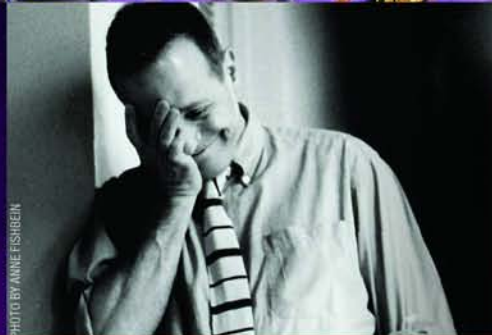

A Message from the General Manager

Public Media = Public Safety

Every year, millions of visitors attend a convention in Las Vegas. Two of the city's largest conventions — the International Consumer Electronics Show (CES) and the National Association of Broadcasters Show (NAB) — combined with the annual PBS Technology Conference, make Las Vegas a national hub for technology conventions. Vegas PBS has leveraged these conventions by offering to demonstrate and experiment with promising new technology and in the process, became a national leader in public safety and educational technology applications.

For example, "datacasting" — the broadcasting of data to computers within a TV signal — was developed by Vegas PBS as an emergency communications service. When disasters hit, state emergency management officials can tap into our public television transmitter to deliver messages to the public and first responders when cellular networks are overwhelmed by customer calls and texts. Vegas PBS was the first station to make bandwidth available to emergency responders during crises and to provide them with preselected multimedia data in the form of blueprints, photos, key personnel and emergency plans.

In the event of a public safety incident, Vegas PBS can securely transmit critical information — hidden in our broadcast signal — directly to the Clark County School District police, the Las Vegas Metropolitan Police Department or the Southern Nevada Counter-Terrorism Center. Vegas PBS systems were recently utilized by emergency managers during a mercury contamination at a local public school and during the Carpenter 1 Fire on Mount Charleston.

In part due to the success of this lifesaving application first created at Vegas PBS, the national PBS network is currently included in a proposal that would make all PBS stations part of the new FirstNet public safety communications system for first responders.

In addition to the emergency alerts you hear on Channel 10, Vegas PBS also uses our television signal to send backup public safety messages to mobile cellular devices during extreme weather conditions or AMBER alerts. The grant-funded PBS Warning, Alert and Response Network (WARN) is used by public television stations across the country to broadcast geo-targeted wireless emergency alert messages directly to cell phone towers, making public television a potentially lifesaving resource, even for people who might never turn on a television.

The public service impact of public television goes far beyond the high-quality entertaining and educational broadcast television programs your membership supports. The less-visible public safety technology applications are a critical part of our mission as a nonprofit public service media organization. The broadcast technology infrastructure we use to transmit your favorite television programs also helps emergency management agencies, first responders and law enforcement keep our community safe. April is Disaster Preparedness Month, and through your support, Vegas PBS is prepared to keep you and your loved ones safe.

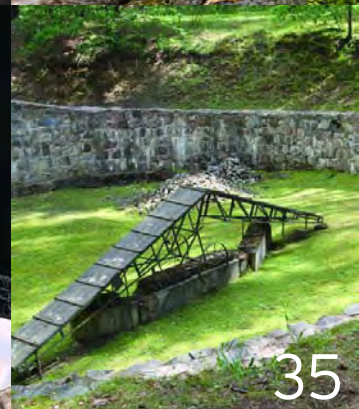

Sundays at 8 p.m. in April

With brand new seasons of our critically-acclaimed dramas, along with encore presentations of several popular series, we have something you are sure to love on Sunday evenings. Why go anywhere else?

This phenomenal British drama returns for an all-new sixth season. Based on the best-selling memoirs of Jennifer Worth, the series follows the lives of a group of midwives working in the poverty-stricken East End of London.

It's 1961 and Poplar is beginning to feel the winds of social change, along with improvements in housing, sanitation and healthcare. Among the complex and challenging cases the nurses and midwives face are two babies born with severe deformities.

Home Fires on Masterpiece, Season 2

Sundays at 9 p.m.

