

Impactful Programming

n any enterprise, evaluating the impact of your work is critical. At Vegas PBS, we measure our media-based educational programs and outreach services by how frequently they are used but also by the impact they have on those who use them. In other words, how do we educate, inform, inspire and empower those who watch our television programs or utilize our outreach services?

We also measure our television audiences. Traditionally, a new "TV Year" begins at the end of each September as the commercial networks offer their fall program premieres, and that's also the time the Nielson company announces cumulative audience

ratings from the previous year. I'm pleased to report that viewers like you made Vegas PBS the second mostwatched PBS station among the largest markets in the country for the 2016-2017 television broadcast season. According to Nielson, our Whole Day

Gross Ratings Points (GRPs) were more than double the national average of all PBS stations. Vegas PBS also registers an above average amount of viewership from recorded programs viewed at times other than our broadcast. Vegas PBS has been among the top three most-watched PBS stations for nine consecutive years.

In addition to Channel 10, viewers tune in at high numbers for our sub-channels as well. Vegas PBS Create was the second most-watched Create channel in the nation, with 30 percent higher viewership than the national average. And since its launch in January 2017, VEGAS PBS KIDS has grown the largest audience on the 24/7 PBS KIDS channel among other large television markets like Detroit, Phoenix, Dallas, Chicago and New York, with an audience rating of more than twice the national average.

Some of the most-watched programs on Vegas PBS Channel 10 during the past broadcast season were Victoria on Masterpiece, Ken Burns' The Vietnam War, NOVA, Midsomer Murders, Spy in the Wild — a Nature Miniseries, Africa's Great Civilizations, and Daniel Tiger's Neighborhood. As we evaluate the impact of our television services, we are thrilled that these compelling programs garnered such large audiences, but we are even more heartened by the stories viewers tell us about how the programs have enriched their lives. They tell us that these programs enable their children to learn basic skills and how to share or express their feelings; help veterans heal from the wounds of war; inspire students to become scientists; give goosebumps to budding musicians; and help homebound seniors explore to new worlds.

The educational and ratings success of Vegas PBS' broadcast and digital channels is built on the foundation of strong financial support from members like you. Nature Wednesdays at 8 p.m. H is for Hawk: A New Chapter November 1

From Helen Macdonald's international best-selling book, this special tells the story of a grieving daughter who found healing in the form of Mabel, a goshawk. The goshawk is one of Mother Nature's own fighter jets, capable of finding and killing its prey with tremendous speed. For the first time after Mabel's death, Macdonald tries again to train another one of these secretive birds of prey and intimately explore their lives in the wild forests they call home.

Cubs live with their mothers for about 18 months but often become prey to lions, leopards and hyenas. To protect her cubs, a mother moves them frequently. In this new special, wildlife cameraman Kim Wolhuter shadowed a wild cheetah family on foot for nearly two years in the forested hills of Zimbabwe, revealing in intimate detail the cubs' remarkable journey to adulthood and their mother's dedication in raising them.

Nature's Miniature Miracles November 22

It really is a big bad world out there, so what happens if you are the little guy? This film tells the epic survival stories of the world's smallest animals, from a tiny sengi, the "cheetah" of the shrew world, to a small shark that walks on land. To make a living, these tiny heroes have evolved extraordinary skills and achieved mind-boggling feats. For these animals, size does not matter.

NOVA Wednesdays at 9 p.m. Killer Hurricanes November 1

The Great Hurricane of 1780 took nine days to blast its way across the Caribbean, killing at least 20,000—the highest known death toll of any single weather event in history. But just how unusual was the Great Hurricane? Experts recover traces of tempests stretching back over more than 1,000 years. The picture they paint is disturbing: mega-hurricanes were not only more frequent in the past but are likely to strike again in our near future, as climate change warms the oceans and fuels more intense hurricanes.

Killer Floods November 8

All over the world, scientists are discovering traces of ancient floods on a scale that dwarfs even the most severe flood disasters of recent times. What triggered these cataclysmic floods, and could they strike again? Like forensic detectives at a crime scene, geologists study these strange features and reconstruct catastrophic Ice Age floods more powerful than all the world's top ten rivers combined.

Every animal has some kind of weapon, whether it's claws or horns, fangs or stings. In rare cases, we find species whose weapons have become stunningly outsized. 
Explore the exciting, diverse and unique wildlife that inhabits the dramatic landscapes of the vast South American continent. Using the latest camera techniques, rarely seen animals are revealed, while an aerial cameraman soars over the continent, revealing an entirely new perspective on its varied and dramatic landscape.

