A Message from the General Manager

Summer of Space

Paradoxically, the cover of this month's magazine features nostalgic travel along the historic routes of steam locomotives, and I am writing about travel and exploration in outer space. In its day, the transcontinental railroad revolutionized travel, agriculture and commerce; forever changed the habitats through which it ventured; and caused the incorporation of the City of Las Vegas in 1905. Three score and four years later, on July 20, 1969, Apollo 11 landed on the moon, inspiring a new generation of explorers and entrepreneurs with "one giant leap for mankind". As the 50th anniversary of the moon landing nears, Vegas PBS is bringing you a Summer of Space, a multiplatform viewing experience that includes new science and history programs for both adults and children.

On Wednesday, June 12, at **9 p.m., Nova: Asteroids: Doomsday or Payday?** explores how would-be asteroid miners dream up their own program to scout for potentially profitable asteroids, perhaps involving Nevada's world class mining corporations. Then at **10 p.m., Farthest – Voyager in Space** shines a light on the epic NASA mission launched in 1977 that revolutionized our understanding of the galaxy.

On Wednesday, June 26, PBS shines a light on the realities of the human experience in space. At **9 p.m., NOVA: First Man on the Moon** gives an intimate portrait of American hero Neil Armstrong with interviews with his family and friends. At **10 p.m., A Year in Space** goes behind the scenes of astronaut Scott Kelly's 12-month stay on the International Space Station. Then, at **11 p.m., Beyond a Year in Space** explores more of Kelly's story with his last day in space and his return to Earth.

Summer of Space programs will stream following each broadcast and be available on VegasPBS.org and the PBS Video App. Vegas PBS station members like you can view every episode on Vegas PBS Passport, our exclusive streaming service available to members who donate \$60 or more annually or make a sustaining donation of \$5 or more monthly.

As part of the Summer of Space, Vegas PBS KIDS will roll out new spaced-themed content beginning this month, including educational resources for families and educators to use all summer long. A special episode of **Ready Jet Go!: One Small Step** airs **June 17 at 12:30 p.m.** The one-hour special features astronomy and scientific exploration. This new program will take viewers on a far-flung adventure, as Jet and his friends journey to the moon where they learn about Neil Armstrong and the Apollo 11 mission. The special will air on Vegas PBS KIDS and stream for free on the PBS KIDS Video app and pbskids.org. Three free science learning apps for telephones and mobile tablets are also available including Ready Jet Go! Space Explorer, Bot Builder and Space Scout.

Stay tuned next month for even more cosmic programs. July will feature the highly anticipated **American Experience** six-hour film, **Chasing the Moon**, by Academy Award nominee Robert Stone. The film thoroughly reimagines the race to the moon for a new generation, upending much of the conventional mythology surrounding the effort. Don't miss an advanced look at the series with **PBS Previews: Chasing the Moon on June 5 at 9:30 p.m.**

Whether you love trains or space ships, Vegas PBS invests your donations in programs that provide thoughtful and thought-provoking science programs to all Southern Nevadans throughout the summer and beyond. We also explore changing social values, relax with music, cooking and drama, and reflect on the civilizations and wars in our past. We are a target in a cosmic shooting range. In a collision with Earth, asteroids could set off deadly blast waves, raging fires and colossal tidal waves. But some asteroids are loaded with billions of dollars' worth of elements like iron, nickel and platinum. minute to protect the craft from radiation; to the near disasters at launch; to the emergency maneuvers to fix a crucial frozen instrument platform, viewers get a sense of how difficult — and rewarding — space exploration can be. Featuring a soundtrack of evocative period music including songs from Pink Floyd, stunning cinematography and original groundbreaking photographs taken by the twin spacecraft, the film tells the story of one of humanity's most ambitious scientific endeavors. *Repeats Friday, June 14 at 3:30 p.m.*

NOVA: First Man on the Moon

Wednesday, June 26 at 9 p.m.

