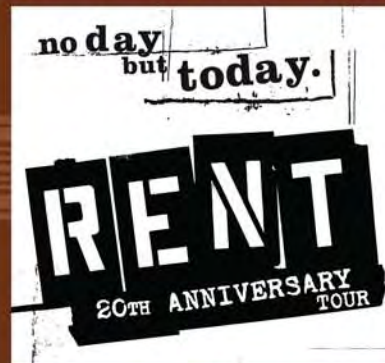

## A Message from the General Manager

### Impactful Programming

In any enterprise, evaluating the impact of your work is critical. At Vegas PBS, we measure our media-based educational programs and outreach services by how frequently they are used but also by the impact they have on those who use them. In other words, how do we educate, inform, inspire and empower those who watch our television programs or utilize our outreach services?

We also measure our television audiences. Traditionally, a new "TV Year" begins at the end of each September as the commercial networks offer their fall program premieres, and that's also the time the Nielson company announces cumulative audience ratings from the previous year. I'm pleased to report that viewers like you made Vegas PBS the second most-watched PBS station among the largest markets in the country for the 2016-2017 television broadcast season. According to Nielson, our Whole Day Gross Ratings Points (GRPs) were more than double the national average of all PBS stations. Vegas PBS also registers an above average amount of viewership from recorded programs viewed at times other than our broadcast. Vegas PBS has been among the top three most-watched PBS stations for nine consecutive years.

In addition to Channel 10, viewers tune in at high numbers for our sub-channels as well. Vegas PBS Create was the second most-watched Create channel in the nation, with 30 percent higher viewership than the national average. And since its launch in January 2017, VEGAS PBS KIDS has grown the largest audience on the 24/7 PBS KIDS channel among other large television markets like Detroit, Phoenix, Dallas, Chicago and New York, with an audience rating of more than twice the national average.


Some of the most-watched programs on Vegas PBS Channel 10 during the past broadcast season were **Victoria on Masterpiece**, **Ken Burns' The Vietnam War**, **NOVA**, **Midsomer Murders**, **Spy in the Wild — a Nature Miniseries**, **Africa's Great Civilizations**, and **Daniel Tiger's Neighborhood**. As we evaluate the impact of our television services, we are thrilled that these compelling programs garnered such large audiences, but we are even more heartened by the stories viewers tell us about how the programs have enriched their lives. They tell us that these programs enable their children to learn basic skills and how to share or express their feelings; help veterans heal from the wounds of war; inspire students to become scientists; give goosebumps to budding musicians; and help homebound seniors explore to new worlds.

Your support allows public service media to provide the kind of richness that achieves significant ratings success AND powerful community impact. The educational and ratings success of Vegas PBS' broadcast and digital channels is built on the foundation of strong financial support from members like you. More than 15,000 people have chosen to become Vegas PBS members and invest in the quality content they rely on Vegas PBS to provide. These donations allow us to acquire programming from PBS and half a dozen other providers. Thank you for tuning in and for your continued support.

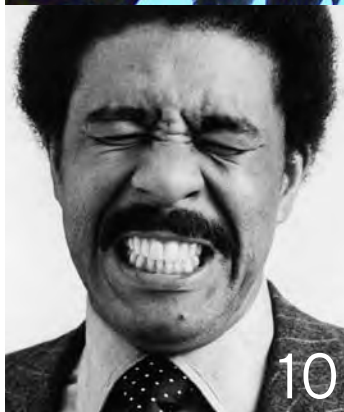

The Great Hurricane of 1780 took nine days to blast its way across the Caribbean, killing at least 20,000—the highest known death toll of any single weather event in history. ## **Wild South America**

**Thursdays, November 2 and 9 at 8 p.m.**

Explore the exciting, diverse and unique wildlife that inhabits the dramatic landscapes of the vast South American continent. Using the latest camera techniques, rarely seen animals are revealed, while an aerial cameraman soars over the continent, revealing an entirely new perspective on its varied and dramatic landscape.

On **November 2, Amazon Jungle** takes you to the world's largest rainforest, where the diversity of life is so great that in just two square miles scientists have counted 3,000 varieties of plants, 530 types of birds and 11 species of monkey. But it's not only full of variety, it's a dangerous place too.

Then on **November 9, Penguin Shores** journeys from the Falklands to the tropical Galapagos, as the cold coastal currents create one of the richest marine ecosystems on Earth with the highest densities of seabirds ever seen. This is the habitat of killer whales, dolphins, seals, albatrosses, pelicans, the world's only marine lizard and the ubiquitous penguins, which can be found in the most surprising locations.

