

A Message from the General Manager

Vegas Golden Knights Help Celebrate our Golden Anniversary

Children's education was the motivating vision for Vegas PBS' founding over 50 years ago. In our initial decade, we combined national programs like **Mister Rogers' Neighborhood** and **Sesame Street** with locally-produced, live classroom instructional courses. Over the decades, our locally-produced formal instructional programs migrated from TV to cable to VHS tape and internet streaming. Thanks to viewer support, research-based national television programs like **Odd Squad**, **Arthur**, **Dinosaur Train**, **Nature Cat** and **Daniel Tiger's Neighborhood** were created to support early childhood education. Each is supplemented with online resources, mobile phone apps and community workshop curriculum to support children, teachers and caregivers.

We now complement our Channel 10 children's programming with the 24/7 **VEGAS PBS KIDS** channel. Young children in our community spend over 3.5 million hours a month viewing these programs on television, and an additional 400,000 hours a month interacting online. Over 85,000 mobile apps have been downloaded. Leveraging your financial gifts for television programming, Vegas PBS has received individual, foundation and corporate grants to provide over 1,000 free educational workshops to underserved families in Southern Nevada each year. The workshops use popular Vegas PBS characters to make learning fun for Pre-K through third grade students. Participants perform hands-on activities and learn to use digital resources to facilitate learning at home. Over 180,000 people attended these Ready To Learn workshops last year, and over 95,000 free grant-funded books were distributed to build at-home libraries.

Our newest technological service will launch this month. **Bright by Text** will provide subscribing parents and caregivers with newborns to 5-year-olds with free texts that contain research-based information and links to trusted resources to support the learning and development of the children in their lives. These tips cover developmental milestones, brain development, social-emotional behavior, nutrition and more. They are curated from PBS KIDS, Vroom, PBSParents, health providers, museums and other experts.

Our commitment to education does not stop during the summer months. On Sunday, June 2, Vegas PBS will kick off summer vacation learning with **Daniel Tiger Be My Neighbor Day**, a free event for the whole family emphasizing acts of kindness in our community. Hosted by the **Vegas Golden Knights** in their practice arena, attendees will have the chance to meet PBS KIDS stars **Daniel Tiger** and **Katerina Kittycat**, see and explore first responder vehicles and tour the City National Arena. Vendors will provide community-focused acts of kindness activities that relate to education in science, technology, engineering, art and math. Join Vegas PBS at **Daniel Tiger Be My Neighbor Day** from 10 a.m. to 3 p.m. and sign up for **Bright by Text**. Learn more at VegasPBS.org/community. Vegas PBS has been a trusted, valued and essential resource for children's education for half a century. 

National Memorial Day Concert 2019

Sunday, May 26 at 8 p.m.

An American tradition, this concert special features uplifting musical performances, documentary footage and dramatic readings that honor the military service of all our men and women in uniform and their families at home. With an all-star lineup, the concert unites the country in remembrance and appreciation of those who gave their lives for our nation and

serves those who are grieving through the mission put forward by Abraham Lincoln in his second inaugural address: "Let us strive on to finish the work we are in; to bind up the nation's wounds; to care for him who shall have borne the battle, and for his widow, and his orphan." **Repeats immediately following at 9:30 p.m.**

The Civil War, a Film by Ken Burns

Sundays, May 19 and 26 beginning at 9 a.m.

The nine-part series explores the most important conflict in our nation's history. The war was fought in 10,000 places, more than 3 million Americans fought in it and over 600,000 men — 2 percent of the population

— died in it. It was the first modern war and, for Americans, the costliest, yielding the most American casualties and the greatest domestic suffering, spiritually and physically. It was the most horrible, necessary, intimate, acrimonious, mean-spirited and heroic conflict the nation has ever known. Please see page 35 for full details on episodes and times.

The People's Protectors

Sunday, May 26 at 2 p.m.

Four Native American veterans reflect on their experiences in the military during the divisive Vietnam War and how their communities helped them carry their warrior legacy proudly. From the Marine Corps to the Navy to the U.S. Army veterans, Valerie Barber, Art Owen, Sandy White Hawk, Vince Beyl and civilian eyapaha (announcer) Jerry Dearly recall their memories of one of the most controversial wars in United States history. Even as they struggled with their relationship to the United States government due to genocidal policies and government oppression, the Dakota, Lakota and Ojibwe warriors still felt compelled to honor their duty to their tribes as protectors of the people. A lifetime later, these soldiers meet and begin to tell their stories.

D-Day at Pointe du Hoc

Sunday, May 26 at 3 p.m.

