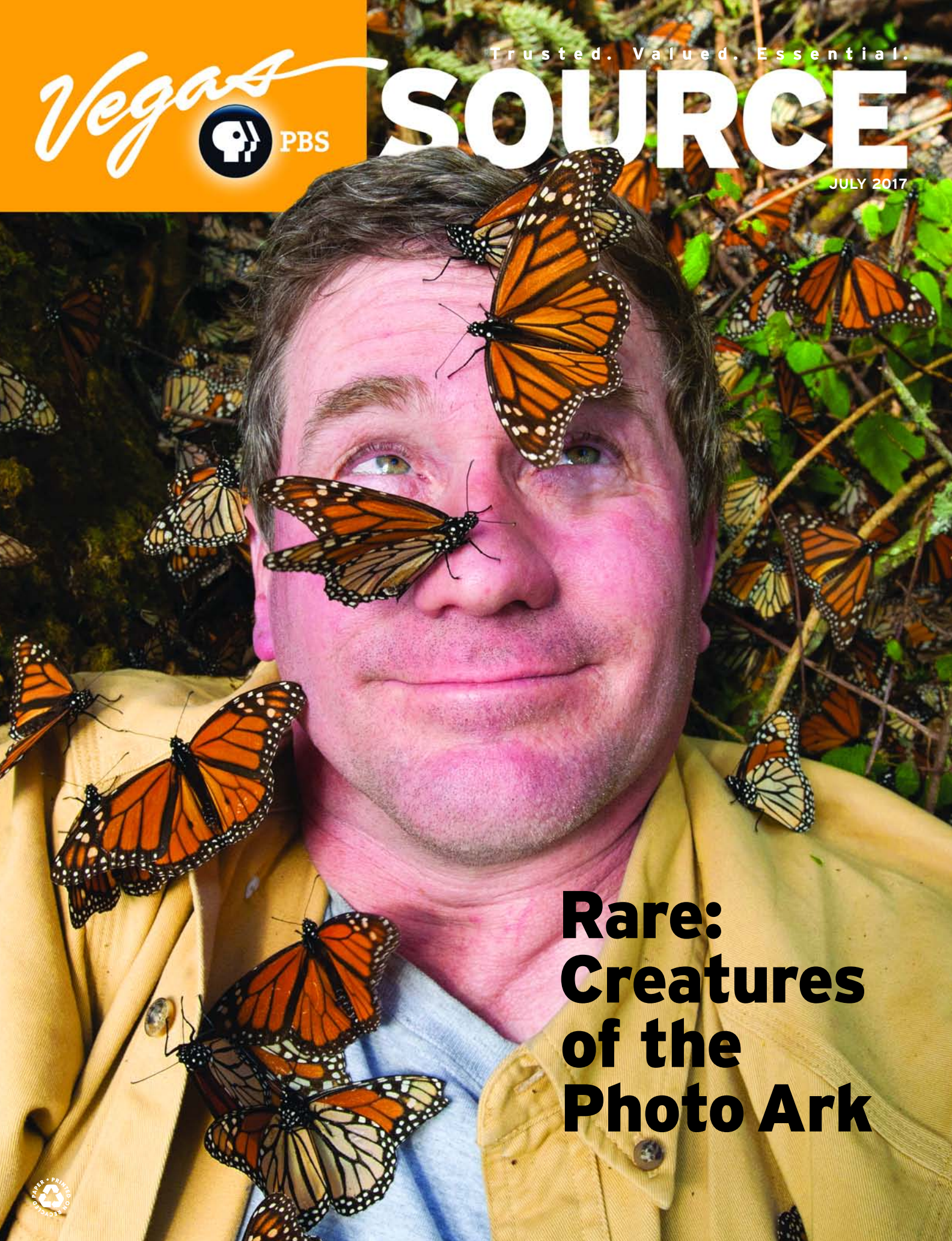

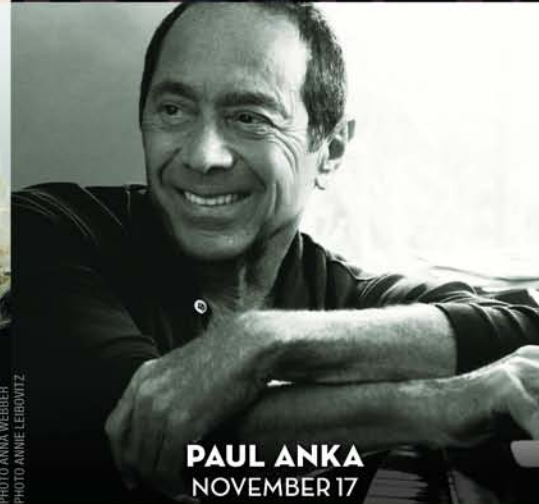

A Message from the General Manager

Stop Summer Learning Loss

Teachers and national research report that the first six weeks of the school year are spent reviewing and re-learning skills and subjects children have forgotten over the summer. Vegas PBS is helping parents, grandparents and caregivers combat summer learning loss with hands-on family engagement workshops, an educational media lending library, and new digital devices that provide dedicated PBS KIDS content all summer long. These grant-funded community engagement activities are intended to enhance our educational television programs, interactive websites, and mobile apps at home and on the go.

This summer, Vegas PBS will partner with numerous community organizations, including the Las Vegas Clark County Library District, the Boulder City Library District, Discovery Children's Museum, Family to Family Connections and COX Cable, to provide a series of multi-media activities that incorporate popular PBS KIDS shows and characters. In each workshop, families will experience a unique combination of online games, video segments, related books, and hands-on learning from programs kids know and love to deepen their understanding of math and literacy.

Summer is also an opportune time for parents or guardians and their children, service providers, educators, and adults with disabilities to explore Vegas PBS' educational media library serving special needs populations. The library provides FREE educational media to special needs families throughout the state of Nevada, circulating approximately 2,000 pieces of educational media per month, in partnership with Nevada Early Intervention Services specialists and the parents/children they serve, teachers from various CCSD school sites, Easter Seals specialists, ISS Baby Steps specialists, and other vital community partners. Described and captioned videos are only part of the available resources.

