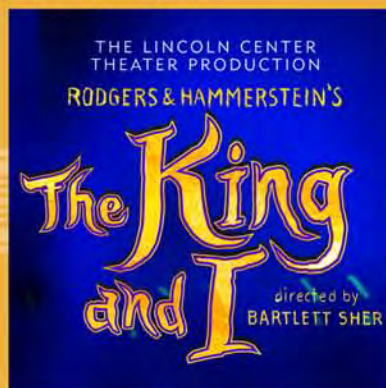

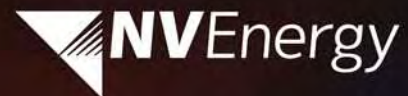

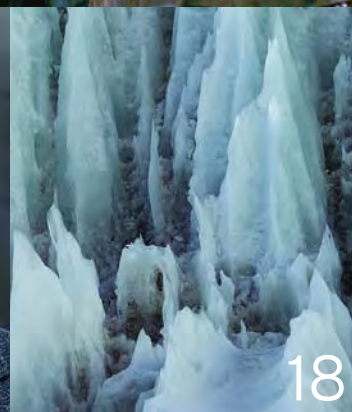

The Vietnam War

**Sundays through Thursdays,
September 17-28 at 8 p.m.**

Vegas PBS brings to you epic programming that you cannot find anywhere else on television, and this month is no exception. After months of anticipation, we are proud to present the story of one of the most consequential, divisive and controversial events in American history.

This landmark series is a 10 part, 18-hour documentary film series directed by Ken Burns and Lynn Novick. An immersive 360-degree narrative, the series tells the story of the Vietnam War as it has never before been told on film. It features testimony from nearly 80 witnesses, including many Americans who fought in the war and others who opposed it, as well as Vietnamese combatants and civilians from both the winning and losing sides.

Ten years in the making, the film brings the war and the chaotic epoch it encompassed viscerally to life. It includes rarely seen, digitally re-mastered archival footage from sources around the globe, photographs taken by some of the most celebrated photojournalists of the 20th century, historic television broadcasts, evocative home movies and revelatory audio recordings from inside the Kennedy, Johnson and Nixon administrations.

"The Vietnam War was a decade of agony that took the lives of more than 58,000

Americans," Burns said. "Not since the Civil War have we as a country been so torn apart. There wasn't an American alive then who wasn't affected in some way — from those who fought and sacrificed in the war, to fam-

ilies of service members and POWs, to those who protested the war in open conflict with their government and fellow citizens. More than 40 years after it ended, we can't forget Vietnam, and we are still arguing about why it went wrong, who was to blame and whether it was all worth it."

"We are all searching for some meaning in this terrible tragedy," Novick said. "In addition to dozens of Americans who shared their stories, we interviewed many Vietnamese on both the winning and losing sides, and were surprised to learn that the war remains as painful and unresolved for them as it is for us."

Featured in this special is new, original music written and recorded by Academy Award-winning composers Trent Reznor and Atticus Ross, along with new music arranged and performed by Grammy Award-winning cellist Yo-Yo Ma and The Silk Road Ensemble. The series also includes more than 120 popular songs that define the era, including tracks from The Beatles, The Rolling Stones, Bob Dylan, Jimi Hendrix, Simon & Garfunkel, Janis Joplin, Buffalo Springfield, Otis Redding, Santana, Joni Mitchell, The Temptations, Booker T. and the M.G.s, Pete Seeger and more.

EPISODES:

Déjà Vu (1858-1961)

Sunday, September 17 at 8 p.m.

After a long and brutal war, Vietnamese revolutionaries led by Ho Chi Minh end nearly a century of French colonial occupation. With the Cold War intensifying, Vietnam is divided in two at Geneva. Communists in the north aim to reunify the country, while America supports Ngo Dinh Diem's untested regime in the south.

Riding the Tiger (1961-1963)

Monday, September 18 at 8 p.m.

President Kennedy inspires idealistic young Americans to serve their country and wrestles with how deeply to get involved in South Vietnam. As the increasingly autocratic Diem regime faces a growing communist insurgency and widespread Buddhist protests, a grave political crisis unfolds.

The River Styx

(January 1964-December 1965)

Tuesday, September 19 at 8 p.m.

