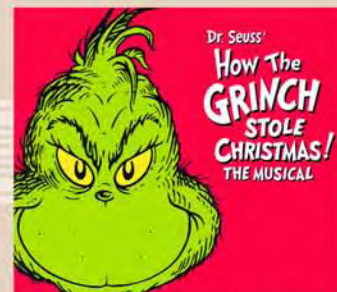

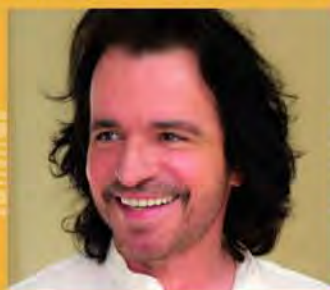

Ken Burns is television's most prolific documentarian, and PBS is the exclusive home he has chosen for his work. Since his first film in 1981, Ken Burns has been telling unique and fascinating stories of the United States.

Ken has provided historical insights on events like **The Civil War**, **Prohibition** and **The Vietnam War**. He has investigated the impact of important personalities in **The Roosevelts**, **Thomas Jefferson** and **Mark Twain**, and signature legacies like **The Brooklyn Bridge**, **The National Parks** and **The Statute of Liberty**. Now the filmmaker explores another thread of the American identity in **Country Music**. Beginning **Sunday, September 15 at 8 p.m.**, step back in time and explore the remarkable stories of the people and places behind this true American art form in eight two-hour segments.

"At the heart of every great country music song is a story," said Ken Burns. "As the songwriter Harlan Howard said, 'It's three chords and the truth.'" **Country Music** traces the origins of this music genre from its early days when it was referred to as hill-billy music, to exploring how Nashville slowly became not just the mecca of country music, but "Music City USA."

It's impossible to tell the story of any popular music form without Southern Nevada. As you watch **Country Music** you will spot a familiar locale. Co-producer Dayton Duncan traveled here to interview Hank Williams and Merle Haggard when they were performing at the Golden Nugget Hotel & Casino. They reminisced about performing with the genre's finest musicians. This was one of Merle's last interviews. Other artists you will see in this series include Dolly Parton, Loretta Lynn, Charlie Daniels, Brenda Lee, and more.

Accompanying Burns' film is a robust educational initiative designed to engage teachers and students through multiple platforms, including the free educational resource site, PBS Learning Media. This service is invaluable to Southern Nevadan teachers. The site provides thousands of teaching resources to inspire students including videos, lesson plans and interactive games aligned to state school standards.

Ken Burns' **Country Music** is also a fantastic opportunity to watch in an all new way: streaming on the PBS Video App. The app is free to download on iOS, Android, Roku, Apple TV, Amazon Fire TV and Chromecast and has thousands of hours of free programming. You will be able to stream the first four episodes of **Country Music** beginning the night of the premiere. As a \$60 or more member of Vegas PBS, you can also activate your Vegas PBS Passport account to gain access to on-demand streaming to more than 1,500 episodes of your favorite programs, including all eight parts of **Country Music**.

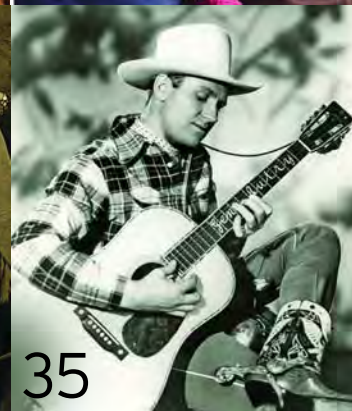
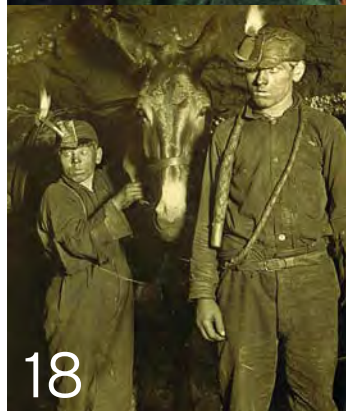

Country Music: A Film by Ken Burns

Sundays thru Wednesdays, September 15-25 at 8 p.m.

