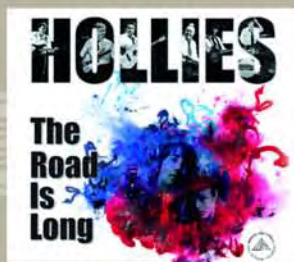

## A Message from the General Manager

### SPRING FOCUS ON HEALTH AND WELLNESS

Long before the Coronavirus epidemic became the lead item in news reports, the national PBS schedule was poised to focus on health and wellness. I was prepared to write this month about the events we and our partners were scheduling to amplify the educational topics from these programs and to allow viewers to connect with local resources. Our events are being cancelled on the advice of health experts, but we are continuing to televise the Vegas PBS Spotlight programs this spring under the theme of Taking Care of You / Health + Wellness. These programs shine a light on some of our community's most pressing health issues, offering insight on impacted populations, highlighting frontline researchers and service models, and offering practical information that you can use in your daily life.

The outbreak of COVID-19 remains top of mind for many in our local community. We have already assembled information on our website at [vegaspbs.com/covid19resources](http://vegaspbs.com/covid19resources) and are adding new information almost daily. Alongside substantive reporting clips from the **PBS NewsHour**, **FRONTLINE**, **Nevada Week** and **Inside Education** are especially charming videos for children and grandchildren in your family featuring **Daniel Tiger**, **Curious George**, **Sesame Street's** Elmo on handwashing, coughing etiquette and germs. This month in our lineup of health-related programs also covers topics from obesity and diabetes, to mental health and beyond.

Definition of **Insanity** on **Tuesday, April 14 at 10 p.m.** follows a team of dedicated Miami-Dade County public servants who work to help people with mental illness navigate from lives of tragedy to possibility. The film explores a humane criminal justice approach to mental health. On **Blood Sugar Rising**, airing **Wednesday, April 15 at 9 p.m.**, we explore the epidemic of diabetes that affects 100 million Americans. You'll learn about the history and science of this hidden crisis and meet some of the faces behind the statistics whose stories bring insights and hope. Then, airing directly after at **11 p.m.**, watch **Parent's Survival Guide: Childhood Obesity** to learn about the multi-faceted solutions for this growing pediatric health problem, specifically the role parents can play as the first line of defense in their children's nutrition and fitness.

Health care delivery will be powerfully impacted by the US Census. Nevada's share of funding for Medicaid/Medicare, maternal and pre-natal programs, Supplemental Nutritional Assistance, educational training for healthcare professionals, and other health and wellness programs will be impacted by the accuracy of our local population count. In the 2010 Census, thousands of residents are believed to have been missed, costing the state hundreds of millions over the following decade. To support the Census, **Nevada Week** produced a program on the subject and we will be airing hundreds of messages from March through May to encourage participation.

With your financial support, Vegas PBS is able to produce and broadcast programs that help ensure a healthy community in Southern Nevada. From awareness of health care challenges to promising scientific research, or from wellness resources to our state's fair share of federal healthcare funding, we will continue to listen to public health concerns and respond with trustworthy programs spotlighting timely and informative content for our viewers. Have a safe month – wash your hands, cover your cough and watch even more Vegas PBS!