On **November 2, Amazon Jungle** takes you to the world's largest rainforest, where the diversity of life is so great that in just two square miles scientists have counted 3,000 varieties of plants, 530 types of birds and 11 species of monkey. But it's not only full of variety, it's a dangerous place too.

Then on **November 9, Penguin Shores** journeys from the Falklands to the tropical Galapagos, as the cold coastal currents create one of the richest marine ecosystems on Earth with the highest densities of seabirds ever seen. This is the habitat of killer whales, dolphins, seals, albatrosses, pelicans, the world's only marine lizard and the ubiquitous penguins, which can be found in the most surprising locations.

Wild Caribbean Thursday, November 16 at 8 p.m.

The Caribbean is the embodiment of paradise: crystal blue waters, magical coral reefs and lush tropical forests. Yet behind its beauty lie many dark and mysterious secrets. This series reveals both the magic and the drama of a violent paradise. In this first episode, take a round trip to discover how volcanoes and other forces have shaped the Caribbean islands. From the ice-capped peaks on the coast of Colombia to the spewing vents of Central America, find out how the islands are still today being formed under the massive pressures of tectonic movement and how a violent Eden has given way to a garden of delight.



This Wild Life Tuesdays, November 7 and 21 at 7:30 p.m.

Wildlife expert Saba Douglas-Hamilton and family move to the romantic Samburu National Reserve in northern Kenya to run a safari lodge for the first time. This wild, remote and rugged region is on the frontline of conservation and the battle to protect Africa's big five from poachers is heating up. This series follows the drama, tears and laughter that make up daily life at the lodge as this adventurous family and their Samburu team nurture the wildlife of this stunningly beautiful nature reserve and work to keep the tourists coming back. It might look like an idyllic barefoot life, surrounded by animals, but behind the facade lies a vulnerable game reserve facing tough times in a remarkable and changing Africa.

Richard Pryor - Icon Tuesday, October 31 at 10:30 p.m.


Learn the story of the groundbreaking entertainer who changed the rules of comedy, from his troubled upbringing in the slums of Peoria, Illinois, to his brave battle against multiple sclerosis, from performing on the *Ed Sullivan Show* to being banned by the networks. Though he was one of the most successful and influential entertainers of his generation, Pryor wrestled with selfdestructive behaviors that threatened his

life. The special explores Pryor's transformation from a straight-laced comedian to one of the most controversial and thoughtprovoking acts of his time. After walking off stage during a sold-out Las Vegas show, fed up with being forced to limit his self-expression, Pryor took a two-year sabbatical. He returned to the comedy scene a raw and unfiltered performer — and changed comedy forever. Sex, drugs, race...nothing was off limits. As he was more honest with himself, and his audience, the laughs grew even bigger. Pryor opened the door for other comedians to inject social commentary and other once-verboten topics into their humor.

David Letterman: The Mark Twain Prize Monday, November 20 at 9 p.m.

This new special salutes David Letterman and features a star-studded cast of Letterman's friends and colleagues. He has been hailed as one of the most innovative



and influential broadcasters in the history of television. From his roots in comedy, Letterman also became renowned as a masterful interviewer, sharing the stage with the U.S. Presidents, Cabinet officials, Medal of Honor recipients and virtually every Presidential candidate for more than 20 years. Letterman aired his final episode of *Late Show* on May 20th, 2015 to an audience of 13.76 million people. Remembering Our Veterans

Throughout November


We honor our heroes for their service and reflect on the great cost of war for both individuals and for nations.

The Vietnam War Tuesdays at 9 p.m.

Vegas PBS presents an encore viewing of this landmark 10-part, 18-hour documentary film series directed by Ken Burns and Lynn Novick that tells the epic story of the Vietnam War. The film features testimony from nearly 80 witnesses, including many Americans who fought in the war and others who opposed it, as well as Vietnamese combatants and civilians from both the winning and losing sides. The series brings the war and the chaotic epoch it encompassed viscerally to life.

VA and the Human Cost of War Monday, November 6 at 10 p.m.