Step back in time and journey through the compelling history of a truly American art form in this sweeping new eight-part, 16-hour film directed by Ken Burns, and produced by Burns and his long-time collaborators Dayton Duncan and Julie Dunfey.

The documentary chronicles country music's early days, from Southern Appalachia's songs of struggle, heartbreak and faith to the rollicking Western swing of Texas, California's honky-tonks and Nashville's "Grand Ole Opry." The film follows the evolution of country music over the course of the 20th century as it eventually emerges to become "America's music."

The series digs deep to uncover the roots of the music, including ballads, minstrel music, hymns and the blues, and its early years in the 1920s, when it was called "hillbilly music,"

and was recorded for the first time and played across the airwaves on radio station barn dances. It explores how Hollywood B movies instituted the fad of singing cowboys like Gene Autry and shows how the rise of juke joints after World War II changed the musical style by bringing electric and pedal steel guitars to the forefront.

The documentary features interviews with more than 100 people, including 40 members of the Country Music Hall of Fame (17 of those interviewed have since passed on). Among those storytellers are historian Bill Malone and a wide range of country artists such as Marty Stuart, Rosanne Cash, Vince Gill, Reba McEntire, Merle Haggard, Dolly Parton, Willie Nelson, Dwight Yoakam, Emmylou Harris, Kris Kristofferson, and Naomi and Wynonna Judd,

as well as studio musicians, record producers and others. The film uses more than 3,200 photographs and over two hours of archival footage, including rare and never-before-seen photos and footage of Jimmie Rodgers, Johnny Cash and others.

At its heart are the unforgettable songs and the artists who created them: their emergence from humble beginnings, their musical influences and their breakthrough moments. Much like the music itself, the film also tells the remarkable stories of hardships and joys shared by everyday people. Ken Burns notes, "At the heart of every great country music song is a story. As the songwriter Harlan Howard said, 'It's three chords and the truth.'"

The Rub (Beginnings - 1933)

Sunday, September 15 at 8 p.m.

What was first called "hillbilly music" reaches new audiences through phonographs and radio and launches the careers of country music's first big stars, the Carter Family and Jimmie Rodgers.

Hard Times (1933 - 1945)

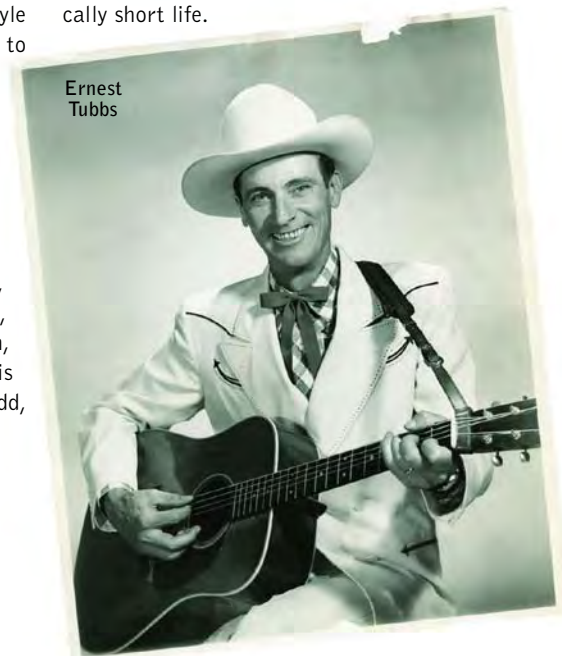
Monday, September 16 at 8 p.m.

Nashville becomes the heart of the country music industry. The genre grows in popularity during the Great Depression and World War II as America falls in love with singing cowboys, Texas Swing and the Grand Ole Opry's Roy Acuff.

The Hillbilly Shakespeare (1945 - 1953)

Tuesday, September 17 at 8 p.m.