This is an intimate portrait of Neil Armstrong, the first person to set foot on the moon. The film reveals his achievements as a Navy combat veteran and pioneer of high-speed flight and revisits the final moments of

the Apollo 11 landing, when Armstrong brought the Eagle down safely with seconds to spare. But he regretted that he got so much credit for the team effort that the lunar landing represented. The special also explores the achievements of this quietly effective man following Apollo. This is an inspiring story of heroic risk-taking and humble dedication to advancing humanity's adventure in space.

A Year in Space

Wednesday, June 26 at 10 p.m.

Go behind-the-scenes of astronaut Scott Kelly's 12-month stay on the International Space Station where he tests human limits for space travel and lays the groundwork for a manned mission to Mars. nation that stresses self-sufficiency. The long road trip shows us Cuba's vast sugarcane fields and the convoluted geology of mountain ranges, bays and cliffs. Baracoa has its own heritage of mixed Caribbean and African culture, evolving without interference from the outside.

The Road from Oaxaca to Chiapas June 29

The states of Oaxaca and Chiapas in southern Mexico are culturally different from the rest of the country. We descend from the mezcal-producing fields of Oaxaca into the Isthmus of Tehuantepec, where the native culture is dominated by women, then on to Chiapas, where a river town is home to ancient peoples and a most unusual carnival celebration.

