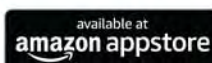

Timely news programs like the **PBS NewsHour**, **FRONTLINE** and **Nevada Week** retain viewers, but viewers are also seeking entertainment, education and diversion from the abnormal patterns of social distancing. Our Top 25 "most watched" shows for the past 60 days include **Antiques Roadshow** and **NOVA** for those seeking educational entertainment, **Lydia's Kitchen**, **Hubert Keller's Secrets of a Chef** and **America's Test Kitchen** attracted those considering new ideas for at home meals, and **Call the Midwife**, **Death in Paradise** and **Midsomer Murders** offered dramatic diversion.

Vegas PBS will offer more of the same great programming this month, plus concerts to entertain you and documentaries about unconventional trailblazers who questioned the status quo and changed our world. From suffragettes to ground-breaking artists, the Vegas PBS Trailblazers Spotlight Series will reintroduce us to people who pushed against the odds and left an indelible impression on the world. 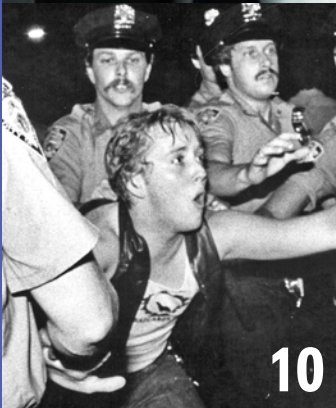
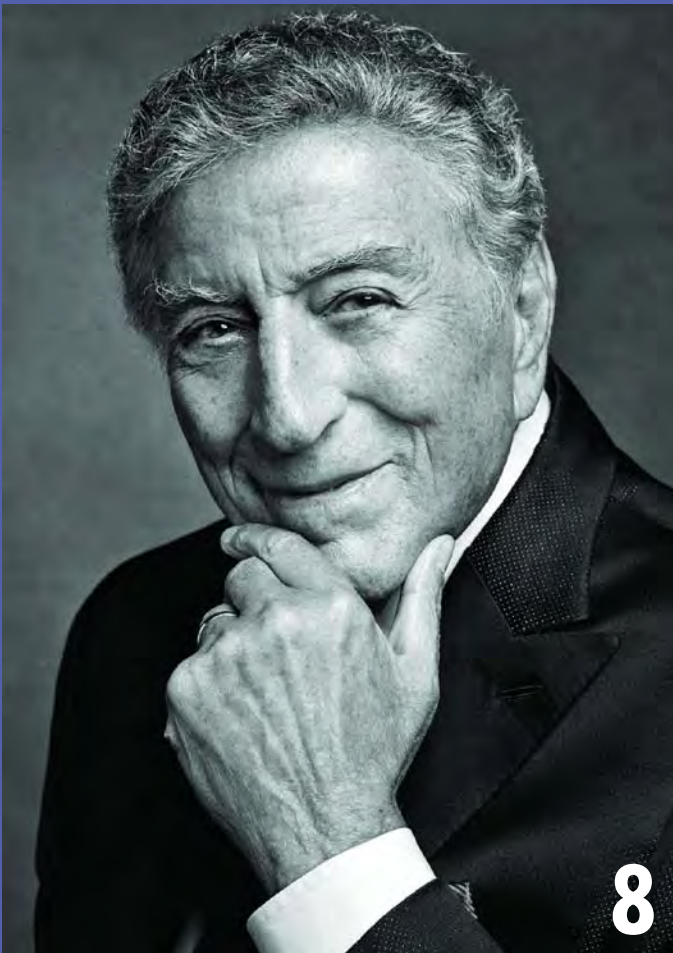

SATURDAY, MAY 30

Iconic Women of Country at 7 p.m.

This new special opens up the music vaults to provide an intimate look at legendary female artists, their stories and songs, and why they've stood the test of time. A love letter to the women of Nashville, the program pays tribute to 14 icons of country music — Dolly Parton, Tammy Wynette, Loretta Lynn, Patsy Cline, Brenda Lee and more — with heartfelt stories from ten contemporary artists, including Trisha Yearwood, Wynonna Judd and Kathy Mattea. Using the songs as an entry point, the program provides a unique look at the hallmark artist along with the context and influences that made the song so popular and timely. What drove these legends to write or perform each memorable song? How did the songs reflect their own lives? What inspired them? The program unearths stories and provides new insight through the reflections of those who have followed in the footsteps of legends.

Recorded live in Melbourne, Australia, in November 1989, this concert film captures the Bee Gees' "One for All World Tour," celebrating their 18th studio album "One." This fully restored, newly mixed and mastered show features the Gibb brothers performing tracks from as far back as their 1966 hit "Spicks and Specks" as well as their classic seventies and eighties songs. Featured are their 1968 breakthrough US Top 10 hit "I've Gotta Get A Message to You," along with electrifying performances of "Stayin' Alive" and "Jive Talking."

TUESDAY, JUNE 2

Iconic Women of Country at 8 p.m. (Please see description at left)

Moments to Remember (My Music) at 9:30 p.m.