The bluegrass sound spreads in post-war America, and meet honky-tonk star Hank Williams, whose songs of surprising emotional depth are derived from his troubled and tragically short life.

I Can't Stop Loving You (1953 -1963)

Wednesday, September 18 at 8 p.m.

Travel to Memphis, where Sun Studios artists Johnny Cash and Elvis Presley usher in the era of rockabilly. Ray Charles crosses America's racial divide by recording a country album. Patsy Cline shows off Music City's smooth new Nashville Sound.

The Sons and Daughters of America (1964 -1968)

Sunday, September 22 at 8 p.m.

Country music reflects a changing America, with Loretta Lynn speaking to women everywhere, Merle Haggard becoming "The Poet of the Common Man" and audiences looking beyond race to embrace Charley Pride.

Will the Circle Be Unbroken? (1968 -1972)

Monday, September 23 at 8 p.m.

Learn how country music responds to a nation divided by the Vietnam War, as Army captain turned songwriter Kris Kristofferson sets a new lyrical standard, and artists like Bob Dylan and the Byrds find a recording home in Nashville.

Are You Sure Hank Done It This Way? (1973 -1983)

Tuesday, September 24 at 8 p.m.

Witness a vibrant era in country music, with Dolly Parton finding mainstream success; Hank Williams Jr. and Rosanne Cash emerging

from their famous fathers' shadows; and Willie Nelson and Waylon Jennings launching the "Outlaw" movement.

Don't Get Above Your Raisin' (1984 -1996)

Wednesday, September 25 at 8 p.m.

"New Traditionalists" like George Strait, Randy Travis and the Judds help country music stay true to its roots. Witness the rise of superstar Garth Brooks and the return of an aging Johnny Cash to the industry he helped create.

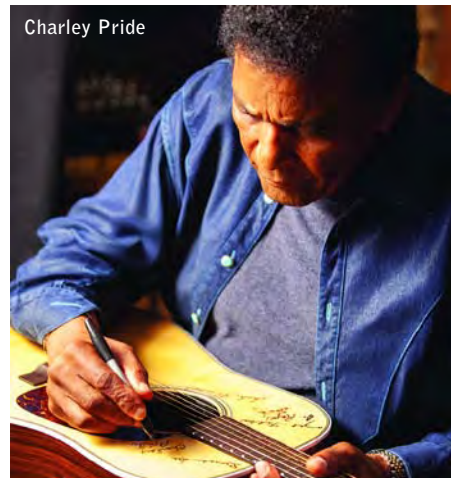

Willie Velasquez: Your Vote is Your Voice Friday, September 20 at 11 p.m.

Throughout American history, Latinos were often kept from the ballot box through poll taxes, gerrymandering and outright intimidation. But drawing inspiration from the Civil Rights movement and Cesar Chavez' farmworkers movement, the Mexican-American activist Willie Velasquez launched a grassroots movement that forever changed the nation's political landscape. With his

rallying cry of “su voto es su voz” (“your vote is your voice”), his Southwest Voter Registration and Education Project (SVREP) launched over a thousand voter registration drives in 200 cities, harnessing the power of the Latino vote in unprecedented ways.

VOCES on PBS Fridays

PBS' signature Latino arts and culture documentary showcase celebrates the rich diversity of the Latino cultural experience.

Children of Giant September 13 at 10:30 p.m.

In 1955, Elizabeth Taylor, Rock Hudson, James Dean and a massive crew descended on the Texas town of Marfa to begin production on “Giant.” It was a different kind of western, one that took an unflinching look at feminism and class divisions. Now, 60 years later, this special returns to Marfa to explore the dramatic story behind the making of the film and its enduring legacy. The program combines interviews with the surviving cast and crew with the recollections of residents, many of whose lives mirrored the controversial themes of racism and segregation explored in the film.

The Pushouts September 20 at 10 p.m.