With South Vietnam in chaos, hardliners in Hanoi seize the initiative and send combat troops to the south, accelerating the insurgency. Fearing Saigon's collapse, President Johnson escalates America's military commitment, authorizing sustained bombing of the north and deploying ground troops in the south.

Resolve

(January 1966-June 1967)

Wednesday, September 20 at 8 p.m.

Defying American airpower, North Vietnamese troops and materiel stream down the Ho Chi Minh Trail into the south, while Saigon struggles to "pacify the countryside." As an antiwar movement builds back home, hundreds of thousands of soldiers and Marines discover that the war they are being asked to fight in Vietnam is nothing like their fathers' war.

This Is What We Do

(July 1967-December 1967)

Thursday, September 21 at 8 p.m.

American casualties and enemy body counts mount as Marines face deadly North Vietnamese ambushes and artillery south of the DMZ and Army units chase an elusive enemy in the central highlands. Hanoi lays plans for a massive surprise offensive, and

the Johnson Administration reassures the American public that victory is in sight.

Things Fall Apart

(January 1968-July 1968)

Sunday, September 24 at 8 p.m.

On the eve of the Tet holiday, North Vietnamese and Viet Cong forces launch surprise attacks on cities and military bases throughout the south, suffering devastating losses but casting grave doubt on Johnson's promise that there is "light at the end of the tunnel." The president decides not to run again and the country is staggered by assassinations and unrest.

The Veneer of Civilization

(June 1968-May 1969)

Monday, September 25 at 8 p.m.

Public support for the war declines, and American men of draft age face difficult decisions and wrenching moral choices. After police battle with demonstrators in the streets of Chicago, Richard Nixon wins the presidency, promising law and order at home and peace overseas. In Vietnam, the war goes on and soldiers on all sides witness terrible savagery and unflinching courage.

The History of the World (April 1969-May 1970)

Tuesday, September 26 at 8 p.m.

With morale plummeting in Vietnam, President Nixon begins withdrawing American troops. As news breaks of an unthinkable massacre committed by American soldiers, the public debates the rectitude of the war, while an incursion into Cambodia reignites antiwar protests with tragic consequences.

A Disrespectful Loyalty (May 1970-March 1973)

Wednesday, September 27 at 8 p.m.

South Vietnamese forces fighting on their own in Laos suffer a terrible defeat. Massive U.S. airpower makes the difference in halting an unprecedented North Vietnamese offensive. After being re-elected in a landslide, Nixon announces Hanoi has agreed to a peace deal. American prisoners of war will finally come home — to a bitterly divided country.

The Weight of Memory (March 1973-Onward)

Thursday, September 28 at 8 p.m.

While the Watergate scandal rivets Americans' attention and forces President Nixon to resign, the Vietnamese continue to savage one another in a brutal civil war. When hundreds of thousands of North Vietnamese troops pour into the south, Saigon descends rapidly into chaos and collapses. For the next 40 years, Americans and Vietnamese from all sides search for healing and reconciliation.

Join Lily as she journeys back to Saigon (Ho Chi Minh City) to check out the vibrant youth culture of the city where she was born and discovers surprising U.S./Vietnamese cultural connections in fashion, food and more.

They Were Our Fathers

Sunday, September 17 at 7 p.m.

More than 20,000 American children lost their dads in Vietnam. This special shares their stories, as told by members of Sons and Daughters in Touch — a group

formed in 1990 to locate, unite and support Gold Star children who lost their fathers in service during the Vietnam War. They gathered in the nation's capital on Father's Day to honor their fathers, reflect on their common grief and support one another, like no one else can. Their stories serve as powerful testimonies about the true cost of war.

Peace Meals

**Friday, September 8 at 10:30 p.m.
and Sunday, September 24 at 11 a.m.**

The concept is simple: bring together a Vietnam Vet and a Vietnamese refugee who immigrated to the U.S. after the war for a simple meal and see where the conversation leads. Then do the same with young people who are a generation removed from the war.

The program helps build bridges between veterans and immigrant communities — who have sometimes had trouble connecting — and to shed light on the nature of citizenship, assimilation and what it means to be an American.

American Medevac

Sunday, September 24 at 11 p.m.

Meet the American wounded and the men of the 236th Army Medical Detachment who risked their lives to save them during the Vietnam War. Please see page 31 for details.

