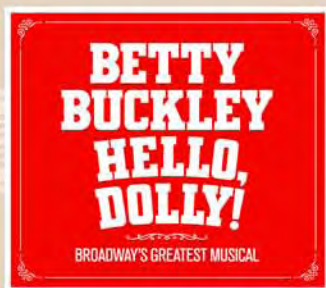

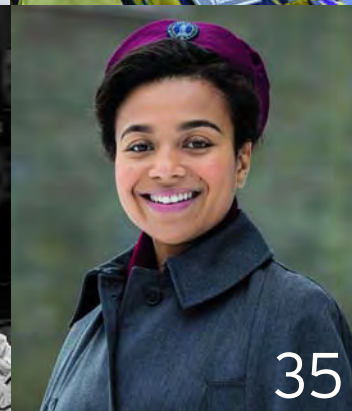

## Great Performances: Birgit Nilsson: A League of Her Own Friday, March 22 at 9 p.m.

This performance-documentary celebrates the life of Birgit Nilsson, the era-defining Swedish dramatic soprano who became the face of opera in the 1950s through the 1970s with her unforgettable voice. Known for her groundbreaking turns in operas such as "Tristram and Isolde," "Elektra," "Turandot," and "The Ring Cycle," along with her larger than life personality and wit, this illuminating documentary about her life in the arts features rare television and archive footage of Nilsson showcasing her remarkable talents. Shot in the locations that Nilsson knew best — the Bayreuth Festival, the Wiener Staatsoper,

the Metropolitan Opera in New York and the farm in Bastad, Sweden, where she grew up — the film also includes interviews with friends and fellow opera luminaries like Plácido Domingo, Otto Schenk, Nina Stemme, Jonas Kaufmann and many others.

## Rita Asfour: Art Her Way Friday, March 22 at 10:30 p.m.

Explore the life of Rita Asfour, a Las Vegas-based visual artist. Rita came out of retirement to paint the city's showgirls after seeing their bedazzling performance at Bally's Jubilee show. Dr. Robert Tracy, of the University of

Nevada, Las Vegas (UNLV), recognized the depth and diversity of her art and curated a show for her. This program takes us into her home where she still creates art today.

## Great Performances at the Met: Samson et Dalila Sunday, March 24 at 9 a.m.

Saint-Saëns's biblical epic based on the tale of Samson and Delila from the Book of Judges is brought to life in this dazzling opera. The production stars tenor Roberto Alagna and mezzo-soprano Elina Garanca in the title roles, with Sir Mark Elder conducting. Darko Tresnjak, who won a Tony Award® for Best Direction of a Musical in 2014 for "A Gentleman's Guide to Love & Murder," makes his Met debut directing a vivid, seductive staging, featuring a monumental setting for the last-act Temple of Dagon, where the hero crushes his Philistine enemies.

## Great Performances: Julius Caesar Friday, March 29 at 9 p.m.

Set in a women's prison, this special offers a powerful dramatization of the catastrophic consequences of a political leader's extension of power beyond constitutional confines through an all-female lens. The cast stars Tony Award-nominee Harriet Walter ("Sense and Sensibility") as Brutus; Jackie Clune ("Borderline") as Caesar; Martina Laird ("EastEnders") as Cassius; and Jade Anouka ("Cleaning Up") as Mark Antony. The women play male inmates and guards: Brutus wrestles with his moral conscience over the assassination of Julius Caesar and Mark Antony manipulates the crowd with subtle and incendiary rhetoric to create frenzied mob violence. The performance creates a unique perspective on Shakespeare's famous discourse on power, loyalty and tragic idealism.

## Black Ballerina Friday, March 29 at 11 p.m.

Sixty years ago, while pursuing their dreams of careers in classical dance, Delores Brown, Joan Myers Brown and Raven Wilkinson confronted racism, exclusion and unequal opportunity in segregated mid-century America. In 2015, three young black women also pursue careers as ballerinas and find that many of the same obstacles their predecessors faced are still evident in the ballet world today. Through interviews with current and former ballet dancers along with engaging archival photos and film, the documentary uses the ethereal world of ballet to engage viewers on a subject that reaches far outside the art world and compels viewers to think about larger issues of exclusion, equal opportunity and change.