In addition to these local Vegas PBS services, on a national level, our 24-hour PBS KIDS channel continuously experiments with new ways to engage children with media that sparks their curiosity and fosters a love of learning. For families, always on-the-go, PBS KIDS now offers its high-quality, innovative content on an affordable tablet device that helps kids learn and explore with their favorite PBS KIDS characters, whenever and wherever.

A one-stop destination for PBS KIDS' educational content, the PBS KIDS Playtime Pad provides more than 25 games and 120 video clips and music videos pre-loaded, along with 100+ hours of video on the PBS KIDS Video App. The Playtime Pad features a front-and-back camera and a Paint Box coloring app that encourages kids to flex their creative skills. The tablet is kidSAFE® Coppa-certified, and includes controls that enable parents to customize the device for each of their children, set limits on screen time using a play timer and manage what kids can access.

Summer is also a time for kids to participate in extracurricular activities. Research shows that students involved in extracurricular activities perform better in school and are more likely to graduate from high school. Many families in Southern Nevada may not be familiar with the wealth of youth activities available for their children throughout the summer months. Vegas PBS, as a part of our Keeping Kids Fit initiative, provides a list of art, music and sport activities for families to consider. Visit VegasPBS.org/kkf/youth-activities to learn more.

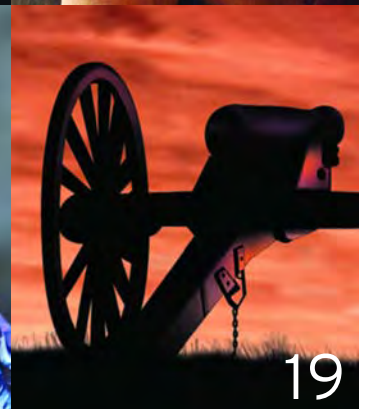

The Story of China

Tuesday, July 11 at 8 p.m.