Samantha Bond (*Downton Abbey*) and Francesca Annis (*Reckless*) head an extraordinary cast in a moving drama about women in an English village facing the onset of World War II. The new season opens in June 1940, when Great Britain faces the threat of imminent invasion, standing alone against German forces. The Battle of Britain rages in the skies overhead and with daily air-raids, the threat of invasion and defeat is palpable. For some of Great Paxford's women, the war throws off peacetime limitations, allowing them to flourish in unexpected ways. As Britain finds itself increasingly beleaguered, the tightknit community will be tested as never before.

Homicide, blackmail, greed, and betrayal: just a taste of what goes on behind the well-trimmed hedges of the wealthy, isolated English county of Midsomer in this deliciously sinister series.

Jesus of Rome

Tuesday, April 4 at 8 p.m.

The final week of Jesus' life — known as Holy Week — stands at the very center of Christianity. But what do we know about what happened in the prevailing months? New evidence gathered from archaeology, Roman historians, Jewish texts and insights into the Gospels suggest Roman politics led to the series of events that resulted in the crucifixion. Based on *The Lost Gospel* by investigative journalist Simcha Jacobovici and Professor Barrie Wilson, this two-hour drama documentary will present new insights into the iconic Easter events and uncover the Roman power politics that ultimately led to the last days of Jesus. **Repeats Sunday, April 9 at noon.**

The Great War: American Experience

Monday through Wednesday, April 10-12 at 9 p.m.

Drawing on the latest scholarship including unpublished diaries, memoirs and letters,

this special tells the rich and complex story of World War I through the voices of nurses, journalists, aviators and the American troops who came to be known as "doughboys." The series explores the experiences of African-American and Latino soldiers, suffragists, Native-American "code talkers" and others whose participation in the war to "make the world safe for democracy" has been largely forgotten. **Repeats Sunday, April 16 from 1 p.m. to 7 p.m.**

Grand Coulee Dam: American Experience

Tuesday, April 18 at 8 p.m.

During the darkest days of the Depression when construction was started on Grand Coulee Dam, it was to be the salvation of the common man, a dam and irrigation project that would make the desert bloom. Featuring the men and women who lived and worked at Grand Coulee and the Native people whose lives were changed, alongside historians and engineers, this film explores how the crucial

WWII: Behind Closed Doors

Sunday, April 23 from 3 p.m. to 6 p.m.

Joseph Stalin — the supreme leader of the Soviet Union — was a tyrant responsible for the death of millions. Yet he also had some unlikely relationships during the Second World War; not just with leaders of the great democracies like Winston Churchill and Franklin Roosevelt, but also with Hitler and the Nazis. This ambitious series lifts the lid on these relationships to reveal the true nature of the three leaders and how their meetings — and the decisions they made — shaped the world today.

Command and Control: American Experience

Tuesday, April 25 at 8 p.m.

This special exposes the long-hidden story of a deadly 1980 accident at a Titan II missile complex in Damascus, Arkansas. Uncover the terrifying truth about the management of America's nuclear arsenal and what can happen when weapons built to protect us threaten to destroy us. Featuring the minute-by-minute accounts of those who were on the scene, the film reveals the unlikely chain of events that caused the accident and the feverish efforts to prevent the explosion of a ballistic missile carrying the most powerful nuclear warhead ever built by the United States.

In Celebration of Passover

Sunday, April 9 from 5 p.m. – 7 p.m.

The Four Sons and All Their Sons at 5 p.m.

The Four Sons are the focus of one of the most beloved and intriguing stories in the Haggadah, the book read and sung at the Passover Seder. This beloved short fable follows four boys at the Seder table and how they're treated by their father. The fable has been revised relentlessly over the centuries – in words, in art, in music – until it must be right up there with Shakespeare's plays among the most re-interpreted tales ever told. Why so many versions? Because Passover and its Seder are really about passing on heritage – or any belief – to your chil-

dren. The documentary shows the variety of those versions as it moves constantly from an actual Seder to Four Sons stories in art, words and music to interviewees from ages 17 to 70...and back to the Seder.

Gefilte Fish Chronicles at 6 p.m.