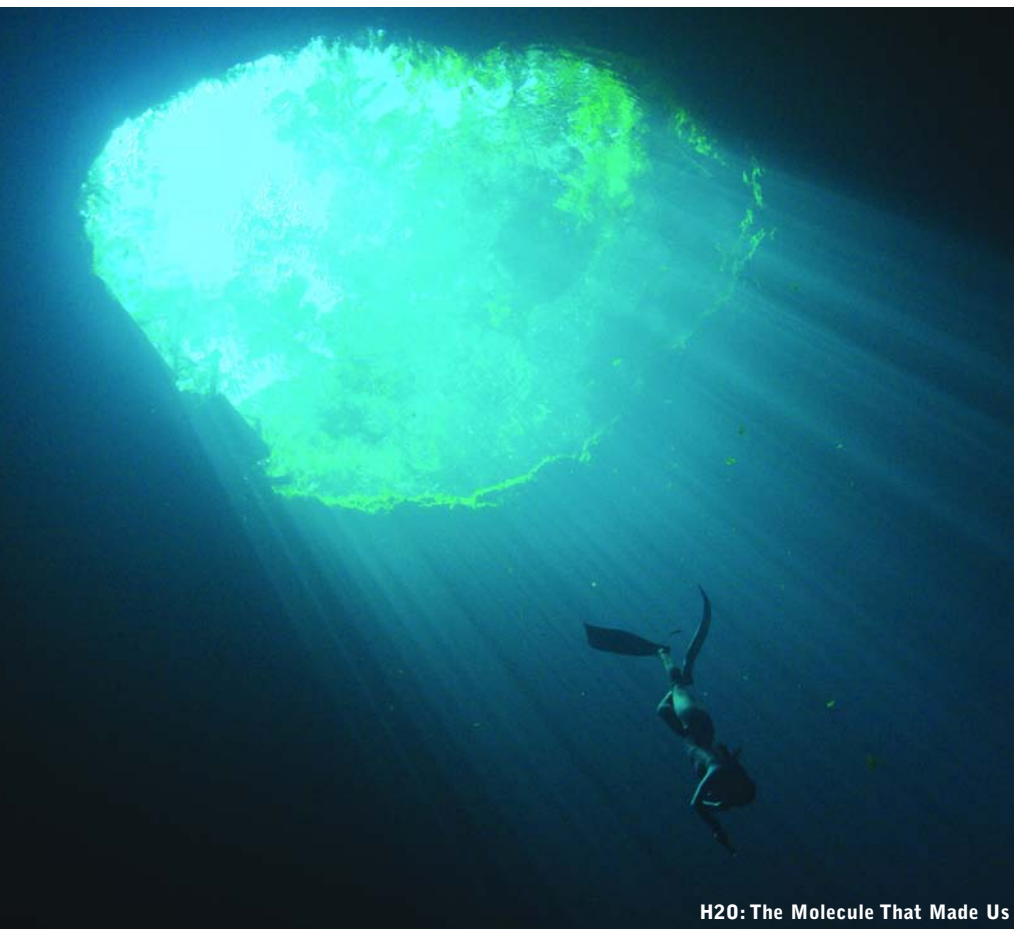

### H2O: The Molecule That Made Us

**Wednesdays April 22 and 29 at 9 p.m.**

Earth is alive because of liquid water and the success of our human story is intimately connected to our relationship with this simple molecule. But the growth of our civilizations has created a dangerous dependence that may be about to run out. This three-part series explores just how critical water is to our survival and the challenges that are facing us. **Repeats the following Fridays at 3:30 p.m.**

### Antiques Roadshow: Treasure Fever

**Monday, April 6 at 8 p.m.**

Catch a case of "Treasure Fever" as the series examines artifacts and artistry with health and medicine history, including surprising historical objects once used for health purposes but not in use today. Finds include a Lakota Sioux doctor's bag, a Civil War medical officer's sword and a Fern Isabel Coppedge oil. Which is valued at \$120,000-\$180,000? **Repeats Saturday at 4 p.m.**

### Broken Places

**Monday, April 6 at 10 p.m.**

This impactful special explores why some children are severely damaged by early adversity while others are able to thrive. A group of abused and neglected children that had been profiled decades ago were revisited. Some of these children were so scarred by abuse and neglect that they are now in mental institutions, correctional facilities or drug rehabilitation centers. A few died prematurely. However, there are others who managed to overcome comparable childhood stress and are now healthy, self-sufficient adults. The film helps to better understand the devastating impact of childhood adversity as well as the inspiring characteristics of resilience.

### Ken Burns Presents The Gene: An Intimate History

### No Evidence of Disease

**Wednesday, April 8 at 4:30 p.m.**

Follow a unique rock band made up of six gynecologic oncology surgeons. What started as a novelty turned into an awareness movement to give a voice to women affected by gynecologic cancers. The intimate, humorous and inspiring documentary interweaves the remarkable courage and harrowing experiences of the women, devoted families and dedicated doctors fighting cancer.

In 1966, drought and an exploding population confronted India with the imminent threat of a severe famine — a potential disaster that many feared only presaged global catastrophes to come, as the world's population outstripped its ability to produce food. In search of a lasting solution, India turned to Norman Borlaug. This special explores the life of the 1970 Nobel Peace Prize winner who tried to solve world hunger. He rescued India from a severe famine and led the "Green Revolution,"

estimated to have saved one billion lives. But his work later faced criticism. **Repeats Wednesday at 2:30 p.m.**

### **FRONTLINE: Opioids, Inc.** **Tuesday, April 21 at 9 p.m.**

Learn how a pharmaceutical company bribed doctors to prescribe the company's lucrative and highly addictive opioid pain killer. With the "Financial Times," the special reveals the inside story of the corruption behind Insys Therapeutics' spectacular rise and the federal prosecution that brought it down.

### **Understanding the Opioid Epidemic** **Tuesday, April 21 at 10 p.m.**

According to the U.S. Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, an average of 115 Americans die of an opioid overdose every day. This special combines stories of people and communities impacted by the epidemic, along with information from experts and those at the frontlines of dealing with the problems. The program will trace the history of how the nation got into this situation and provide possible solutions and directions for dealing with the crisis.