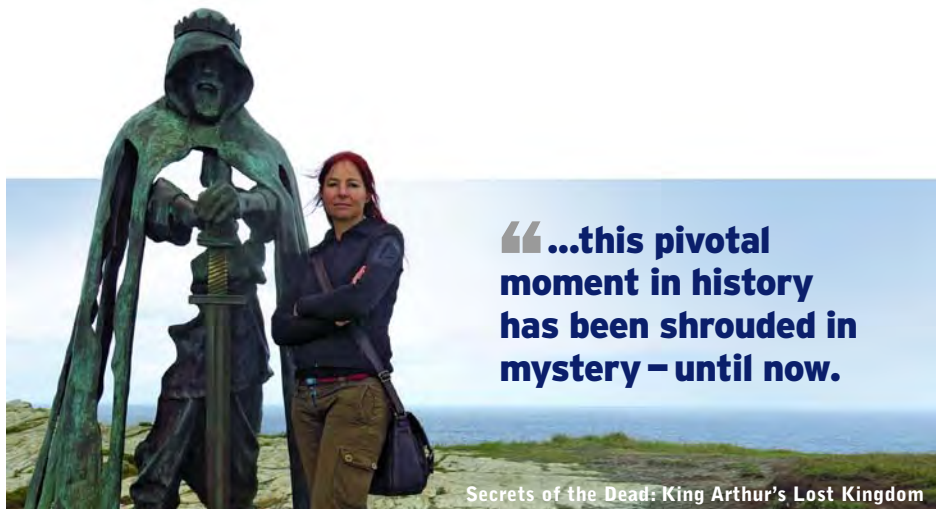

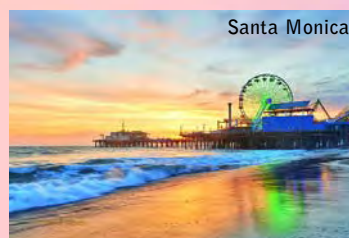

The two eventually join forces and form a highly unlikely and hugely entertaining detecting duo. Frank and Lu quickly discover that all is not as peaceful as it seems in their pretty theatre town. The mayor is murdered, vengeful lovers stalk the streets and a magician's trick fatally misfires. Welcome to the birthplace of the Bard — where fact is stranger than fiction and low-life criminals get caught up in deliciously high drama. Repeats on Mondays at 3:30 p.m.

### FRONTLINE: The Trial of Ratko Mladić

Tuesday, March 19 at 9 p.m.

In the siege of Sarajevo by Bosnian Serb forces in the 1990s, more than 10,000 people died. In the 1995 Srebrenica massacre, more than 7,000 Muslim men and boys were killed. Bosnian Serb General Ratko Mladić stood accused of masterminding those operations and many others during the Bosnian War. He was found guilty by the U.N. International Criminal Tribunal and sentenced to life in prison. This special takes you inside the war crimes trial, with coverage of the prosecution lawyers and witnesses who testify about what they experienced — but, uniquely, also the defense lawyers and Mladić's supporters. The documentary deals with the worst of humanity, but there is a glimmer of light that comes as witnesses come forward to establish the truth of what happened.

# Dick Van Dyke: A Celebration

Saturday, March 9 at 5 p.m.

Dick Van Dyke is a beloved actor, comedian, singer and dancer, whose entertainment career has spanned seven decades. He first gained recognition on radio and Broadway, then he became known for his role as Rob Petrie on the television sitcom "The Dick Van Dyke Show," which ran from 1961 to 1966. ### **Cancer: The Emperor of All Maladies**

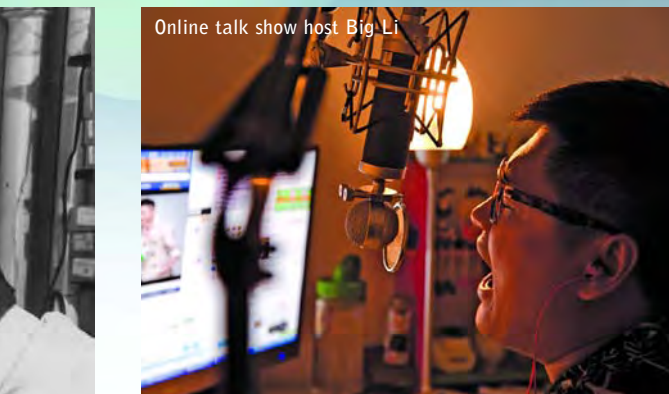
**Mondays at 8 p.m. beginning March 11**
