









A Message from the **General Manager**

Celebrating Women's History in Our 50th Year

t is fitting that Fred Rogers adorns this month's cover. His national program debuted 50 years ago, and on March 25, 1968, Channel 10 signed on as Nevada's first educational television station. Fifty years is a long time, and with the support of our viewers, Vegas PBS has transitioned from film, to video tape to digital recording; and from single channel analog black and white, monaural broadcasting to digital high definition, 5.1 surround sound color broadcasting, cable casting and internet streaming. We will celebrate in many ways in the next 12 months, but we want to thank our donors for their steadfast support over the decades.

This year our governing boards are led by women, and our major donor society is named for Charlotte Hill, who founded the Friends of Channel 10 to increase community support for our educational, cultural and public affairs programming. Thus, we kick off our 50th anniversary celebrations during Women's History Month by presenting programs that highlight the vital contributions of women across the globe and examine the important ways they have influenced our history and are shaping our future.

Two featured documentaries share stories of remarkable women who were often overshadowed by their charismatic husbands. Anne Morrow Lindbergh: You'll Have the Sky uses Anne's own words to help convey the inner life of the acclaimed author and the challenges of being part of America's most famous couple. In Untold Stories: Mina Miller Edison, the Wizard's Wife, diaries and personal letters reveal Mina's accomplishments and struggles, the lasting impact of her charity work, and her influence on her husband and his inventions.

Other films tell the history of extraordinary women who shaped our country. Dolores Huerta co-founded the first farmworkers union with César Chávez and led the fight for racial and labor justice. Peter Bratt's film, **Dolores**, is presented by **Independent Lens**. We will host a special screening of the documentary on Thursday, March 15 at 6 p.m. at Springs Preserve. Details are at VegasPBS.org/indie. We are also pleased to sponsor the Nevada Women's Film Festival's screening of **Dolores** at Eclipse Theaters on Sunday, March 25. Visit nwffest.com for those details.

Another American legend, Wilma Mankiller, overcame rampant sexism and personal challenges to become the Cherokee Nation's first woman Principal Chief in 1985. Mankiller reveals how she fought injustice and gave voice to the voiceless. Women Outward Bound chronicles the experiences of the first group of young women to participate in the survival school course, and reveals the lessons they learned during their one month in the woods that eventually changed the course of history.

In addition to these powerful new programs, we will rebroadcast **MAKERS**, a national documentary series featuring groundbreaking American women in different spheres of influence. We will also air two local productions about Southern Nevada influencers. MAKERS: Women in Nevada History, a co-production with UNLV, showcases women who shaped Clark County from a vast desert populated by small towns and few residents into the world-famous and unique destination it is today. Finally, Women in Gaming, recorded live at the Mob Museum, highlights the role women played in the gaming industry throughout the state of Nevada.

Thank you for your crucial financial support of public service media for 50 years. Your support allows us to partner with our university, museums, film festivals and others to produce and broadcast historical documentaries like those featured during Women's History Month. 



Remembering Vietnam: Las Vegas Veterans

Thursday, March 29 at 8 p.m.

This new local documentary explores the experiences of several Las Vegas veterans during the Vietnam War era. Their stories cover their enlistment, basic training, combat

and the aftermath of their military experience.

When we first approached the local Vietnam veterans about sharing their stories, many of the veterans didn't want to talk about it. Some of them insisted that they have put the war behind them and want to keep it there. For many vets, war is not a topic they wanted to share with their wives or children. That is why so many veterans have found it easier to pretend they never served. Consequently, people are often shocked to find out after many years that neighbors, friends and coworkers are Vietnam veterans.

The truth is that they think about the war every day, still trying to figure it out. But the memories are indeed painful: of friends lost, of lives changed, of endless fear and stress, the guilt of surviving, the reception received when they came home, accusations that they lost their war, anger over the way the war was fought and things they were asked to do. For some of the veterans, attempts to tell their stories have gone badly. Listen now as they finally share their experiences.







Rise and Fall of the Brown Buffalo

Friday, March 23 at 9 p.m.

This is a fresh and genre-defying film about the life of radical Chicano lawyer, author and countercultural icon Oscar Zeta Acosta — the basis for the character Dr. Gonzo in *Fear and Loathing in Las Vegas*, written by legendary journalist-provocateur Hunter S. Thompson. Acosta's powerful literary voice, brash courtroom style and notorious revolutionary antics made

him a revered figure within the Chicano movement of the 1960s and 70s, and offered one of the most brazen assaults on the status quo and white supremacy seen at the time. Phillip Rodriguez brings Acosta to life by employing a cinematic style as unorthodox as his subject: weaving archival footage and images with dramatized portrayals of Acosta, Thompson and other key figures and moments of the era.

Sarah Lancashire stars as Catherine Cawood, a police sergeant in a small town where drunkards, drug addicts and teenage pregnancies are a way of life. Meanwhile, quiet middle-class accountant Kevin Weatherill feels underappreciated and underpaid at work. Desperate to give his daughters a decent education, he asks for a pay rise so he can send them to private school. But when his wealthy boss Nevison refuses, something finally snaps for Kevin and he enlists the help of local drug lord Ashley to kidnap Nevison's daughter and hold her for ransom. Things quickly spiral out of control when Ashley involves Tommy Lee in the plan. How far will any of them go to get what they really want?





Monday, March 5 at 6 p.m.

This critically-acclaimed film uses the rat to burrow into the dark, complicated history of Baltimore. It explores how racial segregation, discriminatory lending practices known as "redlining" and environmental racism built the Baltimore that exists today. In Baltimore, just as in many other urban areas, rats are part of the daily lives of residents. Some have learned to live with them, domesticating rats as pets. Others hunt them for sport, using blowguns and fishing rods. What begins as an examination of our interactions with rats becomes an investigation into the history of the city, and the systemic racism that established the low-income and predominantly black neighborhoods that are still plagued by rats today. In one of the film's most shocking sequences, 2015 Baltimore city statistics are superimposed over old redlining maps, exposing a haunting correlation to present-day urban issues and the neighborhoods formed decades ago.