The Caribbean is the embodiment of paradise: crystal blue waters, magical coral reefs and lush tropical forests. Yet behind its beauty lie many dark and mysterious secrets. From the ice-capped peaks on the coast of Colombia to the spewing vents of Central America, find out how the islands are still today being formed under the massive pressures of tectonic movement and how a violent Eden has given way to a garden of delight.

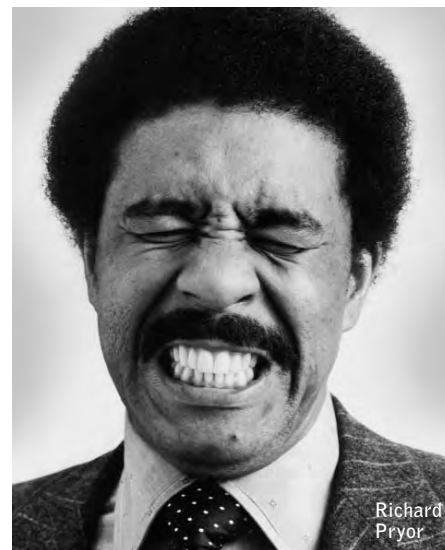

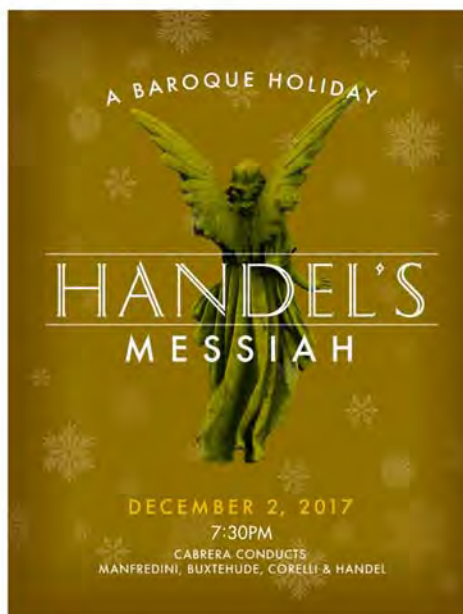
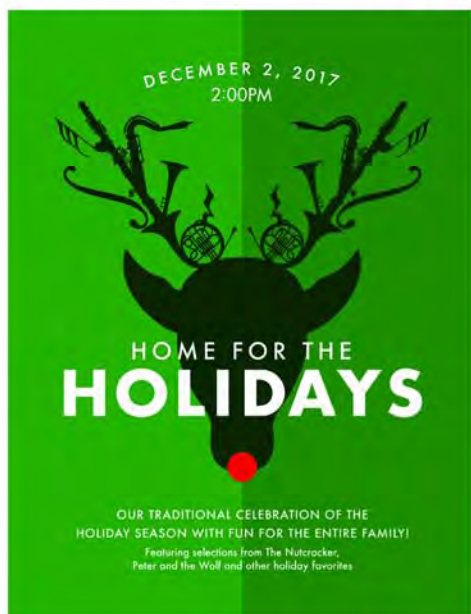
This new special salutes David Letterman and features a star-studded cast of Letterman's friends and colleagues. He has been hailed as one of the most innovative

### The Vietnam War

**Tuesdays at 9 p.m.**

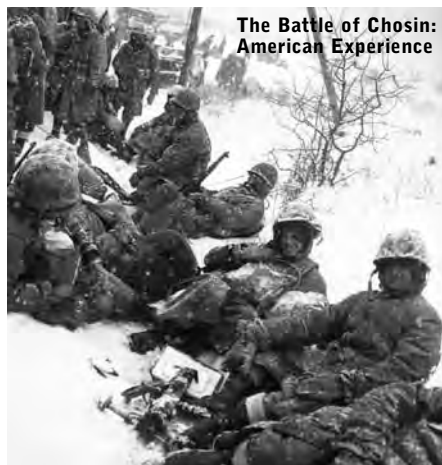

This new documentary film explores the history of the department of Veterans Affairs — from the troubled beginnings of the Veterans Bureau of the 1920s, to the modern VA system. 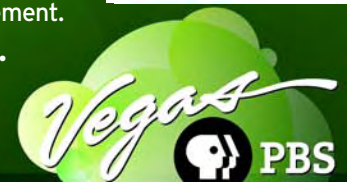

## Got a favorite show? Why not put your name on it?

**W**e've been updating our VegasPBS.org website recently – a checklist process organizations go through all too often these days – and it's reminded me that it might be time to share a few things about the role viewers can play in programming.

You're already aware that we have sponsors for programs on Vegas PBS Channel 10. Last year, we began offering sponsorships for our Create channel, and we added our VEGAS PBS KIDS 24-hour channel to the mix when it launched earlier this year.