In 1904, Abe and Minnie Dubroff immigrated from Russia to Brooklyn where they raised seven daughters and a son. For a century, the family has gathered at Passover and celebrated the Seder together. Led by the three surviving sisters, Sophie Patasnik, Peppy Barer and Rosie Groman, traditional



preparations were made as they shopped and chopped, tasted and seasoned. Using recipes nearly a century old, they began to put together the Gefilte Fish, Cholent, Horse Radish and Sponge Cake. This is a loving, living album of the Seder, filled with joy and love, family films and photographs. Although this is a tale about one family, it crosses cultural and religious lines, reminding us of how many families develop rituals as they celebrate holidays.

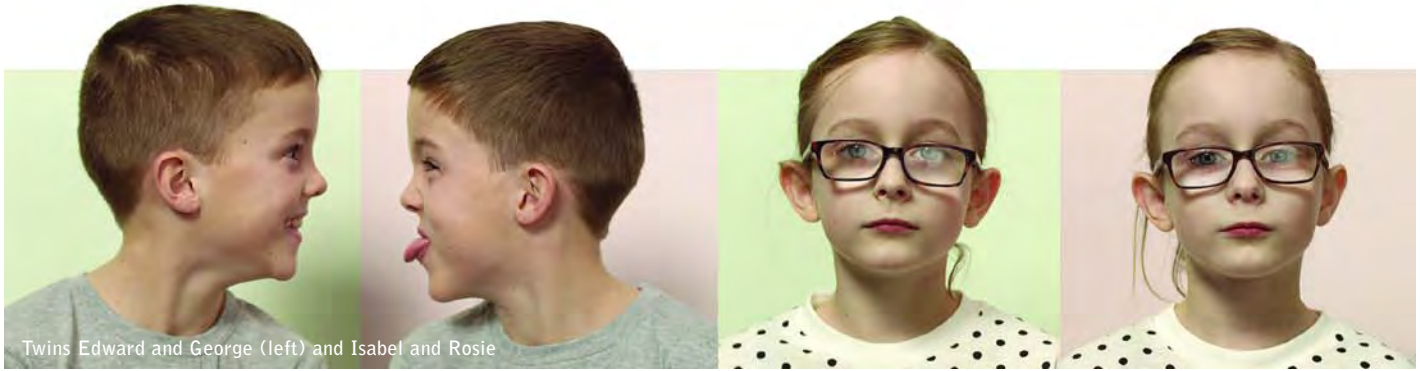

Through raw and heart-breaking interviews with parents, siblings, teachers, doctors and first responders, Newtown documents a traumatized community still reeling from the senseless tragedy, fractured by grief but driven toward a sense of purpose.

There are no words of compassion or reassurance that can bring back those who lost their lives during the shooting at Sandy Hook

Elementary School. Instead, Snyder delves into the lives and homes of those who remain, all of whom have been indelibly changed by the events. They speak candidly about their grief, anger and disbelief over what occurred and their disappointment that nothing has truly changed with regard to the country's legal response to gun violence.

Most people know Vegas PBS for the non-profit educational, informational and cultural television programs broadcast on Channel 10, or on our companion channels: Create, VEGAS PBS KIDS, Rewind and Jackpot! Vegas PBS' vision as a public service media organization is to be a leading information technology resource, online education provider and preferred community partner for those engaged in addressing Southern Nevada issues. Beyond the airwaves, however, are 300 individuals who dedicate their time and talents as volunteers for the work of Vegas PBS.

Station volunteers are as diverse as our programming. They include people of all ages and backgrounds. Some can spare a lot of time; others only a little. But one thing they all have in common is their eagerness to serve the Vegas PBS community. We have had the unique pleasure of individual volunteers as well as collaboration with volunteer groups that include collegiate associations, restaurants, senior centers, retired service organizations and fellow non-profit corporations.