Victor Rios was a high school dropout, gang member and three-time felon by age 15. But when a teacher's quiet persistence, a mentor's moral conviction and his best friend's murder converge, Rios' path takes an unlikely turn. Twenty years later Rios, by then an award-winning professor, author and expert on the school to prison pipeline, rejoins his old mentor to work with young people who have been pushed out of school for reasons beyond their control. Trading narratives of tragedy and victimization for true stories of grit and resilience, the film highlights the vast potential of young people to thrive when given access to meaningful opportunities and connections to adults who care.

Adios Amor - The Search for Maria Moreno September 27 at 10 p.m.

The discovery of lost photographs sparks the search for a hero that history forgot — Maria Moreno, an eloquent migrant activist and mother of 12. Years before Cesar Chavez and Dolores Huerta launched the United Farm Workers, Maria used the only weapon she had — her voice — and became an outspoken leader in an era when women were usually relegated to the background. The first woman farmworker in America to be hired as a union organizer, Maria's story was silenced and her legacy buried — until now.

Animal Babies: First Year on Earth

September 4 and 11 at 8 p.m.

Like all babies, young animals can have a first year filled with joy, love and play. But there will also be challenges, sometimes on a daily basis. To survive, they must overcome threats and adversities — from rivals, from the elements and from predators. To tell the stories of these magical months, four renowned wildlife cinematographers will travel the globe to follow the lives of six iconic baby animals as they grow and develop. This is the story of what it takes to survive in the wild. This is their first year on earth.

NOVA: Rise of the Superstorms

September 4 at 9 p.m.

In just one devastating month in the summer of 2017, three monster hurricanes swept in from the Atlantic, shattering storm records and killing hundreds of people. First, Harvey brought catastrophic rain and flooding to Houston, causing \$125 billion in damage. Less than two weeks later, Irma lashed the Caribbean with 185 mile per hour winds. Hot

on Irma's heels, Maria ravaged Puerto Rico and left millions of people without power. As the planet warms, are these superstorms the new normal? How well can we predict them? Do we need to prepare for the reality of climate refugees? This special goes inside the 2017 superstorms and the cutting-edge research that will determine how well equipped we are to deal with hurricanes in the future.

NOVA: Treasures of the Earth: Gems

September 11 at 9 p.m.

Their beauty has captivated us for millennia. Their cost can be extraordinary — some are even considered priceless. Precious gems like diamonds, rubies, emeralds, opal and jade are the ultimate treasures of the earth, and each one is made from a specific — and often torturous — recipe of chemistry, pressure and heat. The secrets to their sparkle, color, and even strength lie deep inside the gems themselves, but could they also hold clues to one of the most enduring mysteries in the field of geology?



Magical Land of Oz

September 4 and 11 at 10 p.m.

Across Australia, as the dawn rises the marsupials go to bed — except for the ones that don't — because there are exceptions to every rule in this land of ancient wonders, big skies and jeweled seas. Magic does not have rules. It has splendid dragons, saltwater monsters and dancing spiders. This stunning special offers a blue chip, continent-wide series ranging from the land's highest snow peaks to the depths of the frigid and wild southern seas, from its last populations of wild numbats to its largest diorama of giant cuttlefish. It's a land of diverse beauty, that delights and surprises.

Outback

September 4 and 11 at 11 p.m.

Australia's vast North West corner is a startling landscape, possessing some of the world's most ancient rock. But Australia's Outback is much more than desert and rock. Where it meets the sea, great flocks of shorebirds migrate from the Arctic Tundra and crocodiles predate narrow estuaries. Off the coast, a humpback nursery receives its new arrivals from Antarctica. Below them, elite divers descend in search of the world's most spectacular pearls. The Kimberley region of Western Australia is as large as California with a population of only 40,000 people. It's a frontier existence and it takes a tough hide to survive.

We continue with an encore airing of the entire series of this popular crime drama. We pick up in Season 3 with Endeavour (Shaun Evans) attempting to deal with the aftermath of the tragic events that left him languishing in prison and his senior officer DI Fred Thursday (Roger Allam) with a life-threatening injury. As we move into Season 4, we find them picking up the pieces of their personal and professional lives. It's the summer of 1967, and the effects of the Cold War and '60s counterculture are being felt in Oxford.

