A Message from the General Manager

In Remembrance of Charlotte Hill

In 1971, Charlotte Hill convened a group of community leaders who founded "Friends of Channel 10" to provide financial support for KLVX, Nevada's first educational public television station – and she never left us. Over the next 47 years, she would dedicate untold hours of support to the station; raise millions of dollars through auctions and wine tastings; recruit a virtual army of volunteers; and troop through the marbled halls of Congress to secure support despite blizzards and thunderstorms.

In addition to her support of our local station, she held numerous leadership roles with National Friends of Public Broadcasting. It was in that capacity that we first met nearly 40 years ago. In national PBS circles, Charlotte was well-known for her pragmatic support of best practices, innovation in PBS fundraising, and active engagement of local volunteers. In fact, the National Friends named their annual Volunteer of the Year award in her honor.

When I started at Channel 10, I had already known Charlotte Hill for almost two decades, but I would soon learn much more. Charlotte was a constant and passionate companion, advisor, historian and friend. Remarkably, her dedication to the community extended far beyond our station. Charlotte was known to many for her civic leadership, tenacity and commitment to the organizations she loved. In March 2009, the State of Nevada issued a Concurrent Resolution in recognition and appreciation of her "magnanimous volunteer support of education in Nevada."

Because of her support and advocacy, thousands of economically disadvantaged children have been able to attend the Sun Summer Camp, experience performance art through Allied Arts, or receive scholarships to CSN and UNLV. Multiple generations of young people have received education and inspiration through organizations such as Girl Scouts, Boys and Girls Clubs, United Way of America, Economic Opportunity Board, and Variety Early Learning Center. In many cases her name is on the founding registrations of the organizations and she served each as President or board member.

Charlotte began her philanthropic work in a very small town – a town one-tenth its current size. She resolved to make it more than just a great place to work; she wanted Las Vegas to be a great place to live.

On April 26, 2018, we lost a "founding mother" of Vegas PBS. She will be deeply missed, yet her mark is permanently enshrined in the Charlotte Hill Volunteer Center in our new building, the Charlotte Hill Society, and the blown glass "Blossoming of the Mind" sculpture she challenged the board to fund for our lobby. We are forever grateful for her gifts of service and forever inspired by her passion for this community.

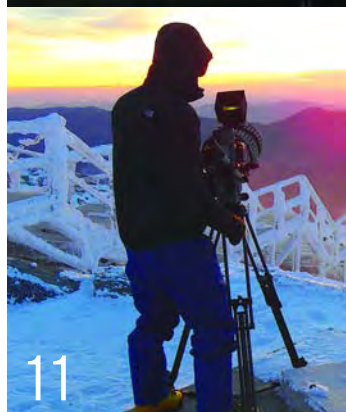

In the aftermath, ill-equipped workers heroically sealed the smoldering reactor in a concrete sarcophagus, but the hastily constructed shelter was only built to last 30 years. Now the sarcophagus is crumbling, and another disaster at Chernobyl looms. An international team of engineers is racing the clock to assemble one of the most ambitious superstructures ever built—an extraordinary 40,000 ton, \$1.5 billion dome to encase the crumbling remains of the Chernobyl nuclear reactor.

Man in an Orange Shirt on Masterpiece

The plot opens on the Italian front near the end of World War II. British Captain Michael Berryman saves the life of a wounded fellow officer. In an era when homosexuality in England was punished by prison, they share a brief, passionate encounter before parting. The second half of the drama skips two generations to the present day. Michael and Thomas have died, and Flora (Redgrave) keeps house with her grandson, Adam, a young veterinarian active in London's gay hookup scene. The story charts the changes and challenges in gay lives in England — from the era of jail terms to the onset of dating apps — and was broadcast to wide acclaim in the UK in 2017 for the fiftieth anniversary of the decriminalization of homosexuality.

