Poldark, Season 3 on Masterpiece

Sundays at 9 p.m.

With unforgettable characters, a gripping story, fiery passions and stunning scenery, this romantic series has taken audiences by storm. In the highly anticipated new season, enjoy the latest thrilling exploits of Ross Poldark and his fiery partner, Demelza, starring Aidan Turner (*The Hobbit*) and Eleanor Tomlinson (*Death Comes to Pemberley*) as the intrepid eighteenth century duo. Last season, *TV Guide* was captivated by Poldark's "myriad pleasures, not the least of which is Aidan Turner's swarthy charisma as the chivalrous and perilously proud crusader of Cornwall...Poldark is the sort of great escape you would be foolish to resist."

As the saga opens, fresh doubts are introduced about the paternity of Elizabeth's impending baby, along with some consequential new characters including Ellise Chappell

as Elizabeth's pretty cousin Morwenna. Hired as the governess for Elizabeth's young son (by her previous marriage to Poldark's cousin Francis), Morwenna is soon a pawn in George's grand game to win political influence. Morwenna would prefer to share company with Demelza's strapping brother Drake, but George intends her to marry the recently widowed Reverend Whitworth.

Whitworth gives every indication of being a rank libertine, to the horror of the upright and innocent Morwenna. Meanwhile, George manages to abuse every privilege he accrues in his ruthless climb to power.

Also enlivening the new season are a mysterious plague of frogs, a thwarted famine and Aunt Agatha's eagerly anticipated one-hundredth birthday party, which has a catastrophic catch. But the most stirring action involves the French Revolution, which manages to ensnare one of the program's main characters in its Reign of Terror, prompting Poldark's most dangerous mission yet.

Poldark Revealed

Sunday, October 1 at 8 p.m.

Follow the cast and crew on location in beautiful Cornwall as they bring Winston Graham's much beloved saga to life. This special digs deep into the series' tumultuous background through exclusive interviews from cast and crew.

Additionally, hear interviews from Poldark's historical consultant, Dr. Hannah Greig, and an in-depth conversation with the author's son, Andrew Graham, who reveals how his father began writing the Poldark novels when he moved to Cornwall as a coastguard during the Second World War.

The Collection on Masterpiece

Sundays at 10 p.m. beginning October 8

World War II is over and stylish clothes are back as Paris recovers from the horrors of the Nazi occupation. In this new drama, the Sabine family is struggling to build a fashion empire at any cost, composed of business-savvy Paul (Richard Coyle), his wealthy American wife Helen (Mamie Gummer) and his brilliant but dissipated designer brother Claude (Tom Riley).

Set in 1947, the drama captures a turbulent era in French history when partisans hunted down Nazi collaborators and anyone with something to hide shunned the past and embraced the future. Fashion became the perfect expression of this impulse to look ahead. Wartime rationing, drabness and erotic restraint gave way to alluring displays of color, form and fabric in women's clothes — for those who could afford them. The Sabine family firm is at the forefront of this exciting but ruthless pursuit, and Paul has been chosen by the French government to lead the battle to reclaim the nation's preeminence in the couture world. Widely regarded as the genius behind his studio's stunning designs, Paul is, in fact, purveying the work of his brother, Claude, an unbridled sensualist who can't restrain his amorous impulses.

Into this superficially elegant universe comes a hard-boiled American reporter, a top model plotting revenge, police inquiries and scheming siblings.

Who knew that couture could be so cut-throat?

The Durrells in Corfu, Season 2 on Masterpiece

Sundays at 8 p.m. beginning October 15

It was a dark and stormy night—in Corfu, of all places! A spooky séance in wild weather is just one of the many adventures, along with otter breeding, a cricket showdown and a search for romance.

Inspired by the beloved memoirs of Gerald Durrell, this tender drama features Keeley Hawes as Louisa Durrell, the harried widowed mother of a brood of recalcitrant children (this season ages 12 to 22) who moves the floundering family from England to Corfu in the mid 1930s to recharge their lives. Gerry is the wildlife-obsessed youngest, who later penned his reminiscences of the family's unusual exploits; Margo is a man-mad teen; Leslie is the hunter-turned-distiller-turned-fashion-photographer; and Larry, who in real life, went on to make a name for himself as the bohemian novelist Lawrence Durrell.

Season 2 finds the family in dire financial straits, as usual. They have a new landlady, an island beauty who holds a mysterious grudge against Louisa. Desperate to come up with the cash for the rent, Louisa

embarks on a bold strategy: sell homemade British delicacies at the village market. Meanwhile, Louisa is being courted by handsome British ex-pat Hugh (Daniel Lapaine, *Zero Dark Thirty*), who has an olive press, drives a red MG and wants to sweep her back to England. The plot thickens when Louisa's dead husband gets back in touch, and an international incident threatens when the expats and Greeks organize a “friendly” cricket match. **Season 1 is scheduled on Saturdays at 11 p.m., concluding October 14.**

impressive buildings in the ancient world. They use their laser technology to scan Djoser's Step Pyramid at Saqqara, Meidum's collapsed pyramid, the mysterious Bent Pyramid at Dashur and the famous Great Pyramid at Giza and finally, establish the true location of the King's Burial Chamber in the Great Pyramid.