Mrs. Wilson on Masterpiece September 1 from 8 p.m. to 11 p.m.

At the outset of World War II, Alison McKelvie took a secretarial job with the Secret Intelligence Service. There, she fell in love with an older man — Major Alexander Wilson, a popular author of spy novels, then doing real intelligence work for the war effort. 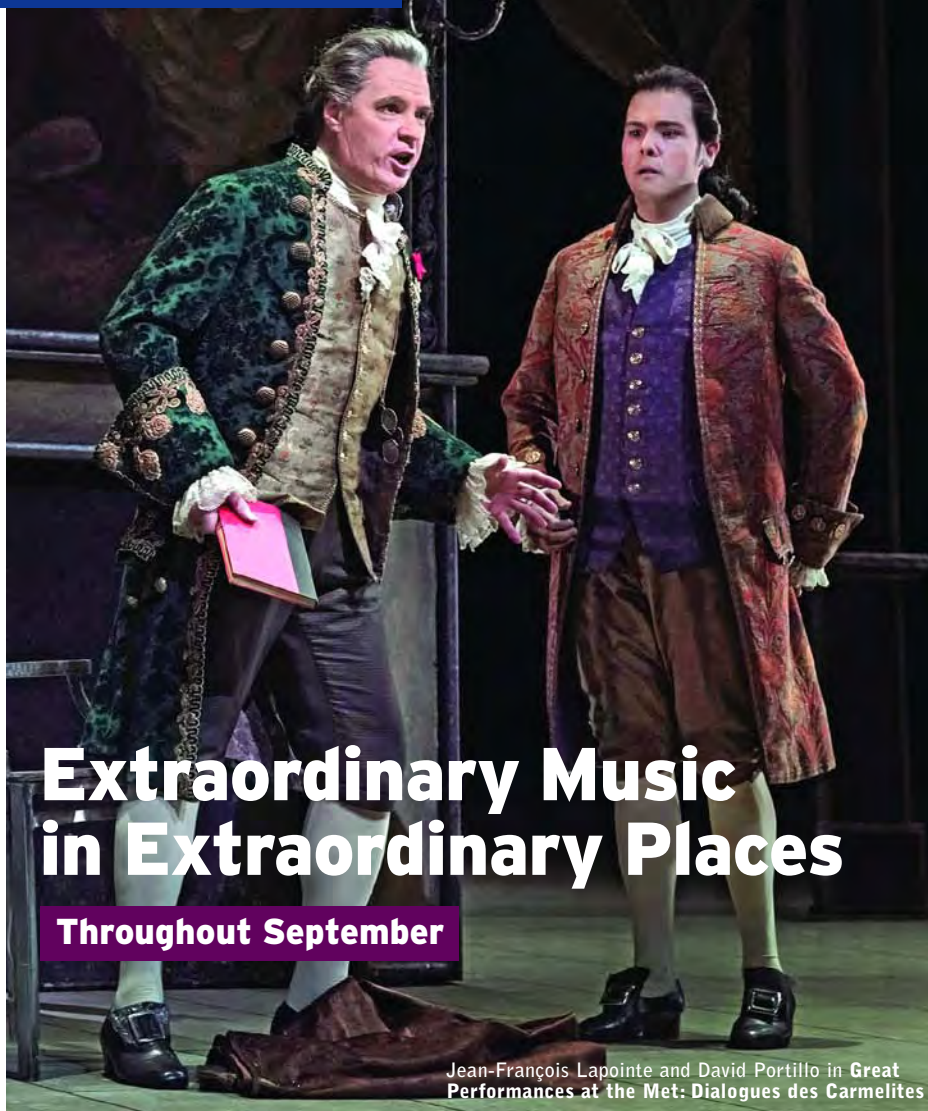