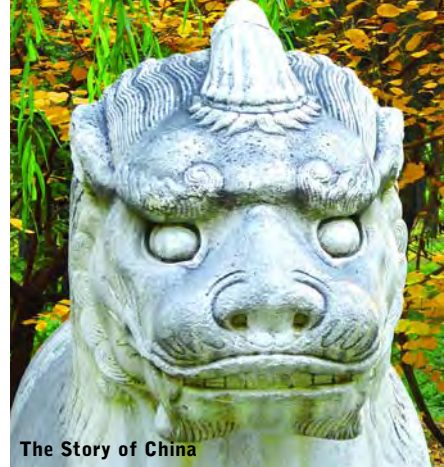

Revolution surveys the three great revolutions that gave birth to today's China. Wood visits wild mountain villages; describes the fall of the empire; visits Jazz Age Shanghai; and stays in the last communist commune—before a celebration on Chinese New Year.

July 19 Big Pacific: Making Of

Follow the adventures of the filmmakers, capturing the highlights and challenges of wildlife filmmaking.

Great Yellowstone Thaw

Wednesday, July 5 at 9 p.m.

Journey with Kirk Johnson to Yellowstone, where wolves, grizzlies, beavers and Great Gray owls survive one of the greatest seasonal changes on the planet. The series follows the animals as they emerge from winter's cold and adapt to an early spring thaw, before encountering the rising summer temperatures, as the temperature swings 140 degrees. In the final episode tonight, find out why a summer with soaring temperatures could pose a threat to Yellowstone's ecosystem. Learn if the Great Gray owl family survives a major fire in the Beartooth Mountains and see how one particular wolf pack is feeding its 11 pups. **Repeats Sunday, July 9 at 11 a.m.**

RARE: Creatures of the Photo Ark

Tuesdays, July 18 - August 1 at 9 p.m.

Renowned National Geographic photographer Joel Sartore is a natural-born storyteller. His Photo Ark project is a digital "collection" of the world's mammals, fish, amphibians, birds, reptiles and insects. This captivating new three-part series follows Sartore as he documents threatened species

at zoos, in nature preserves and in the wild. Throughout the special, scientists and naturalists reveal surprising and important information about why ensuring the future of these animals is so critical.

Sartore has traveled to nearly 40 countries to photograph 6,395 species to date, including 576 amphibians, 1,839 birds, 716 fish, 1,123 invertebrates, 896 mammals and 1,245 reptiles in captivity. He knows he is in a race against time. Sometimes he is able to photograph 30 to 40 species in a few days. Others are disappearing before he can get to them. When complete, the Photo Ark will be one of the most comprehensive records of the world's biodiversity. Journey with Sartore across the globe—to Africa, Asia, Europe, North America and Oceania—as he chronicles his experiences.

Wild Australasia

Thursdays at 8 p.m.

This epic six-part series is a journey through time and space to explore Australasia's natural wonders. As the driest inhabited continent on Earth, Australia is a world apart - a place where successive invasions of people have made the greatest impact on its wildlife and wilderness areas. From the tropical jungle to the vast shallow coral reefs, from burning deserts to snowy mountains, Australasia is a land of outstanding splendor.

Be sure to set your DVRs and enjoy an extraordinary ensemble in Mozart's early masterpiece of love and vengeance following the Trojan War. Like many stories from Greek myth, it explores the motivations and emotions of humans whose fates seem beyond their own control. The opera casts these issues within the framework of the opera seria genre, a stylized format popular

in the 18th century that is characterized by a succession of arias and recitatives and a cast of noble characters.

Tenor Matthew Polenzani sings the title role of the King of Crete, with mezzo-soprano Alice Coote in the trouser role of his noble son Idamante, soprano Elza van den Heever as Elettra and soprano Nadine Sierra as Ilia. Long neglected along with other works of this era, this opera now holds a firm place in the repertoire as the first of Mozart's operatic masterpieces.

Billy Joel: The Library of Congress Gershwin Prize

Friday, July 7 at 10 p.m.

Singer-songwriter Billy Joel ranks as one of the most popular recording artists and respected entertainers in the world. His piano-fueled narratives take listeners into the relatable and deeply personal crevices of life. This musical special honors Billy Joel's receipt of the Library of Congress Gershwin Prize for Popular Song in 2014. The special features Joel, as well as Tony Bennett, Boyz II Men, Michael Feinstein, Gavin DeGraw, Josh Groban, Natalie Maines, John Mellencamp and LeAnn Rimes, with a special performance by Kevin Spacey—as well as dance ensemble performances from Twyla Tharp's "Movin' Out."