St. Paul's Cathedral

Thursday, October 12 at 10 p.m.

Burrows takes his team of experts to this iconic cathedral in London, famed as the location of the marriage of Prince Charles and Lady Diana Spencer. They venture inside the majestic dome to explore its groundbreaking three-part structure; determine how the cathedral's architect, Sir Christopher Wren, overcame unstable foundations and immense structural forces to support his dome; and investigate how the cathedral survived a direct hit by a German bomb during the London Blitz. The laser scans produce genuine revelations and give the team new insight into this iconic architectural masterpiece.

Petra

Thursday, October 19 at 10 p.m.

The team of laser-scanning experts ventures to Jordan to scan the ancient desert city of Petra. Using 3-D laser-scanning technology, Burrows wants to uncover the city's construction secrets and shed new light on this architectural wonderland lost to the West for more than 1,000 years. How did Nabatean stonemasons carve Petra's largest building – the Monastery – out of a mountainside? And what lies hidden underneath the city?

Colosseum

Thursday, October 26 at 10 p.m.

Burrows takes his team to Rome to understand what this gigantic arena once looked like and how it worked. With the help of the team from the Center for Advanced Spatial Technologies at the University of Arkansas and the data they collect, Burrows is hoping to determine how the Romans created magical illusions on the stage at the Roman Games, how the roof of the Colosseum really worked and how it compares to today's modern stadiums. The team uses their high-tech scanning equipment to build up a 3-D digital model of the entire site, revealing any special markings that might help uncover the answers to these mysteries.

Time Scanners

Thursdays at 10 p.m.

With cutting-edge technology that can “read” buildings, ruins and landscapes from ancient worlds, this fascinating series reveals physical and forensic history, allowing viewers to reach out and touch the past. Paving the way for an exciting new approach to documentary filmmaking, new laser technology explores the world's most iconic sites in a way never before seen, surprising even the experts. Steve Burrows, one of the world's foremost structural engineers, leads a team of investigators including pioneering laser-scanning researchers to unlock the secrets of the world's greatest engineering achievements. Each episode provides unprecedented answers to the scientific secrets behind the historical landmarks.

Egyptian Pyramids

Thursday, October 5 at 10 p.m.

The team travels to Egypt to scan the pyramids — the tombs of the mighty pharaohs — to find out how the necropolises evolved from simple mud-brick structures to the most

tell their very personal experience of Patrick's decline from alcohol and marijuana use, into opioid and heroin addiction. A close-knit family, the Mullins watched their son grow from a happy infant into a star lacrosse player and student. But even as he was surrounded by a loving family and friends, his addiction took over his life. A panel of experts discusses the drug epidemic in the U.S. and offers advice about how to recognize the signs and symptoms of drug abuse, and cutting-edge information on prevention and effective treatment. According to the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, heroin-related overdose deaths have more than quadrupled since 2010.

Hooked Rx: From Prescription to Addiction
Sunday, October 15 at 2 p.m.

This special investigative project delves into the destructive epidemic of prescription opioid addiction, produced by more than 100 journalism students at Arizona State University. For nearly four months, students crisscrossed the state to produce a multimedia investigation into Arizona's – and the country's – dependence on prescription pain medication and the toll addiction takes on families and patients. The program explores the root of the heroin epidemic with in-depth interviews with recovering prescription pill addicts, law enforcement, government officials, doctors and public health experts.

Sight: The Story of Vision **Sunday, October 15 at noon**

Sight is arguably our most important sense, an extremely complex process, which requires light that can start with photons, generated in distant stars and ending in the visual cortex of our brains. In the middle of this process are our eyes. This hour-long documentary looks at the science, medicine and technology of vision and the individuals who are battling the darkness of blindness. The story's threads will weave the tale of the journey of humanity that discovered the science, along with the technology and medicine that allows us to understand how sight works, cure diseases of the eye and correct vision.