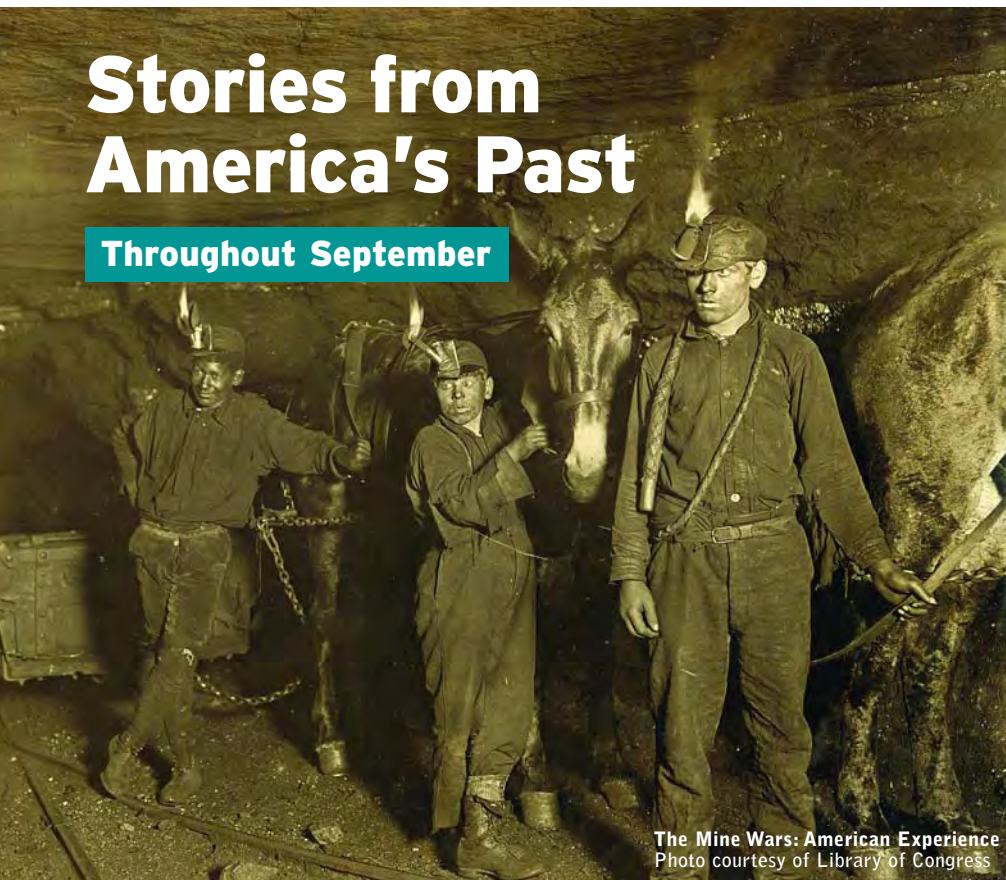

The Mine Wars: American Experience

Prohibition, a film by Ken Burns and Lynn Novick Mondays, September 2 and 9 at 10 p.m.

Learn the story of the rise, rule and fall of the 18th Amendment to the U.S. Constitution. This three-part series explores the extraordinary story of what happens when a freedom-loving nation outlaws the sale of intoxicating liquor — and the disastrous unintended consequences that follow. Prohibition turned law-abiding citizens into criminals, made a mockery of the justice system, allowed illicit drinking to seem glamorous, encouraged neighborhood gangs to form national crime syndicates, permitted government officials to bend and sometimes even break the law, and fostered cynicism and hypocrisy that corroded the social contract all across the country. The film starts with the early history of alcohol in America and examines the 19th-century temperance and progressive movements through the repeal of the 18th Amendment in 1933.