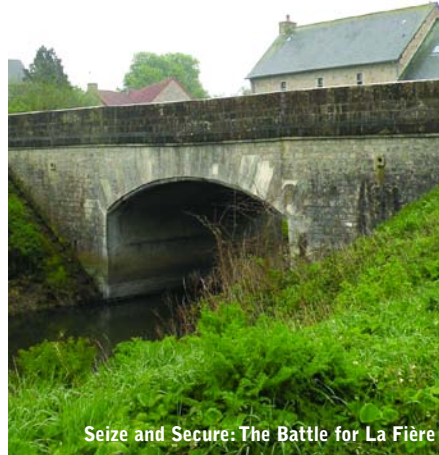

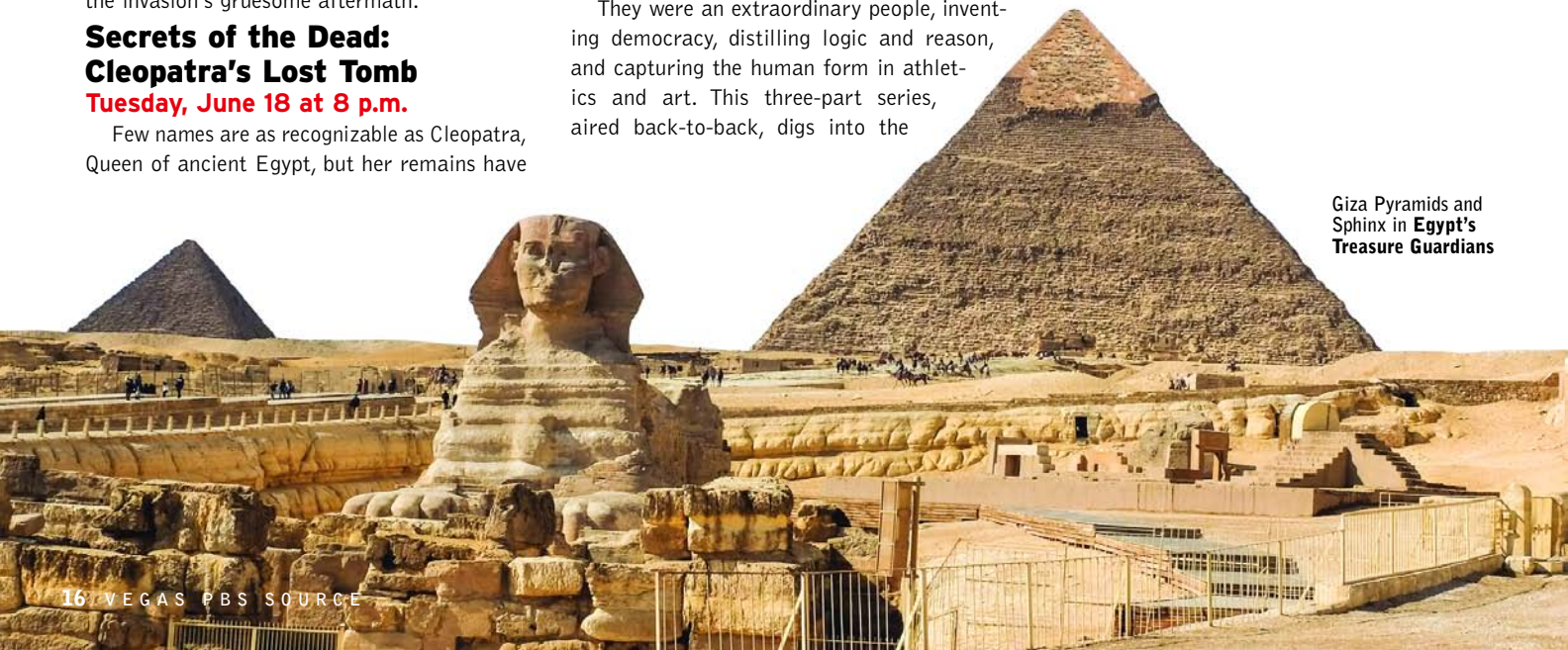

Secrets of the Dead: World War Speed

During World War II, one in three Allied soldiers were incapacitated without a physical scratch on them. Modern weapons and warfare proved so terrifying that almost as many men were shredded by combat fatigue and shell shock — now known as Post Traumatic Stress Disorder (PTSD) — as by bullets and shrapnel. Allied commanders believed that an amphetamine called Bensedrine was the answer, hoping the amphetamine would defeat not just the need for sleep, but anxiety and fear among troops. 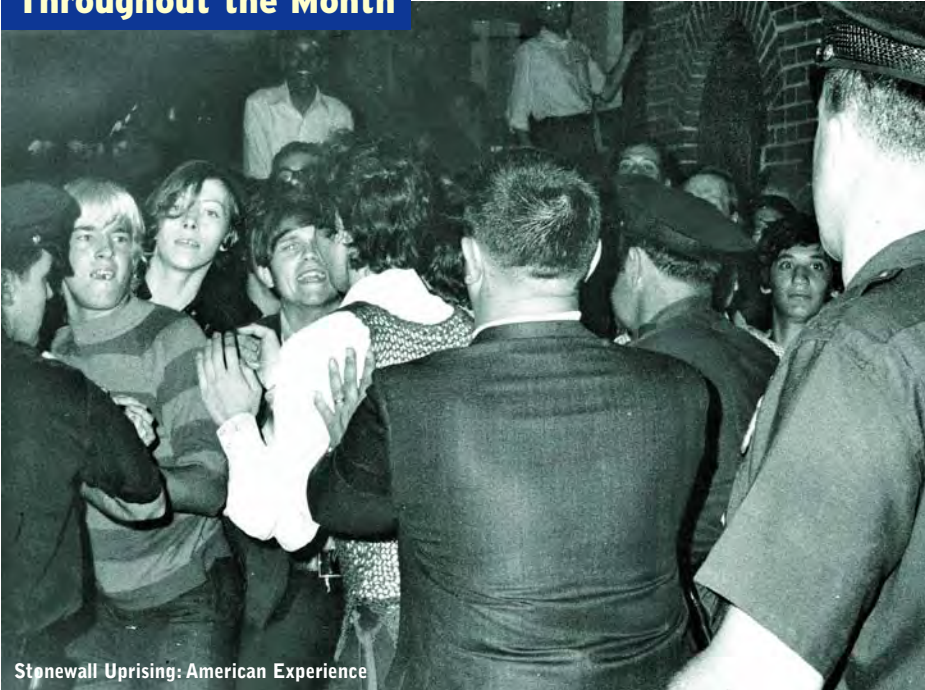
Robert Shaw: American Masters