This second annual all-star concert offers a primetime spotlight for the Academy's 2017 Special Merit Awards recipients. The celebration, led by GRAMMY®-winning industry icon Paul Shaffer as musical director, was recorded in July at New York's Beacon Theatre. 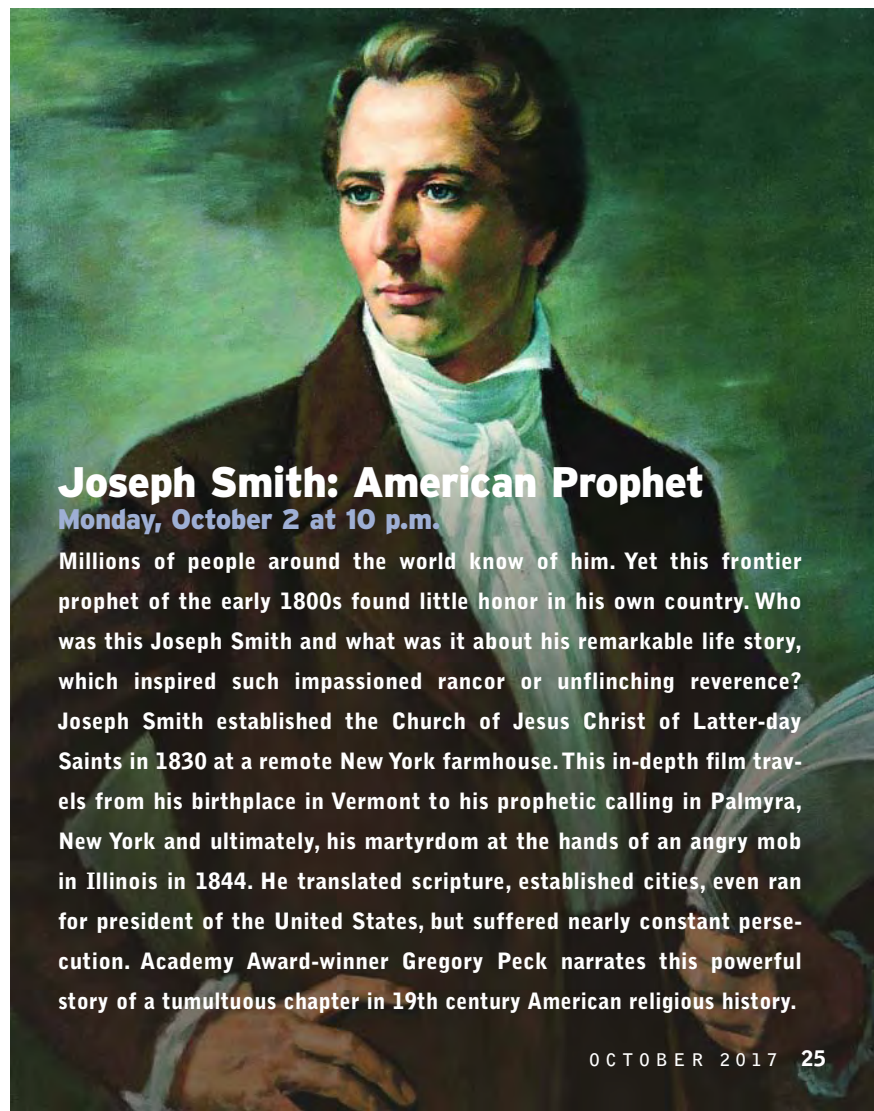
The Vietnam War

Millions of people around the world know of him. Yet this frontier prophet of the early 1800s found little honor in his own country. Who was this Joseph Smith and what was it about his remarkable life story, which inspired such impassioned rancor or unflinching reverence? Joseph Smith established the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints in 1830 at a remote New York farmhouse. This in-depth film travels from his birthplace in Vermont to his prophetic calling in Palmyra, New York and ultimately, his martyrdom at the hands of an angry mob in Illinois in 1844. He translated scripture, established cities, even ran for president of the United States, but suffered nearly constant persecution. Academy Award-winner Gregory Peck narrates this powerful story of a tumultuous chapter in 19th century American religious history.

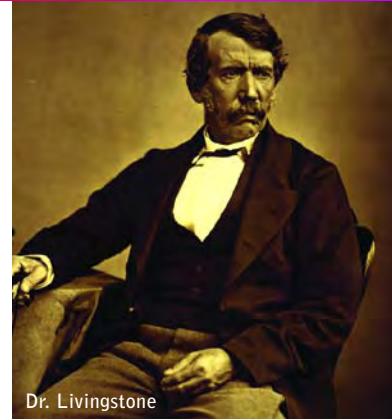

Secrets of the Dead: The Lost Diary of Dr. Livingstone

Monday, October 16 at 10 p.m.