The Mine Wars: American Experience

At the dawn of the 20th century, coal was the fuel that powered the nation. Yet few

Americans thought much about the men who blasted the black rock from underground and hauled it to the surface. This special tells the overlooked story of the miners in the mountains of southern West Virginia — native mountaineers, African American migrants, and European immigrants — who came together in a protracted struggle for their rights. Decades of violence accompanied their attempts to form a union, culminating in the Battle of Blair Mountain in 1921, the largest armed insurrection since the Civil War. The West Virginia mine wars raised profound questions about what freedom and democracy meant to working people in an industrial society. Featured are extensive archival footage, including a recently discovered newsreel of the aftermath of the Battle of Blair Mountain, and interviews with authors, historians and descendants of miners.

Emergency Management Remains Top Priority for Vegas PBS

In today's society, we live ready to expect the unexpected. This new reality makes us question how to best communicate in an emergency situation. September is National Emergency Preparedness Month and as such, a time to highlight the important role Vegas PBS plays in the dissemination of emergency information across our community.

We all run into the problem of sending and receiving too much data — audio, video, text or email. The power of unlimited data becomes vital in times of emergency. Communication is paramount in times of crisis, because we all want to reach someone and often at the same time.

The demands placed on cell towers and/or other communication systems on many occasions exceeds their capacity. Recent memory takes us back to the earthquakes that wreaked unexpected havoc in Ridgecrest, California — a time when communicating with someone in the affected area was a challenge. While this can cause frustration and anxiety for those trying to reach loved ones, imagine the complications for emergency services personnel and first responders who are working diligently to get people into safe areas.

Vegas PBS remains committed to notifying the public through its transmitter with Emergency Alert System (EAS) alerts, and we also serve as backup to the Wireless Alert Reporting Network (WARN) that provides a diverse and redundant path between FEMA and cellular service providers. Those alerts are then sent directly to your cell phone and/or cellular devices, including those being carried by emergency service workers.

Getting valuable and critical information to public safety professionals is mission-based here at Vegas PBS. We have aligned ourselves with partners in the community as well as organizations that assist us in utilizing our digital television signal. The same transmission that brings you and your family some of your favorite and trusted programming, also delivers large amounts of bandwidth and capacity directly to first responders in our community.

The system is called datacasting and it allows real-time, up to the minute transmission of data to emergency responders anywhere in the county that can pick up the Vegas PBS television signal. We are currently working with Clark County School District School Police to deliver real time information that is relevant during school-based emergencies. We have systems in place to deliver information covering school blueprints, floor plans, aerial photography, student emergency contact information, live messaging, streaming video, and even live streaming cell phone video all absent an internet connection that will undoubtedly be congested during said time of crisis.

Vegas PBS is equipped with sufficient bandwidth to accommodate the needs of our community and we hope to partner and collaborate with other emergency-based agencies to expand datacasting, making it available to the emergency services community here in Southern Nevada.

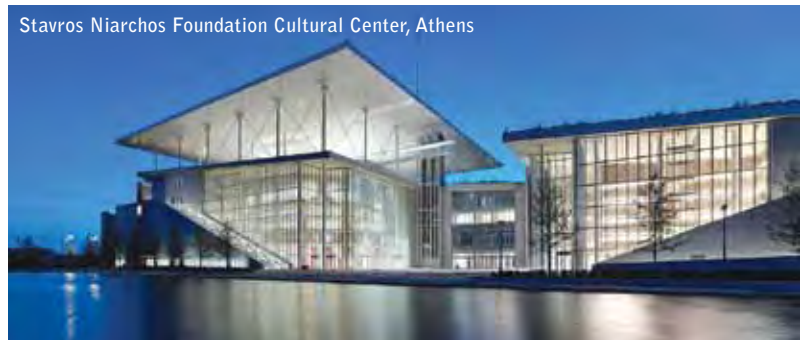

- As long as your gift is made directly from your plan administrator, qualifying IRA gifts will not be subject to federal income tax* and will count toward your required minimum distribution.

* State tax laws vary.

Beneficiary Designation for a Future Bequest

- Anyone at any time can make this kind of gift.
- There is no limit to how much you can give, but you may require spousal approval if the gift is over 50% of the account total.
- Your gift would not be subject to tax (although a comparable gift made to your heirs would be taxable).