Stonewall Uprising: American Experience

Month after month, our viewers enjoy programming that embraces diversity and a sense of community. In February, our schedule included documentaries and performances honoring African-American History Month, and in March the PBS series Women, War & Peace gave viewers access to never-before-told stories of international women pioneers. In June and in honor of Pride Month, Vegas PBS will feature a special collection of films that explore the history of the LGBTQI+ rights movement in the United States.

We'll Meet Again: Coming Out Tuesday, June 11 at 8 p.m.

Before the 1970s, being gay in America meant facing widespread discrimination. To come out was to risk everything: family, job and even safety. For two young men growing up in New England, living a life out of the closet was only possible because of the people who helped them open the door. Join Ann Curry as people who first met during the early days of the LGBTQI+ movement reunite. Tom longs to find the friend who helped him accept his sexuality while Paul searches for the student activist whose courage changed his life.

Stonewall Uprising: American Experience Tuesday, June 11 at 9 p.m.

In the 1960s, the vast majority of medical authorities decreed homosexuality a mental disorder and often prescribed brutal treatment, including lobotomy. Homosexual acts

were illegal in every state except Illinois. Police entrapment was rampant, and being arrested meant that licenses to teach, practice law, medicine or cosmetology might be denied.

We'll Meet Again: Coming Out

Even in Greenwich Village, where thousands moved to escape the constant oppression of their hometowns, patrons of gay bars were accustomed to frequent police harassment. But when police raided the Stonewall Inn, a popular gay bar in Greenwich Village on June 28, 1969, patrons for the first time refused to be led into paddy wagons. The street erupted into violent protests that lasted for days, marking a major turning point in the modern gay civil rights movement. Told through interviews with Stonewall patrons, reporters and the police officer who led the raid, the film recalls the fervently hostile climate in which the gay community was forced to live.

Terrence McNally: American Masters Friday, June 14 at 9 p.m.

Explore four-time Tony-winning playwright Terrence McNally's six groundbreaking decades in theater. The film delves into McNally's pursuit of love and inspiration, LGBTQI+ activism, triumph over addiction and the power of the arts. Please see page 27 for details.

The Lavender Scare Tuesday, June 18 at 9 p.m.

In 1953, President Eisenhower declared gay men and lesbians to be a threat to the security of the country and therefore unfit for government service. Over the next four decades, tens of thousands of government workers would lose their jobs for no reason other than their sexual orientation. But the actions of the government had an unintended effect, as they inadvertently helped ignite the gay rights movement. Learn the untold story of how the firing of these federal workers stirred outrage in the gay community, starting an LGBTQI+ rights movement with an unlikely hero at the forefront.

POV: The Gospel of Eureka Sunday, June 30 at 11:30 p.m.

The spotlight is beaming on drag shows and passion plays in an Arkansas town. Narrated with homespun humor by Mx Justin Vivian Bond, this lushly photographed documentary spotlights the space where the town's seemingly contradictory factions intersect: Lee and Walter, out and proud husband-owners of a local gay bar they liken to a "hillbilly Studio 54," talk about their deep-seated faith; a Christian t-shirt designer describes his love for his gay father; and everything comes together in a show-stopping mash-up of a spectacular passion play and raucous drag show. With verve, humor and unflinching compassion, the film builds unexpected bridges between religious faith and sexual orientation.

