific researchers. Sanctuaries and rehabilitation centers are also springing up, as development often displaces these gentle creatures. Filmed in Panama, Costa Rica and Colombia, this is a story of friendship between a journalist, the sloth she named Velcro and a network of people working to learn more about sloths in order to protect them. *Repeats Sunday, January 29 at 9 a.m.*

NOVA: Sunken Ship Rescue Wednesday, January 25 at 9 p.m.

Follow the epic operation to secure, raise and salvage the Costa Concordia cruise ship, which capsized off the coast of Italy on January 13, 2012, killing 32 people. The wreck stretches the length of three football fields and lies half submerged on the site of a protected reef, with a 160-foot-long hole in its hull. NOVA joins a team of more than 500 divers and engineers as they attempt the biggest ship recovery project in history. *Repeats Sunday, January 29 at 10 a.m.*

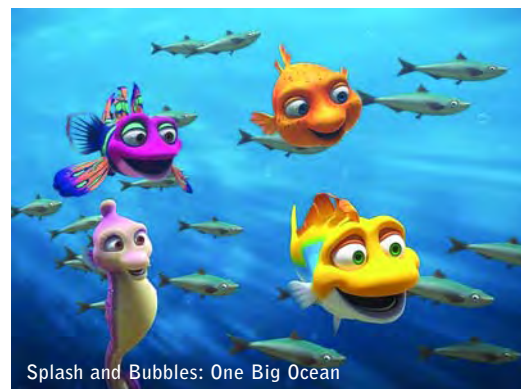