Willie Nelson: The Library of Congress Gershwin Prize for Popular Song

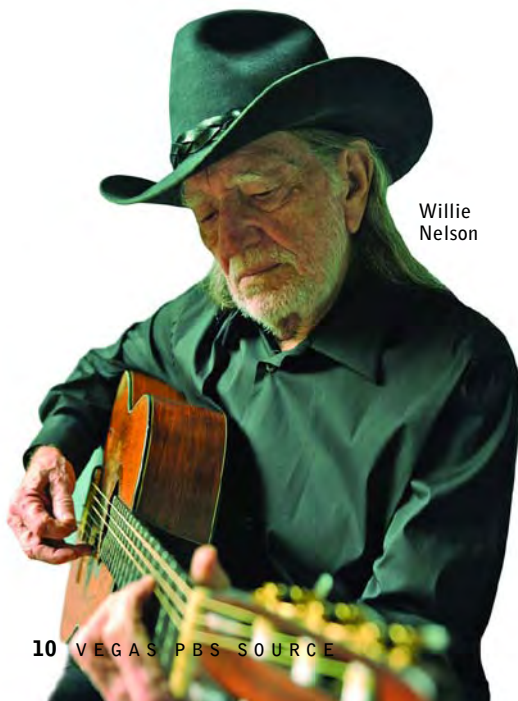
Friday, July 14 at 10 p.m.

A rhythm and blues icon whose career has spanned more than 50 years, Smokey Robinson is considered the poet laureate of soul. Enjoy an all-star tribute to Robinson, the 2016 recipient of the Library of Congress Gershwin Prize for Popular Song, with performances by Robinson, as well as Aloe Blacc, Gallant, CeeLo Green, JoJo, Ledisi, Tegan Marie, Kip Moore, Corinne Bailey Rae, Esperanza Spalding, The Tenors, Joe Walsh, BeBe Winans and a special appearance by Berry Gordy, Founder of Motown.

The National Mall— America's Front Yard

Monday, July 3 at 10 p.m.

The National Mall, placed in the very center of our nation's capital, is lined by some of the world's finest museums and dotted with monuments to the country's most revered figures, drawing millions of visitors each year. Most of them have only a vague sense of the struggles involved in creating this unique space. Using a mixture of contemporary and archival footage, state-of-the-art graphics and fly-over aerials, the film

traces the Mall's, and the country's, development. From its conception in 1791 by French-born artist Pierre L'Enfant to its current status as one of the most familiar and cherished icons of our democracy, the story of the Mall mirrors the story of the United States.

Secrets of London Underground

Monday, July 10 at 10 p.m.

On the surface, London is a buzzing, modern metropolis—but underneath lies a secret, hidden world, all but forgotten by the millions of people above. This program uncovers 2,000 years of subterranean history: a world of ancient caves and perfectly preserved Roman remains; mysterious rivers and gruesome plague pits and top-secret bunkers. Digging deep, the program unearths some of the most extraordinary stories of the darkest part of the city.

Secrets of Westminster

Monday, July 17 at 10 p.m.

As one of the world's most famous churches, Westminster Abbey is steeped in Anglo-Saxon myths and legends dating back to the 11th century. You will be privy to a behind-the-scenes tour to one of the most memorable vantage points of this architectural masterpiece, the site of the coronations of every English monarch since 1066. The film charts the brazen heist of the Stone of Destiny, part of the famous Coronation Chair, first used by Edward the Confessor in 1296. The theft, on Christmas Eve in 1950, made international headlines. Access is also provided to the Houses of Parliament, where intrigue, pageantry and customs, including why a monarch is never allowed into the House of Commons, are the order of the day.

Secrets of the Tower of London

Monday, July 24 at 10 p.m.