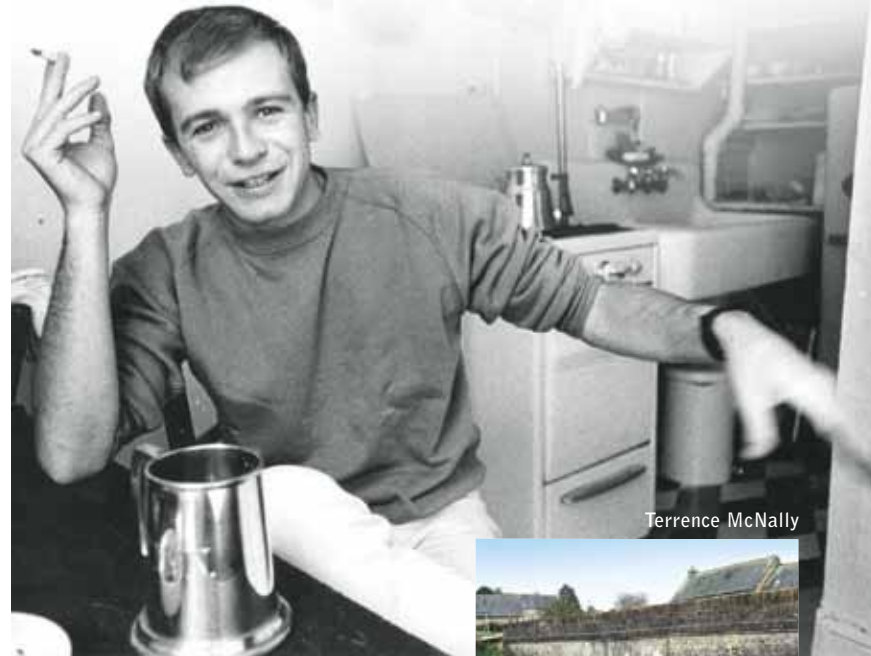

Terrence McNally: Every Act of Life: American Masters

Friday, June 14 at 9 p.m.

Playwright, librettist, scriptwriter and outspoken LGBTQI+ activist Terrence McNally has long believed in the power of the arts to transform society and make a difference. This new documentary lifts the curtain on the life, career and inspirations of the complicated and brilliant Emmy®- and four-time Tony Award®-winning writer. In addition to new interviews with McNally, the film features insights from his friends, his family and some of the most notable stars of stage and screen who he has worked with and mentored. From his troubled beginnings in Corpus Christi, Texas, to his college years in New York City, from traveling the world as the tutor to John Steinbeck's children to having his first Broadway play flop at age 24, the film traces McNally's personal and professional successes, struggles and failures.

Seize and Secure: The Battle for La Fièvre

Monday, June 10 at 10 p.m.

The mortal ferocity of the four-day battle for control of the small stone bridge over the Merderet River at La Fièvre in Normandy is testament to the bridge's strategic importance in the D-Day invasion of June 1944. Without control of the bridge and its vital causeway, American forces coming from Utah Beach would not have been able to force their way inland. Fought largely by paratroopers and glidermen from the 82nd Airborne Division, the battle to secure the bridge at La Fièvre is described as "probably the bloodiest small unit struggle in the experience of American arms." The film draws on historic and contemporary images and footage of the battle scene, as well as eyewitness accounts by WWII veterans who fought there.

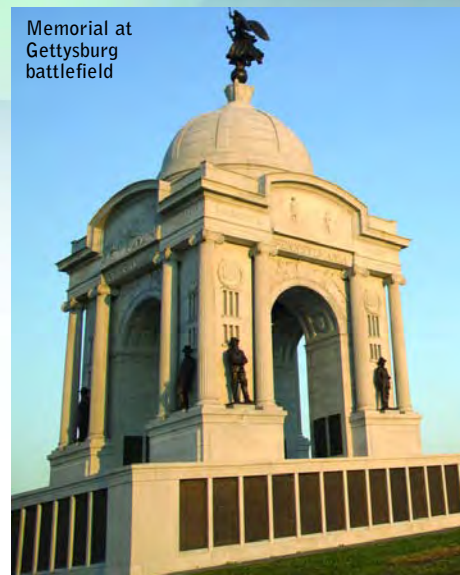