Meet three women who are genetically predisposed to breast cancer. Follow Alejandra, Lilith and Bonnie as they undergo life-altering medical procedures in the hope of reducing their risk — and saving their lives. See page 37 for details.

### **NOVA: Poisoned Water** **Wednesday, April 29 at 10 p.m.**

Water. Turn on the faucet and it's always there. But how safe is our tap water? This special investigates what happened in Flint, Michigan, when local officials changed the city's water source to save money, but overlooked a critical treatment process. As the water pipes corroded, lead leached into the system, exposing the community to dangerous levels of poison. Follow ordinary citizens and independent scientists who exposed the danger and confronted those who turned a blind eye. 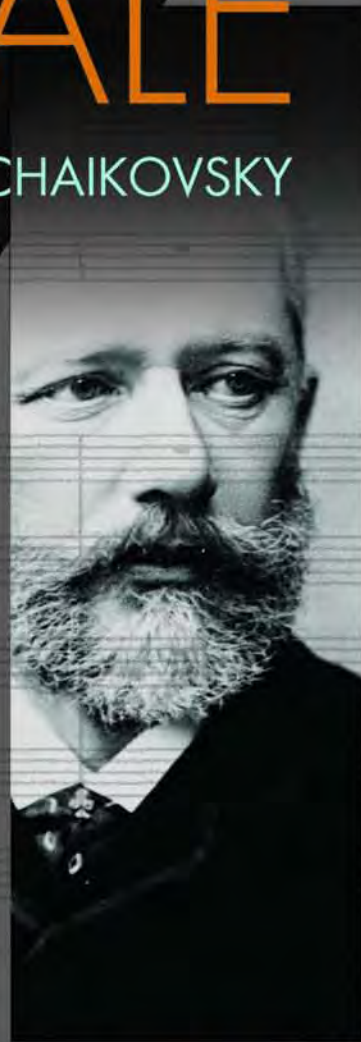

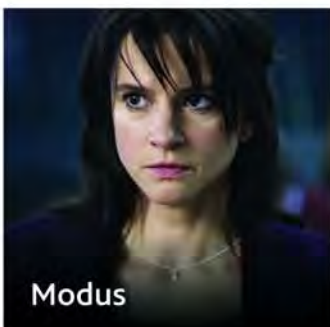

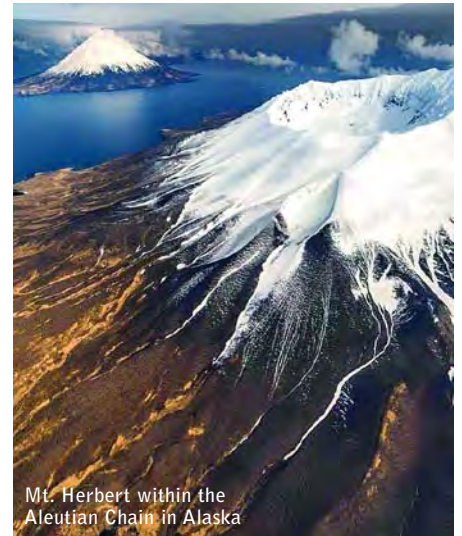
## EPISODES THIS MONTH:

## Fires of Faith: The Coming Forth of the King James Bible Sunday, April 12 at 2 p.m.

Since its original publication in 1611, the King James Bible has had immeasurable influence on religion, language, culture, art and literature, yet its road to influence and acceptance was paved with darkness. International politics, subversion, lust and bloodshed set the stage for the heroic heretics who sought to translate the word of God into the English vernacular. The series crisscrosses a tumultuous Europe at the birth of religious freedom and chronicles characters central to the Reformation, including John Wycliffe, Martin Luther, King Henry VIII and Bloody Queen Mary I, culminating with the reign of King James I and his commissioned translation of the Bible. He then explores inside the depths of one of the ancient silver mines that dot this landscape, following in the footsteps of an army of slaves that once dug silver ore by hand. ### The Durrells in Corfu on Masterpiece Season 1

Let us take you back to the very beginning of this beloved series. In 1935, a beleaguered Bournemouth mother decides to uproot her problematic family and build a new life on the Greek island of Corfu. However, they soon find that island life presents its own problems. Keeley Hawes stars as matriarch Louisa

Durrell, along with her eldest son, Larry (Josh O'Connor), a budding writer on his way to becoming the famous novelist Lawrence Durrell; son number two, Leslie (Callum Woodhouse), an impulsive firearms enthusiast; daughter Margo (Daisy Waterstone), sixteen and man-crazy; and eleven-year-old Gerry (Milo Parker), who only has eyes for wildlife and grows up to be a world-renowned naturalist.