Learn the remarkable story of the U.S. Army's 2nd Ranger battalion. Led by Lt. Col. James Earl Rudder, the soldiers scaled the 100-foot cliffs of Pointe du Hoc in Normandy on June 6, 1944 to destroy six German cannons situated halfway between Omaha and Utah beaches. Many believed it was a suicidal mission for the men involved. Narrated by actor David McCallum ("The Man from U.N.C.L.E." and "NCIS") and featuring interviews with surviving veterans from the Pointe du Hoc assault, the documentary chronicles

the dangerous and daring mission. Weaving together the first-hand accounts, striking drone footage of the English Channel approach and imposing Pointe cliffs, and rare archival footage of the 2nd Rangers preparing for action, the film shares an incredible story of adversity and courage from World War II. **Repeats Monday, May 27 at 11 p.m.**

Remember Pearl Harbor

Sunday, May 26 at 4 p.m.


Narrated by veteran Hollywood actor Tom Selleck, this special chronicles the personal stories of veterans and citizens who witnessed the surprise attack by the Japanese on the American Pacific Fleet on December 7, 1941, launching the United States into World War II. Using archival footage and photos and graphics, the documentary shows in detail the bombings on Oahu, along with the fiery explosion of the USS Arizona, the sinking of the USS Oklahoma and the attacks on Hickam Field, as well as on other parts of the island. The tragic events and the courageous acts of those who were in or near Pearl Harbor on that day are documented. Included are first-person accounts from sailors, airmen, soldiers and civilians, along with Barbara Kotinek, who was just six years old at the time and lived within eyesight of Pearl Harbor.

Going to War

Monday, May 27 at 10 p.m.

Going to war brings terror, pain and grief, but also exhilaration and a sense of purpose. Authors Karl Marlantes and Sebastian Junger help make sense of this paradox, while military veterans reveal the truths of combat with unflinching candor. The special brings first-hand accounts and an abiding commitment to telling the warrior's story with sensitivity and candor, capturing the gritty mental and physical transformation of troops in training and following them into the transformative experience of combat. By delving into the psychologically complex world of warfare and its aftermath, the film reveals the challenges service members face when they return home and rejoin civilian society, revisit their life goals and aspirations, and ultimately redefine themselves.

Omaha Beach: Honor and Sacrifice

Wednesday, May 29 at 2:30 p.m.

On D-Day, a roughly 7,000-yard stretch of beach in Normandy, France proved to be the Allies' biggest obstacle to the success of Operation Overlord. The assignment was to take Omaha Beach, establish a beachhead, and move inland into France. Seven decades after the landing, soldiers who were there on D-Day come back, looking for closure as they enter the final years of their lives. This special shows the very personal stories of several veterans as they return to Omaha Beach and documents the celebration in Normandy that continues to this day as a result of their acts of courage and determination on June 6, 1944.

D-Day: Over Normandy

Wednesday, May 29 at 3:30 p.m.

Narrated by New England Patriots head coach Bill Belichick, this documentary focuses on the personal stories of those who served in the Second World War, and was filmed exclusively by drone camera on location on some of the most iconic locations in Normandy, France including Sainte Marie du Mont, Utah Beach, Brecourt Manor, Sainte Mère Eglise, Pointe du Hoc, Omaha Beach, La Fiere, The Richard Winters Leadership Monument and more. The modern-day aerial footage is accompanied by interviews with World War II veterans, mixed with footage of the June 6, 1944 D-Day invasion, along with maps and photo animations.

Journey Home to the USS Arizona

Wednesday, May 29 at 4:30 p.m.

Narrated by Matthew Broderick, this documentary follows the family of Raymond Haerry Sr. as they travel 5,000 miles from New Jersey to the USS Arizona Memorial at Pearl Harbor in Honolulu, Hawaii to place his ashes aboard the sunken battleship. One of the few remaining crew members from the USS Arizona who survived the Japanese attack during World War II, Ray Haerry Sr. passed away at the age of 94 on September 27, 2016. In April of 2017, his ashes were interred in the USS Arizona, where he rejoined more than 1,000 of his shipmates who lost their lives on that fateful day.

Prohibition: A Film by Ken Burns

Mondays, May 6 - 20 at 10 p.m.

Set in the era of bathtub gin, bootleggers and speakeasies, the series tells the true story of the rise, rule and fall of the 18th Amendment to the U.S. Constitution. It was called the Noble Experiment, but it was in fact one of America's most notorious civic failures, an object lesson in the challenge of legislating human behavior. Prohibition was intended to protect individuals and society at large from the devastating effects of alcohol abuse. Instead, thugs became celebrities and social mores in place for a century were obliterated.

Amelia Earhart: American Experience

Tuesday, May 7 at 9 p.m.

The first woman to fly solo across the Atlantic, Amelia Earhart was one of America's earliest celebrities. After only a few years as a pilot she became the best-known female flier in America, not only for her daring and determination, but also for her striking looks and outspoken personality. Three weeks short of her 40th birthday, Earhart disappeared over the Pacific Ocean, and her story became legend.

Annie Oakley: American Experience

She was the toast of New York, Victorian London, Paris and eventually the world. She was “adopted” by Indian Chief Sitting Bull, charmed the Prince of Prussia and entertained the likes of Oscar Wilde and Queen Victoria. Annie Oakley excelled in a man's world by doing what she loved and won fame and fortune as the little lady from Ohio who never missed a shot. Learn the story of a five-foot, 100-pound sharp shooter who pulled herself out of the depths of poverty to become an iconic performer known the world over as a symbol of the Wild West.