Standing guard over its city for nearly 1,000 years, the Tower of London has been expanded upon over the centuries by many a king and queen. The first foundations were laid in 1078 as part of the conquest by William the Conqueror. Since that time, the Tower of London has been a royal castle, a prison, a place of execution and torture, an armory and the Royal Mint. The special goes behind the tower's ancient walls, exposing its stories, unlocking doors to rooms never before seen on television, talking to the people who do stealth jobs in the edifice and revealing little-known facts about this English icon.

V2 Rocket **July 13**

The first ever long-range rockets were designed and built by the Nazis in a network of top-secret research labs, underground silos and hi-tech launch pads. This is the story of how scientist Werner von Braun heralded the birth of ballistic missiles and laid the technological foundations for the space race.

Super Tanks **July 20**

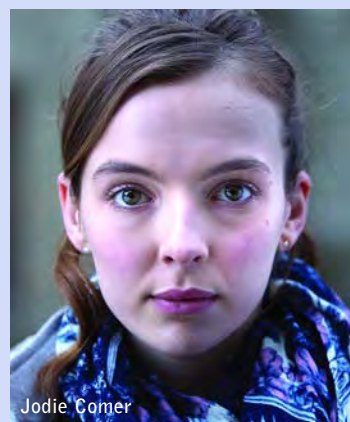

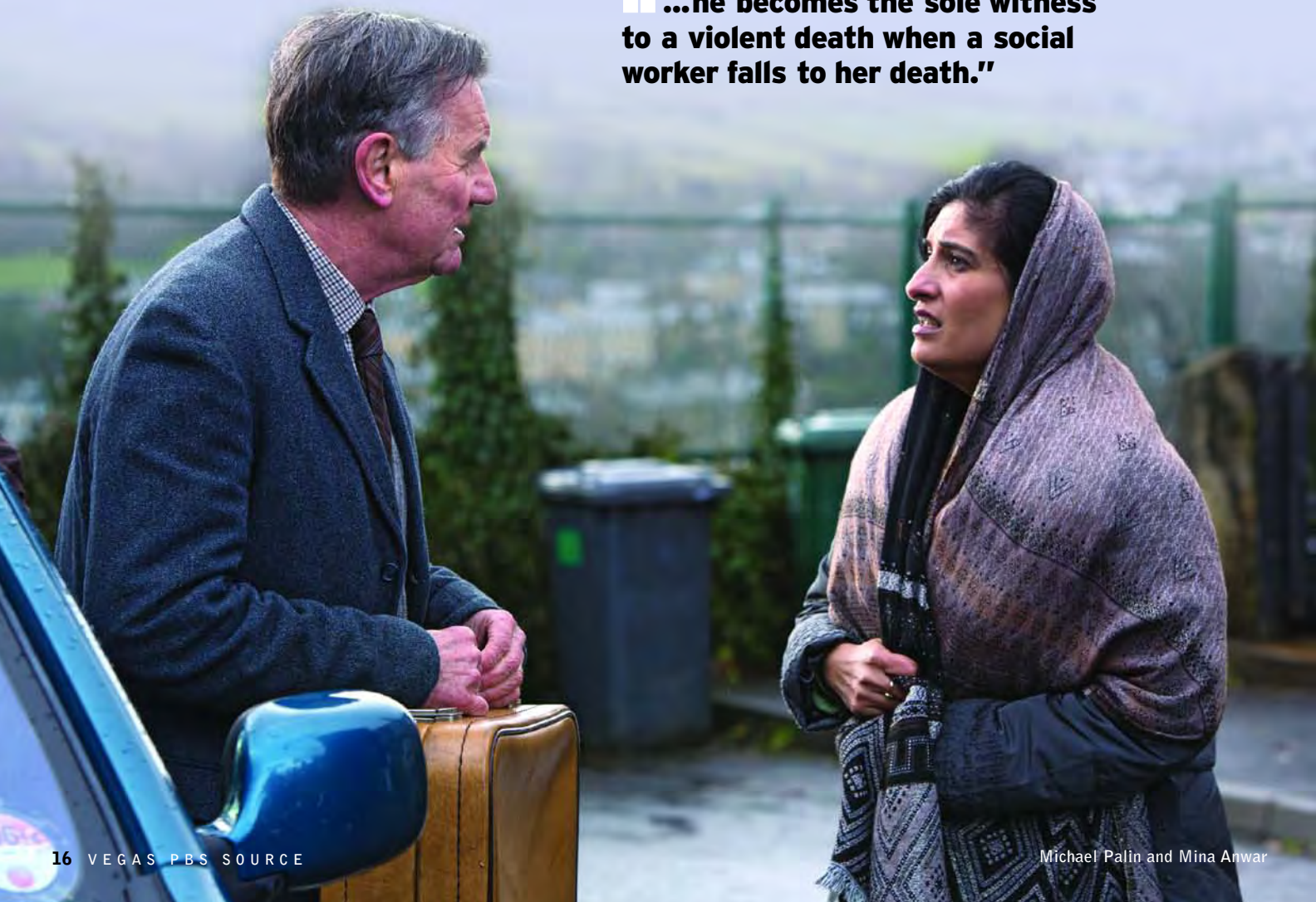

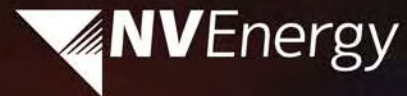

Ken Burns Documentary Showcase

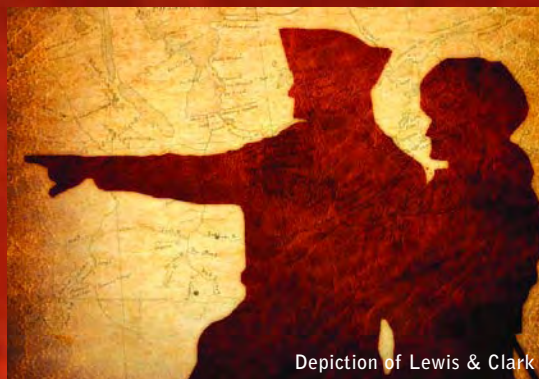
Sundays throughout July

Ken Burns has been making films for more than thirty-five years, pioneering a new genre of historical filmmaking and has directed some of the most acclaimed historical documentaries ever made. This month we feature two iconic films.

Lewis & Clark and the Journey of the Corps of Discovery Sunday, July 2 from 1 p.m. to 5 p.m.

The most notable expedition in U.S. history was led by Meriwether Lewis and William Clark with soldiers, an African-American slave, a female guide and Canadian boatmen. This special re-creates the 1803 journey to locate the Northwest Passage, discovering a varied landscape and a dizzying diversity of Indian peoples.