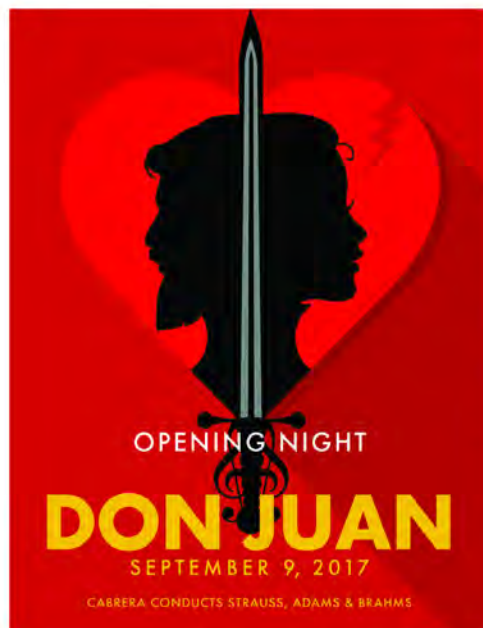
Stories of Service

The Story of the Jews with Simon Schama

Sunday, September 17 from 1 p.m. to 6 p.m.

Prize-winning author of 15 books and Emmy Award-winner Simon Schama brings to life Jewish history, traveling from Russia and the Ukraine to Egypt, Israel and Spain, exploring the imprint that Jewish culture has made on the world and the drama of suffering, resilience and rebirth that has gone with it. The five-part series will air back-to-back.

The film draws on primary sources that include the Elephantine papyri, a collection of 5th-century BC manuscripts illuminating the life of a town of Jewish soldiers and their families in ancient Egypt; the astonishing trove of documents—the Cairo Geniza—recording the world of the

medieval Jews of the Mediterranean and Near East; the records of disputations between Christians and Jews in Spain; correspondence between the leader of the Arab revolt during World War I, Emir Feisal, and the leader of the Zionist movement, Chaim Weizmann.

Schama talks about the turning points of the drama with living witnesses like Aviva Rahamim, who, as a 14-year-old, walked

across the Sudanese desert to try and reach Israel and Yakub Odeh, the Palestinian whose village was destroyed in the war of 1948. He debates the meaning of new archaeological discoveries of the Biblical period with Yosef Garfinkel of the Hebrew University and of the Dead Sea Scrolls with their chief curator Pnina Shor.

Schama brings together memory and actuality, past and present, sorrows and celebrations, vindications and challenges and makes felt the beating pulse of an epic of endurance that has been like no other—a story that belongs to everyone.

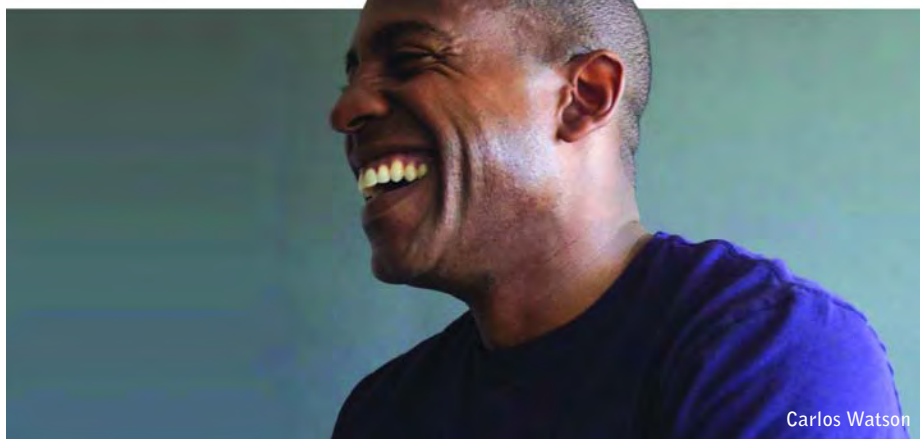

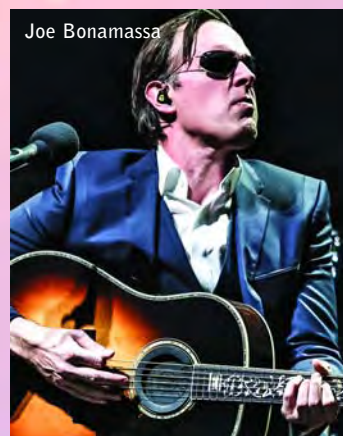

Attenborough's Zoo Quest in Colour

heard publicly, until now. Revisit the events of 9/11 from the perspective of those who were in Washington, DC, working at or near the Pentagon. Using exclusive first-person interviews with Pentagon personnel, first responders, aviation experts and journalists, as well as rarely seen Department of Defense footage taken from inside the Pentagon after the attack, the special tells the story of heroism and perseverance in the face of unimaginable, life-threatening obstacles.