Although the television medium can be relatively complex, program sponsorship really is not. And although many of the sponsors you see on-air are companies, we also encourage and welcome programming support from private individuals and families. We make it easy to do.

Companies often benefit from a professional advertising agency to assist them in preparation of a television spot. But not every business has this luxury, and very certainly few of our viewers have an ad agency on retainer.

No problem. We offer professional production services at no charge to sponsors.

Once you've identified a program you wish to support, the next decision is whether your desired message is to be 15 or 30 seconds long. Once that's been resolved, we construct a script for your review, something unique to you or your family. Once you've approved the language, we gather your graphics or photographs and design a message suitable for high-definition television.

As you may know, there are some Federal Communications Commission restrictions on messages carried by public-service media, and as a result, there are some types of messages you'll never see on Vegas PBS. However, these guidelines actually contribute to the credibility and trust of our sponsor messages.

We also carry far fewer messages per hour than commercial stations do, and we never interrupt a program to insert one. All these things help explain why viewers have a much more positive impression of our sponsors, and a high recall rate of their messages.

When you support a Vegas PBS television program, viewers will remember both your message and community contribution as well. You'll find pride in ownership of your own favorite show, or you might wish to help fund one of the VEGAS PBS KIDS programs that bring daily entertainment and education to thousands of local children. Check with your accountant, too; there may be tax benefits.

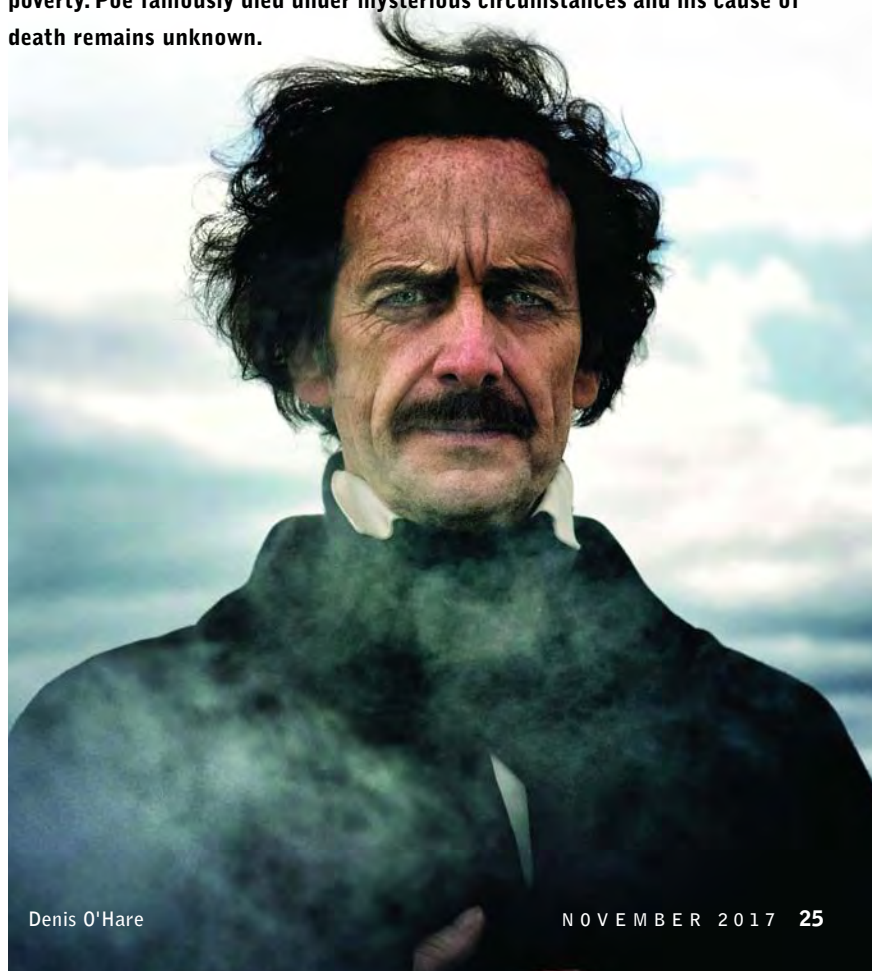

### Edgar Allan Poe: American Masters

Monday, October 30 at 10 p.m.

After his death, writer Edgar Allan Poe (1809-1849) became a global icon of modern literature and a pop culture brand who was best known for his Gothic horror tales. This new documentary draws on the rich palette of Poe's evocative imagery and sharply drawn plots to tell the real story of the notorious author, exploring the misrepresentations of Poe as a drug-addled madman akin to the narrators of his horror stories. An orphan in search of family, love and literary fame, Poe struggled with alcoholism and was also a product of early 19th century American urban life: depressed from the era's culture of death due to the high mortality rate and the struggles of living in poverty. Poe famously died under mysterious circumstances and his cause of death remains unknown.