Volunteers provide a unique opportunity for public television stations to expand the reach of our mission and to directly impact more community members. Volunteers are the heart of all that we do as a public service media station. Every department benefits from the loyalty of our station volunteers. This group, formerly known as the Friends of Channel 10, encouraged public private funding partnerships, funded replacement equipment and led the capital campaign for our current building. 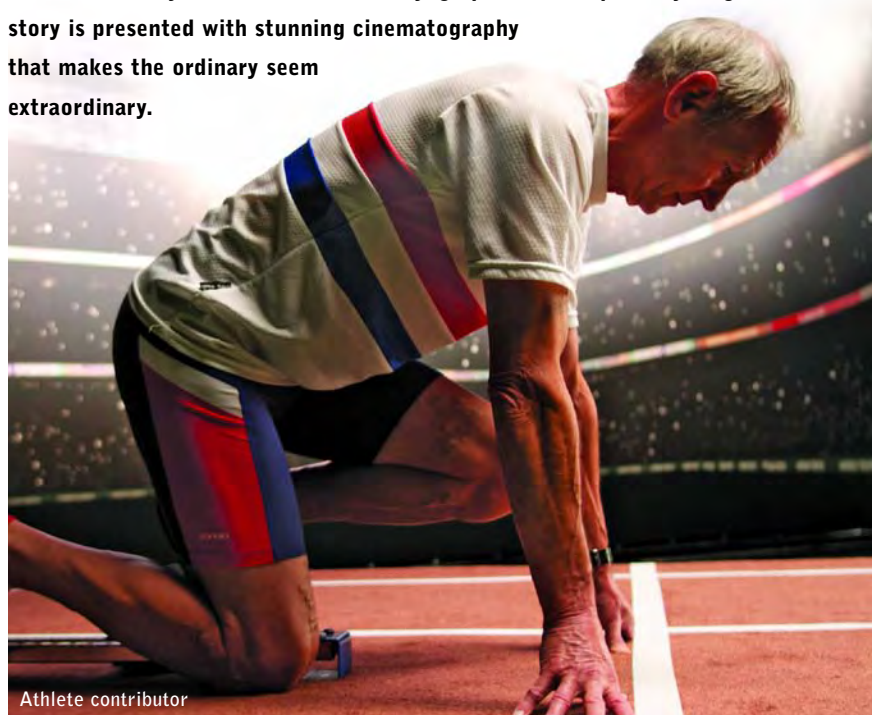

FRONTLINE: Last Days of Solitary

Tuesday, April 18 at 9 p.m.

In solitary confinement, inmates are kept inside a cell that is approximately 80 square feet for about 23 hours a day. Cells are furnished

with a bed, sink and toilet, but rarely much else. Food is delivered through a slot in the door, and each day inmates are allowed just one hour of exercise, in a cage. Supporters say the practice helps keep prisons safe, but according to the medical literature, solitary confinement can also take a heavy mental toll. Follow what happens to recently released prisoners when they go from solitary to the streets. With extraordinary access to the Maine State Prison, the film examines the long-term effects of solitary confinement and efforts to reduce its use.

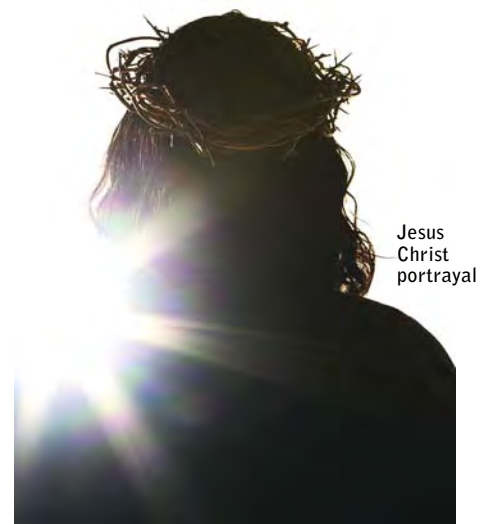

and determination. Then at **2 p.m., Goering's Last Secret** tells the remarkable story of Albert Goring (Goering), the brother of Hitler's henchman, who traded on his brother's name and made it his mission to rescue people from the tyranny of the Nazis.

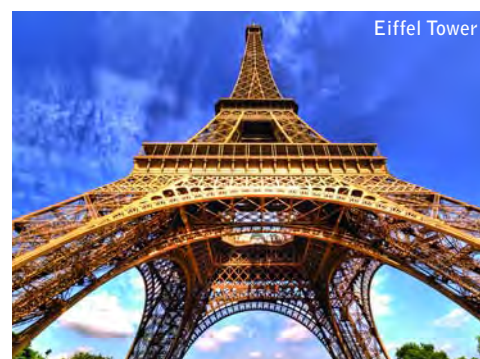