Emma Goldman: American Experience

Tuesday, May 21 at 9 p.m.

For nearly half a century, Russian emigrant Emma Goldman was the most controversial

woman in America, taunting the mainstream with her fervent attacks on government, big business and war. To the tabloids, she was “Red Emma, Queen of the Anarchists,” but many admired Goldman for her defense of labor rights, women's emancipation, birth control and as a fearless writer and merciless publisher.

Rachel Carson: American Experience

Tuesday, May 28 at 8 p.m.

Rachel Carson's “Silent Spring” was published in 1962, a passionate and eloquent warning about the long-term dangers of pesticides. The book unleashed an extraordinary national debate and provoked vigorous attacks from the chemical industry. This prompted an investigation that eventually would result in new laws designed to protect and preserve the environment.

Next Generation TV

Television broadcast is changing. Again.

From the late 1940s through the 1950s all you had to do to watch TV was connect some rabbit ears, or an outdoor antenna, turn on the TV without using a remote and choose one of maybe four or five local channels. Now, a nation-wide change is taking place as broadcast is upgraded to NextGen-TV (ATSC 3.0).

The switch from current HDTV broadcasting to 4K NextGen-TV is a major undertaking that will greatly affect many over-the-air consumers. When broadcasters switched to digital transmission (DTV) in 2009, an FCC-sponsored coupon program allowed consumers to receive a conversion tuner to retrofit their TVs. This time, while tuners will be available, there will be no such coupon program.

Why the Change?

To keep pace with the advance of 4K Ultra HD TVs and 4K content, NextGen-TV is intended to replace the current system. When fully implemented, it is expected to support the following features:

- Over-the-air transmission of TV programming in 4K resolution, as well as HD and SD (digital) simulcasting capability.
- The inclusion of HDR and Wide Color Gamut.
- Compatibility for up to 120 frames per second video transmission.
- The ability to transmit immersive audio including multiple language tracks and other audio enhancements.
- True native 3D transmission capability.
- Supplementary broadcast content on mobile and internet-enabled devices.
- Improved Emergency Alert System for natural disasters or other important events.

NextGen TV Implementation Obstacles

Although NextGen-TV implementation promises to deliver a better, and more flexible, TV viewing experience, it also means another big transition for consumers in terms of how their current TVs will work.

On the upside, as NextGen-TV comes into use, the current DTV/HDTV broadcast system (ATSC 1.0) will continue to be used for transmissions for a period of time, so current TVs will not become obsolete for a while, you just won't be able to access the advanced features offered by NextGen-TV.

However, after it is deemed that there are enough TVs in use that incorporate built-in NextGen-TV tuners, a date will be set where only NextGen-TV standards will be in use.

Once the cut-off date is reached, this would mean that owners of remaining analog, HD and any non-NextGen-TV enabled TVs will need to have external tuners (perhaps as either stand-alone boxes or stick via HDMI connection) in order to receive network and local TV programming over-the-air.

Effects on Vegas PBS

Challenges for broadcasters include major costs and logistics issues. During the transition phase, most TV broadcasters will be faced with having to simultaneously broadcast in both the current and new systems, which will require different transmitters and channels. As part of the transition, many stations will have to change to a different channel frequency as well as share transmission resources with their competitive counterparts at other local affiliates.

But don't get too comfortable with NextGen TV, there are also forces at work that want to make the jump to 8K. Hopefully I'll be retired by then!





In this unlikely setting, David and Hale find a community of other native Hawaiians and discover their indigenous traditions from a fellow inmate serving a life sentence. Hoping for a fresh start and eager to prove that the experience has changed them forever, the two men finish their terms and return to Hawai'i. But once on the outside, each finds life more challenging than they expected. As David and Hale struggle with life's hurdles, they wonder if it's possible to ever go home again.

Norman Mineta and His Legacy: An American Story

This is a documentary portrait of the American statesman and trailblazer. Norman Mineta is a man of many firsts: the first Asian American mayor of a major city (San Jose, California); the first Japanese American from the mainland to be elected to Congress; and the first Asian American to serve in a presidential cabinet. But beyond these groundbreaking achievements, Mineta personifies the dreams and aspirations of many Americans. A U.S. citizen by birth, he was imprisoned by his own country for his Japanese ancestry, yet he steadfastly remained a patriot, leading a Congressional effort for an apology from the U.S. government and redress for Japanese Americans. The film includes interviews with the two presidents under whom he served as a cabinet secretary: Democrat Bill Clinton and Republican George W. Bush.

Forty years ago, a sleepy village in the heart of England was the scene of a gruesome discovery when nearly 300 skeletons were unearthed in a mass grave. Armed with the latest scientific methods, the team uncovers extraordinary human stories from the front line, including evidence of women warriors and a lost king reunited with his son in death. 