Firing Line with Margaret Hoover

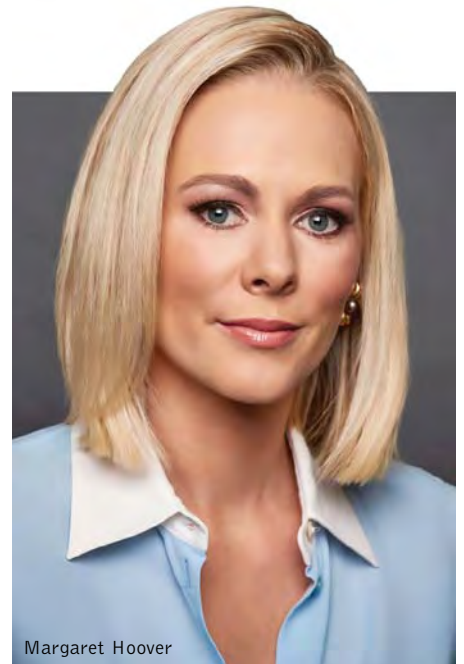
Fridays at 8 p.m. beginning June 22

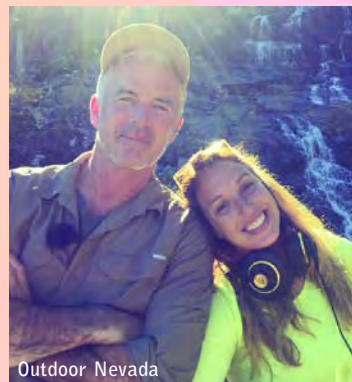

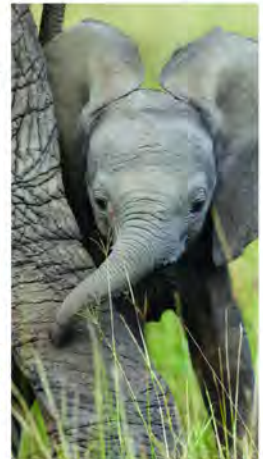

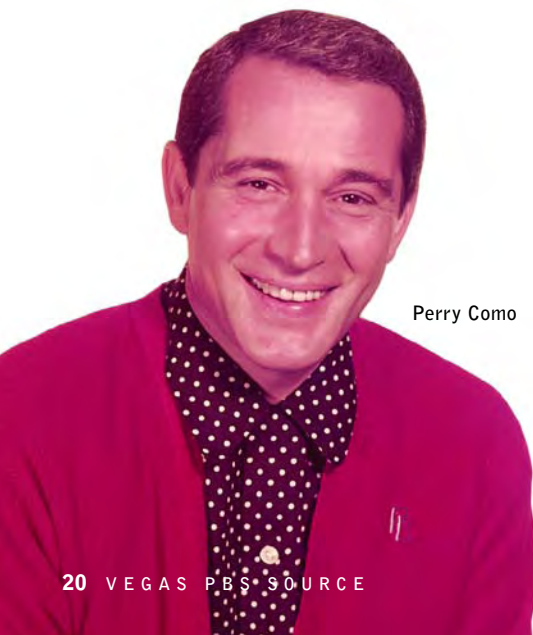

He was lanky, he wore glasses. Aesthetically, Buddy Holly might have been the most unlikely looking rock 'n' roll star of the 1950s. But he was, after Elvis Presley, unquestionably the most influential. It was an all-too-brief career that lasted barely 18 months, from "That'll Be The Day" topping the Billboard charts to the plane crash in February 1959 in Iowa that took Holly's life. This film tells the story of Buddy Holly's tragically short life and career through interviews with those who knew him and worked with him. This combined with contributions from music fans paints a picture of an artist who changed music. Rock 'n' roll started with Elvis, but pop music started with Buddy Holly and The Crickets.

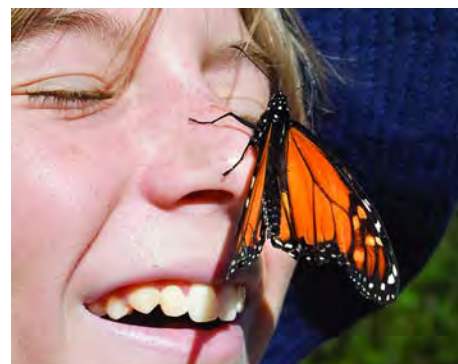