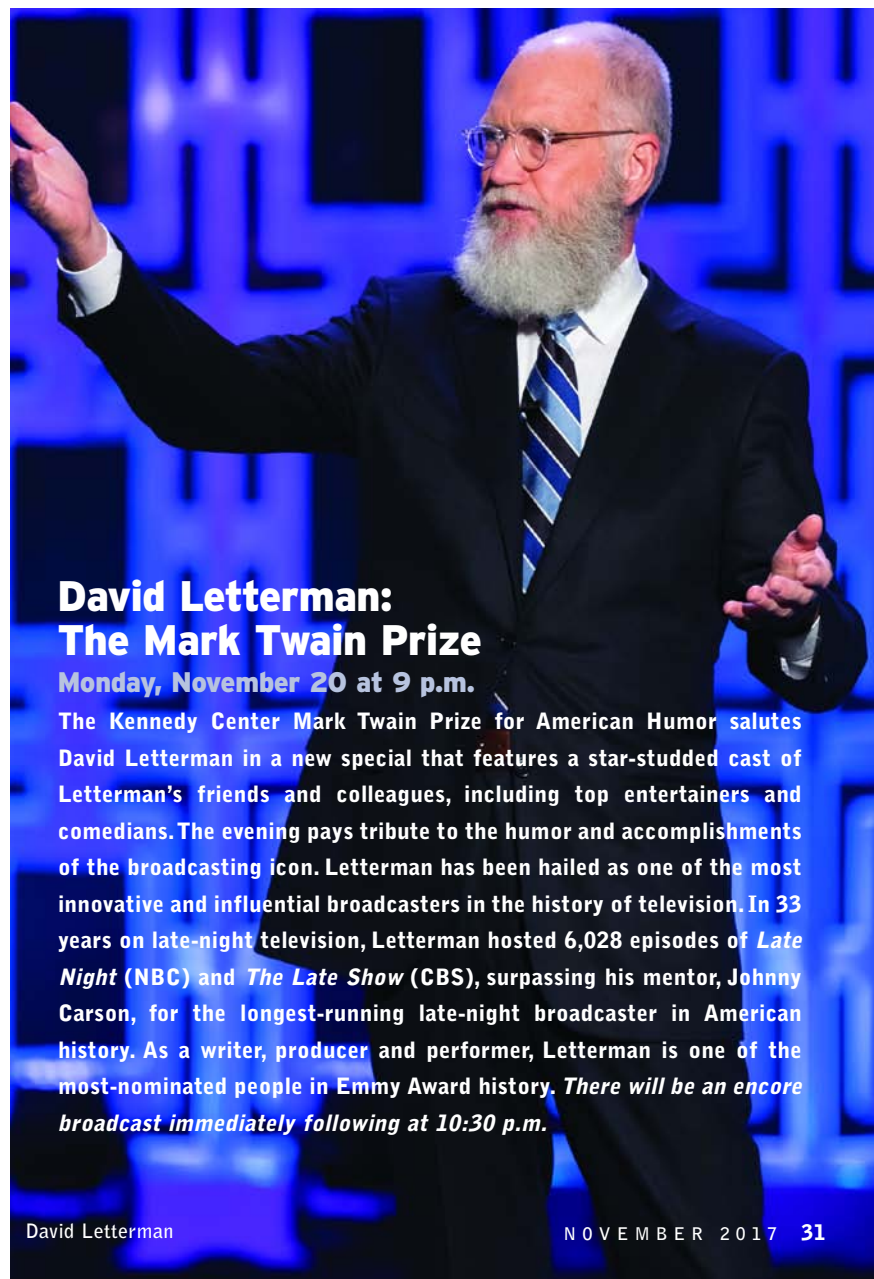

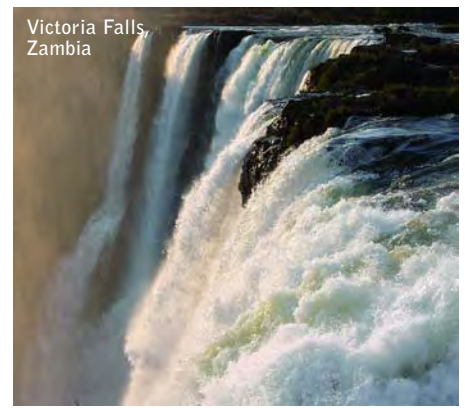