This new documentary film explores the history of the department of Veterans Affairs — from the troubled beginnings of the Veterans Bureau of the 1920s, to the modern VA system. The film chronicles, in depth and with often wrenching detail, the workings of this crucial but at times beleaguered American institution. It explores what it does and how it functions, its vast size and importance, how it has come to be broken in critical ways and how it may be reformed going forward.



A Day of Remembrance Sunday, November 12 The Battle of Chosin: American Experience Noon

Learn the harrowing story of the pivotal 1950 Korean War battle. Through eyewitness accounts of bloody combat and heroic survival, the program revisits the major Cold War conflict that caught American military leaders and thousands of Marines and Army soldiers off guard, outnumbered and at risk of annihilation in the mountains of North Korea. With remarkable archival footage, the program reveals how the two-week battle helped set the course of American foreign policy in the Cold War and beyond.

The Greatest Generation Goes to War: Las Vegans' Memories of WWII 2 p.m.

Money was tight. Food was being rationed. And war was no longer seen as a choice. Las Vegas was a city of just over 8,000 residents, and it was just as much engulfed in battle as the rest of the world. This local production tells the tales of veterans all over the world that now reside in Las Vegas, as well as stories of people who lived in our city during the time that war took over our country. Their shared experiences bring a unique perspective to the many horrific events of this time.

Goering's Last Secret 4 p.m.

This intriguing film reveals the amazing and relatively untold story of Albert Goering, the brother of Nazi Herman Goering. Despite his connections to the highest echelons of the Nazi Party, Albert was determinedly anti-Nazi. He saved 34 people from Nazi atrocities by audaciously using his brother's forged signature and exalted position. The tide of war in the Pacific has now fully turned against the Imperial Japanese forces. 



e've been updating our VegasPBS.org website recently – a checklist process organizations go through all too often these days – and it's reminded me that it might be time to share a few things about the role viewers can play in programming.

You're already aware that we have sponsors for programs on Vegas PBS Channel 10. Last year, we began offering sponsorships for our Create channel, and we added our VEGAS PBS KIDS 24-hour channel to the mix when it launched earlier this year.

Although the television medium can be relatively complex, program sponsorship really is not. And although many of the sponsors you see on-air are companies, we also encourage and

welcome programming support from private individuals and families. We make it easy to do.

Companies often benefit from a professional advertising agency to assist them in preparation of a television spot. But not every business has this luxury, and very certainly few of our viewers have an ad agency on retainer.

No problem. We offer professional production services at no charge to sponsors.

Once you've identified a program you wish to support, the next decision is whether your desired message is to be 15 or 30 seconds long. Once that's been resolved, we construct a script for your review, something unique to you or your family. Once you've approved the language, we gather your graphics or photographs and design a message suitable for high-definition television.

As you may know, there are some Federal Communications Commission restrictions on messages carried by public-service media, and as a result, there are some types of messages you'll never see on Vegas PBS. However, these guidelines actually contribute to the credibility and trust of our sponsor messages.

We also carry far fewer messages per hour than commercial stations do, and we never interrupt a program to insert one. All these things help explain why viewers have a much more positive impression of our sponsors, and a high recall rate of their messages.

When you support a Vegas PBS television program, viewers will remember both your message and community contribution as well. You'll find pride in ownership of your own favorite show, or you might wish to help fund one of the VEGAS PBS KIDS programs that bring daily entertainment and education to thousands of local children. Check with your accountant, too; there may be tax benefits.

Wednesday, November 1 at 10 p.m.

Amid claims he hacked the 2016 election, this special investigates the inside story of Vladimir

Part 2 of this program explores how the U.S. struggled to confront Vladimir Putin over Russian involvement in the 2016 election. The film investigates how revenge may have motivated Putin to target American democracy, along with the U.S. responses under Presidents Obama and Trump.

Edgar Allan Poe: American Masters Monday, October 30 at 10 p.m.

After his death, writer Edgar Allan Poe (1809-1849) became a global icon of modern literature and a pop culture brand who was best known for his Gothic horror tales. This new documentary draws on the rich palette of Poe's evocative imagery and sharply drawn plots to tell the real story of the notorious author, exploring the misrepresentations of Poe as a drug-addled madman akin to the narrators of his horror stories. An orphan in search of family, love and literary fame, Poe struggled with alcoholism and was also a product of early 19th century American urban life: depressed from the era's culture of death due to the high mortality rate and the struggles of living in poverty. Poe famously died under mysterious circumstances and his cause of death remains unknown.