In 1801, the United States ended at the Mississippi River. When President Thomas Jefferson bought the Louisiana Territory, he doubled the country's size. The sudden western expansion of the United States—and rumors of a Northwest Passage that would link the Atlantic with the Pacific—motivated Jefferson to find the great byway to the West. Meriwether Lewis, William Clark and a group of rough frontiersmen

were tasked to find that passage. This documentary chronicles the encounters with Native Americans, the animals and plant life they discovered, their historic pairing with Sacagawea and their crossing of the Continental Divide.

The Civil War Sundays, July 9-23 Parts 1, 2 and 3 July 9 from noon to 4:30 p.m., Parts 4, 5, 6 and 7 July 16 from 11 a.m. to 4:30 p.m., Parts 8 and 9 July 23 from 11 a.m. to 1:30 p.m.,

This epic nine-episode series first aired in 1990 and was restored to a high-definition version in September of 2015. The film is a comprehensive and definitive history of the American Civil War, and the recipient of 40 major film and television awards.

Five years in the making, it was heralded as an unforgettable introduction to a four-year conflict fought in 10,000 places. The film vividly embraces the entire sweep of the war: the complex causes and lasting effects of America's greatest and most moving calamity, the battles and the homefronts, the generals and the private soldiers, the anguish of death in battle and the grief of families at home.

Archival images of 16,000 photographs, period paintings, lithographs and headlines were combined with moving newsreel footage of Civil War veterans. Evocative cinematography of the now quiet battle sites, interviews with distinguished historians and the inclusion of first-person accounts are also featured.