### Call the Midwife Season 9

Sundays at 8 p.m.

The new season of this touching drama continues as the nuns and midwives of Nonnatus House encounter new challenges as the population shifts, rules change and old diseases return. Meanwhile, their own experiences are fueled by love, loss and doubt. Some of the stories this month include the care for a pregnant prostitute after she is caught stealing the team's milk; Lucille delivers a baby in an elevator; four young doctors arrive at Nonnatus House, causing a lot of excitement among the midwives; and a first-time father frustrates Nurse Crane.

### World on Fire on Masterpiece

Sundays at 9 p.m., beginning April 5

This engrossing World War II drama follows the lives of ordinary people coping with

the greatest war in human history. Academy Award®-winner Helen Hunt ("Mad About You") stars as an American broadcaster reporting from Warsaw and Berlin as fighting erupts. Sean Bean ("Game of Thrones") plays a World War I veteran-turned-pacifist trying to cope with chronic shellshock while looking after his working-class family. And Academy Award-nominee Lesley Manville ("Phantom Thread") is a British fascist sympathizer who finds herself sheltering a young refugee.

Set in Britain, Poland, France and Germany, the series traces the interweaved fates of several families in 1939 and 1940, from the Nazi invasion of Poland, to the near debacle at Dunkirk, to the fall of Paris and beyond. All over Europe, no one can quite believe that their normal lives, their everyday pleasures and worries, are about to be demolished. World War II encompassed millions of people and millions of individuals' stories. The series makes this wholesale tragedy achingly personal and, at times, heroic.

### The Windermere Children

**Sunday, April 5 at 10 p.m.**

August, 1945. A coachload of children arrive at the Calgarth Estate by Lake Windermere. They are child survivors of the Nazi Holocaust that has devastated Europe's Jewish population. Carrying only the clothes they wear and a few meager possessions, they bear the emotional and physical scars of all they have suffered. Charged with looking after them is Oscar Friedmann, a German-born child psychologist. He and his team of counsellors have just four months to help the children reclaim their lives.

By the lake, in sunshine and rain the chil-

dren eat, learn English, play football and ride bikes, but they yearn for news of their loved ones every day. A number of the older children steal and they are haunted by nightmares. Nevertheless, it is in this environment that they begin to heal. Eventually, letters from The Red Cross arrive with the terrible confirmation that for nearly all the children their siblings and parents have been murdered. But in the absence of relatives, the children find family in each other. **Repeats Sunday, April 12 at 4 p.m.**

### Baptiste on Masterpiece

**Sundays at 10 p.m. beginning April 12**

One of the best-loved characters of "The Missing" returns in this spinoff series with Tchéky Karyo reviving his role as French detective Julien Baptiste. Tom Hollander ("The Night Manager") and Jessica Raine ("Call the Midwife") round out the cast of the six-part crime drama, set in Amsterdam. Retired and restless, Baptiste is visiting Amsterdam where his daughter has recently given birth. A lunch with old flame Martha Horchner, Amsterdam's chief of police, turns out to be more than a catch-up on old times:

she wants his help finding a missing girl named Natalie and believes the case is connected to a Romanian sex trafficking gang. Julien begins the search, but it's not long before he realizes that all is not as it seems. Why does nobody want to talk about the missing girl? Who is the man following Julien's wife? And who is the mysterious woman who helps the sex industry girls and tells them that Natalie has run away to Germany? As Julien starts to uncover some of the truths behind the lies, he realizes there is more to this case than meets the eye. By the time Baptiste becomes aware of the danger that he is in, his own family is in grave peril.

### Maigret

**Sundays, April 19 and 26 at 2:30 p.m. and 4 p.m.**

Set in Paris in the 1950s, Rowan Atkinson plays the pipe-smoking Chief Inspector Maigret, one of television's classic fictional sleuths from the pen of Georges Simenon. Intuitive, intelligent and with a genius for human nature, Maigret is like no other detective — never failing to pierce straight to the heart of the crime he is investigating. ## HOW WILL COVID-19 IMPACT TAX SEASON?

It's time to file your taxes which normally requires a meeting with your tax professional to review your tax documents and discuss the year gone by. However, with the current virus scare, are there alternatives to the traditional face-to-face meeting? Yes!