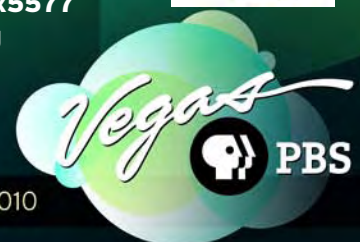

Vegas PBS has had a long tradition of airing documentaries about this country's military conflicts and telling the stories of those who have bravely served our country, including Nevada's own military service members.

In 2007, Vegas PBS produced **The Greatest Generation Goes to War – Las Vegas' Memories of World War II**. In 2015, Vegas PBS hired a full-time veterans coordinator to work with our local business partners, veterans service organizations, active service members and returning veterans and help connect them to career training and job placement services in our community. Over the last few years, we have also produced and aired local **Stories of Service** to honor those who have served as well as to inform and educate our community on the resources available for military families.

As we now mark 50 years since the end of the Vietnam War, new stories are being told. In preparation for the release of Ken Burns' new documentary **The Vietnam War** airing this month, Vegas PBS conducted several focus groups with our local Vietnam veterans to begin collecting their stories and to learn how else we can be of support.

Martin Luther: The Idea that Changed the World

Tuesday, September 12 at 8 p.m.

On October 31, 1517, a penniless monk named Martin Luther posted his now-famous diatribe denouncing the corruption of the medieval world's largest and most powerful institution. His forerunners had been burned alive for similar statements, but Luther had a new tool at his disposal—the recently invented printing press. This special chronicles the real life story of the seismic upheaval that rocked the western world in the early 1500s. Against all odds, a lonely outcast stood up to the world's dominant superpower—the Catholic Church—and won. Narrated by Hugh Bonneville (*Downton Abbey*), this docu-drama uses full-scale dramatizations to tell a great adventure story. With treacherous intrigue, outsized personalities and famous showdowns, it does not shy away from the darker side of Martin Luther's story.

More than 40 years ago, CBS News journalist Morton Dean and CBS News cameraman Greg Cooke flew a combat medevac mission in Vietnam that became their most haunting memory from two lifetimes in journalism. They could not forget the men they met that day — the American wounded and the men of the 236th Army Medical Detachment who risked their lives to save them. The story lasted just seven minutes on the CBS Evening News with Walter Cronkite. But for Dean and Cooke, decades later, the memories refused to fade, so they set out to find them and to tell the stories of their lives. The documentary embraces the bravery of the medevac crew and, by extension, all those who served their country during that controversial conflict.

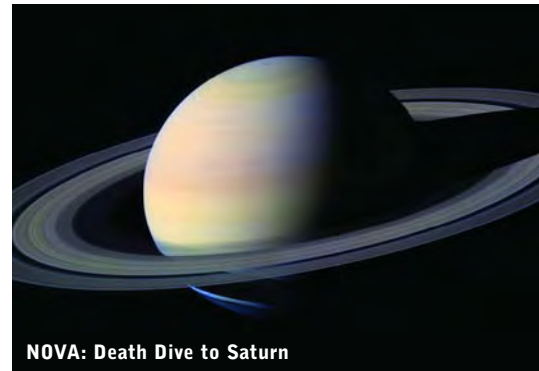

This riveting special tells the saga of the Sungs — a Chinese-American family who own and operate Abacus Federal Savings in New York's Chinatown. It's founder, Thomas Sung, says he started it with the goal to empower the local community and offer a personal alternative to big banks. But in 2009, the Sung's fired a loan officer after they discovered fraud. They reported the fraud to law enforcement, but soon found themselves and the bank under scrutiny. Two-and-a-half-years later, they were accused of mortgage fraud, becoming the only U.S. bank prosecuted after the 2008 financial crash. The film follows how the indictment and subsequent trial forces the Sung family to defend themselves — and their bank's legacy in the Chinatown community — over the course of a five-year legal battle. *Also airs on Tuesday, September 12 at 10 p.m. on Vegas PBS Channel 10.*