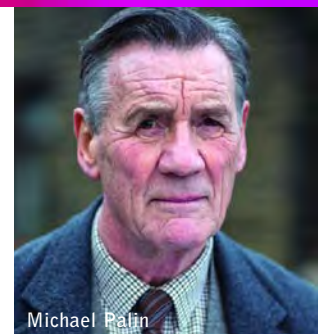

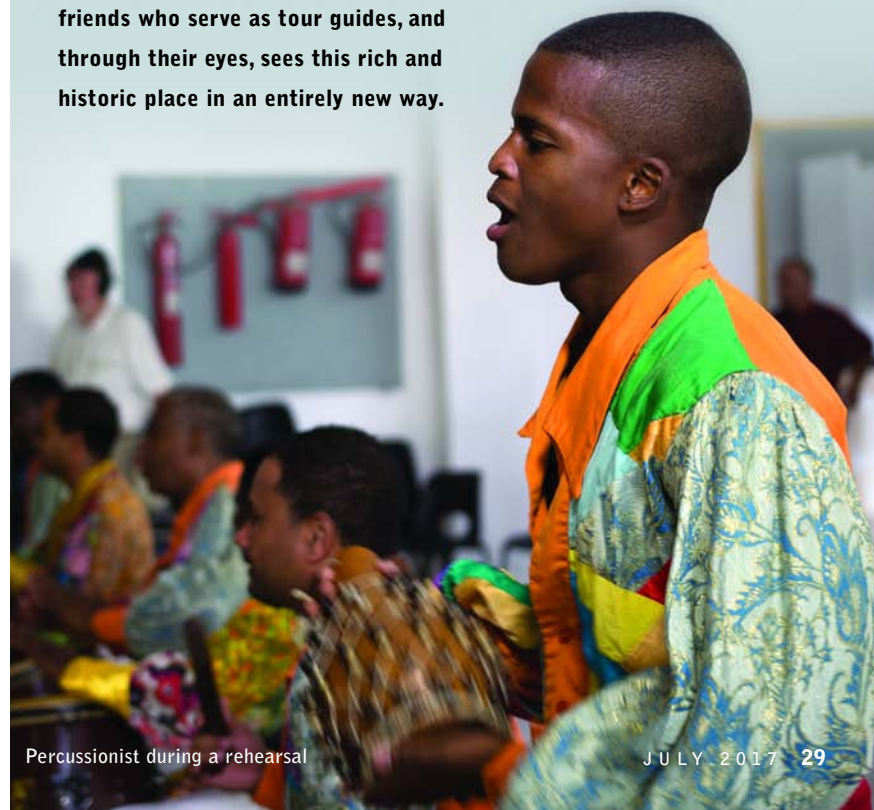

In the summer of 1967, thousands of young people from across the country flocked to San Francisco's Haight-Ashbury district to join in the hippie experience, only to discover that what they had come for was already disappearing. By 1968 the celebration of free love, music and an alternative lifestyle had descended into a maelstrom of drug abuse, broken dreams and occasional violence. Through interviews with a broad range of individuals, including actor Peter Coyote and politician Willie Brown, who lived through the summer of love, as well as police officers walking the beat, teenage runaways who left home without looking back, non-hippie residents who resented the invasion of their community and scholars who still have difficulty interpreting the phenomenon — this presentation offers a complex portrait of the notorious event that many consider the peak of the 1960s counter-culture movement.

Forgotten Ellis Island

Sunday, July 2 at 10 p.m.

During the great wave of immigration at the turn of the 20th century, 22 medical buildings sprawled across two islands adjacent to Ellis Island, the largest port of entry into the United States. The hospital was America's first line of defense against contagious, often virulent, disease. In the era before antibiotics, tens of thousands of immigrant patients were separated from family, detained in the hospital and healed from illness before becoming citizens. There were 350 babies born in the hospital, while many immigrants died on Ellis Island: 3,500 were buried in paupers' graves around New York City. This special brings the lost history of Ellis Island Hospital to life, reminding us of the stories of the immigrant patients who lay in beds with a view of the Statue of Liberty, remembered only by the generation that had lived them. **Repeats** Wednesday, July 5 at 9 p.m.