**Here are a few things you might consider if you are concerned about your exposure to COVID-19:**

1. You can scan your tax documents into your computer and email them to your CPA. You can follow up with a phone call to discuss the particulars.
2. Organize your documents, including a cover sheet then simply drop off the package without having a formal meeting.
3. It might be time to learn how to do a Zoom meeting, Skype, GOTOMeeting or any one of the virtual meeting options. This gives you the benefits of a face-to-face without the need to be in the same room.
4. Don't forget the retro method of transporting documents: UPS, FedEx, or the US Postal Service. Mailing within city limits only takes a day or two.
5. If it's just all too much right now, you can file for an extension. The extension will give you until October 15, 2020 to finish your personal tax return. In addition, the Treasury has extended the payment date (for any 2019 taxes owed) to July 15th. No penalties for late payment this year! The important thing is staying healthy.

### **New 2020 Tax Law – The Secure Act**

The new tax legislation brings some good news for retirees and retirement plans. Traditionally, when you turned 70 1/2, you were required to begin taking annual distributions from your IRA or 401K plans. The new law changes that requirement to age 72. This only applies to taxpayers who were NOT age 70 1/2 by December 31, 2019. If you are still working at age 70, you can continue to contribute to your IRA. Employees who are working past age 72 can delay taking the Required Minimum Distributions from the 401K plan of their current employer (if they own 5% or less of the stock) until they retire.

### **Charitable Donations**

Reminder: If you are required to take RMD's from your retirement plan, you can opt to have your IRA manager pay money directly to a charity (as a donation) instead of to you. The amount of money you donate in this fashion, will not be included in your taxable income for that year. You will need to educate yourself as to the particulars but it is a great way to avoid tax while supporting your favorite charities.

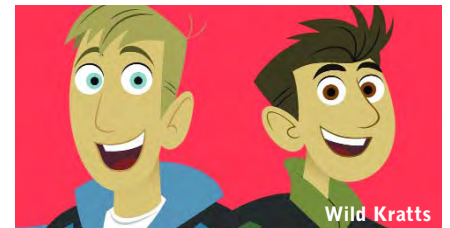

### Ken Burns Presents The Gene: An Intimate History

Tuesday, April 7 at 8 p.m.

Scientific genetics, little more than a century old, holds at once the promise of eradicating disease and the threat of altering the very essence of what it means to be human. This major new four-hour documentary from Ken Burns and Barak Goodman traces the dizzying evolution of this new science as researchers race to identify treatments for genetic diseases, such as cancer and sickle cell anemia, and to perfect tools for rewriting DNA. The film brings the story vividly to life through present-day tales of patients and doctors at the forefront of the search for genetic treatments, interwoven with a compelling history of the discoveries that made this possible. The series also tackles the daunting ethical challenges that these technologies pose for humankind.

## THIS WEEK'S PICKS

### Independent Lens: Bedlam

Monday, April 13 at 10 p.m.

Today, one in five adults — over 40 million Americans — live with a mental illness. Most people with a serious mental illness like schizophrenia, bipolar disorder or severe depression cycle through a revolving door of insufficient care due to lack of funding, personnel and space. In an effort to get to the bottom of the current mental health crisis, psychiatrist Dr. Kenneth Paul Rosenberg chronicles personal, poignant stories of those suffering from mental illness, including his own family, to bring to light this epidemic and possible solutions. Shot over the course of five years, the film takes viewers inside Los Angeles County's overwhelmed and vastly under-resourced psych ER, a nearby jail warehousing thousands of psychiatric patients, and the homes — and homeless encampments — of people affected by severe mental illness, where silence and shame often worsen the suffering.

### Blood Sugar Rising Wednesday, April 15 at 9 p.m.

Diabetes and pre-diabetes affect over 100 million people in the U.S., costing more than \$325 billion each year. It's now predicted that one in three children born since 2000 will develop the disease. This special puts human faces to these statistics, exploring the history and science of the illness through portraits and voices of Americans whose stories shape the documentary. Together, they present a dramatic depiction of this hidden national crisis. The two-hour program also reveals new hopes: from the rise of safer and easier medical treatments to new discoveries about lifestyle and environmental factors, with reports on those taking action to improve diabetes management and prevention.

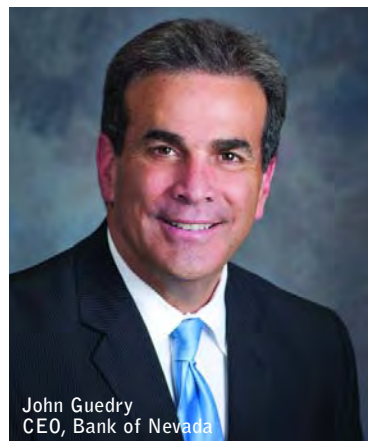