In the late 19th century, Livingstone was a popular hero of the era: a celebrated explorer, Christian missionary, staunch abolitionist and pioneering doctor. But was he really the national hero people made him out to be? On his last trip to Africa, Livingstone witnessed and documented an event that changed the course of history. His account of the mass slaughter of the village Nyangwe horrified the public and ultimately led to the end of the African slave trade. But Livingstone may not have told the entire story of the massacre in his journal. Livingstone's private diary – containing his first-hand account of the massacre – has recently been discovered. 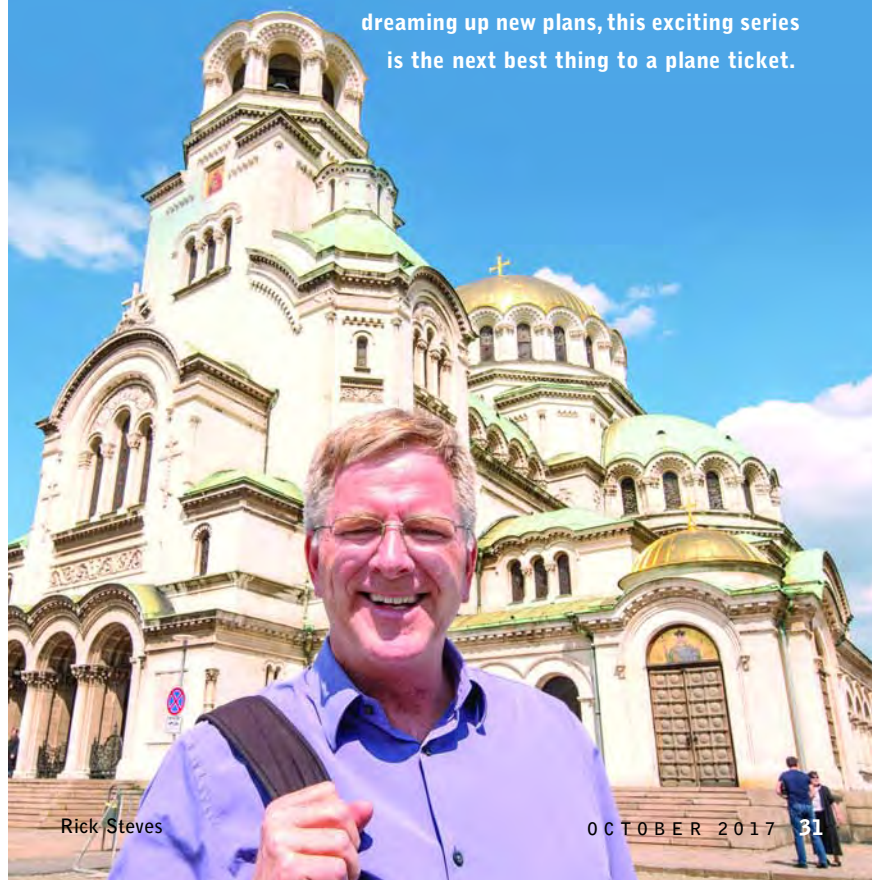

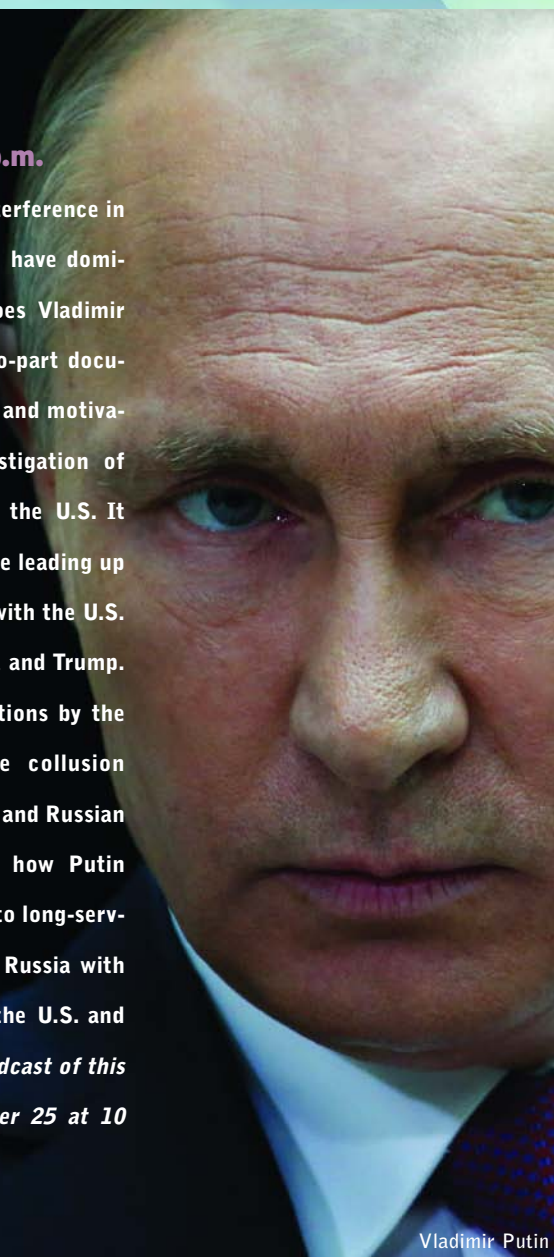