Featuring legends of the late 50s and early 60s pop era, Patti Page and Nick Clooney co-host performances and archival classics. In this trip down memory lane, the late Frankie Laine came out of retirement to "spend one more night in our old rendezvous" singing his sentimental "That's My Desire." Italian crooner Julius La Rosa takes the stage to perform his classics "Eh Compari" and "Domani," while Page sings her million-selling "Allegheny Moon." The Four Lads, Four Aces, Four Freshmen, Roger Williams, Herb Reed's Platters, DeCastro Sisters and others appear to sing their greatest hits. Archival performances from Rosemary Clooney and Perry Como round out this nostalgic special.

Great American Songbook, George and Ira Gershwin. Bennett and Krall team up to perform definitive interpretations of Gershwin favorites such as “Love is Here to Stay,” “Fascinating Rhythm” and “They Can’t Take That Away From Me.” Behind-the-scenes sequences recorded during the making of their Billboard #1 jazz album, “Love is Here to Stay,” highlight the personal and musical rapport that these two artists have established over the course of their 20-year friendship.

The Bee Gees: One Night Only at 8 p.m.

The group's 1997 concert at the MGM Grand in Las Vegas is one of the very few Bee Gees performances ever filmed. The music special showcases many of their greatest disco and pop hits, including “How Deep Is Your Love,” “To Love Somebody,” “You Should Be Dancing/Alone” and many more.

Red, White and Rock at 9:30 p.m.

With a diverse array of talent, this patriotic celebration of American music is presented by Frankie Avalon, Jerry Butler, Connie Francis and Frankie Valli. Spotlighting artists from the rock, pop and doo-wop days of the late 50s and 60s, the all-star concert traces a classic lineage back through the pages of American music and features several performances not previously broadcast.

THURSDAY, JUNE 4

Linda Ronstadt: Live in Hollywood at 7:30 p.m.

On April 24, 1980, at Television Center Studios in Hollywood, Linda Ronstadt recorded a concert for an acclaimed HBO special that was considered by many fans to be a high point in her career. The concert, which featured electrifying performances of many of her greatest songs, captured America's most popular female rock singer at the peak of her reign. On stage, Ronstadt held the packed audience spellbound with powerful renditions of her biggest hits — “Blue Bayou,” “Poor Poor Pitiful Me” and “It’s So Easy” — plus an incredible, previously unreleased six-minute jam of her #1 smash, “You’re No Good.”

70s Soul Superstars (My Music) at 9 p.m.

This is a once-in-a-lifetime gathering of legends featuring all original performers singing their greatest jammin’ hits. Soul diva Patti LaBelle hosts the historic reunion of classic recording artists of the decade, including the Commodores, original lead Eugene Record reuniting with the Chi-Lites, Yvonne Elliman, Heatwave, Earl Young’s Trammps, the Emotions and the Manhattans.

FRIDAY, JUNE 5

Inxs: Live Baby Live at 10:30 p.m.

On July 13, 1991, Australian rockers INXS were filmed live at Wembley Stadium in London, performing one of the most stunning concerts ever in a sold-out event before 72,000 wildly enthusiastic fans. Now fully restored and remixed by Sam Okell (Abbey Road Studios), this electrifying concert features classic INXS anthems “New Sensation,” “Mystify” and “Need You Tonight.”

Secrets of the Dead: King Arthur's Lost Kingdom

Secrets of the Dead: King Arthur's Lost Kingdom

Tuesday, June 9 at 8 p.m.

History teaches that in the 5th century, the country descended into a tumultuous and violent period known as the Dark Ages, leaving the nation vulnerable to invading Angle and Saxon hordes from northern Europe. With a nation divided, a great leader known as King Arthur emerged, uniting the lawless lands to fight off invaders — or at least that's what the fragmentary historical texts suggest. The truth is, no one really knows what happened — until now. In this special, Professor Alice Roberts

and a team of experts use new archaeological discoveries to decode Dark Ages myths and piece together a very different story of this turning point in Britain's history that might also explain the legend of King Arthur.

Stonewall Uprising: American Experience

Tuesday, June 9 at 9 p.m.

Learn the dramatic event that launched a worldwide rights movement. The film revisits a time when homosexual acts were illegal throughout America, and homosexuality itself was seen as a form of mental illness. Hunted and often entrapped by undercover police in

their hometowns, gays from around the U.S. began fleeing to New York in search of a sanctuary. Hounded there still by an aggressive police force, they found refuge in a Mafia-run gay bar in Greenwich Village, the Stonewall Inn. When police raided Stonewall on June 28, 1969, gay men and women did something they had not done before: they fought back. As the streets of New York erupted into violent protests and street demonstrations, the collective anger announced that the gay rights movement had arrived.

Prince Albert: A Victorian Hero Revealed

Sunday, June 14 at 8 p.m.

History largely remembers Prince Albert as Queen Victoria's German husband whose untimely death inspired decades of mourning. However, a wealth of new material suggests he played a profound role in shaping Victorian Britain. Professor Saul David examines Albert's significant influence on British culture, governmental policy and even international relations. Initially viewed with suspicion and hostility, Albert faced an uphill struggle to carve out a role and be taken seriously. Such was his tenacity that by the time of his premature death, aged only 42, Albert was widely regarded as a forward-thinking reformer whose innovative ideas transformed the fortunes of the nation and created a legacy that lives on today. Victoria may have worn the crown, but Albert was king in all but name.

Lucy Worsley's Royal Myths & Secrets

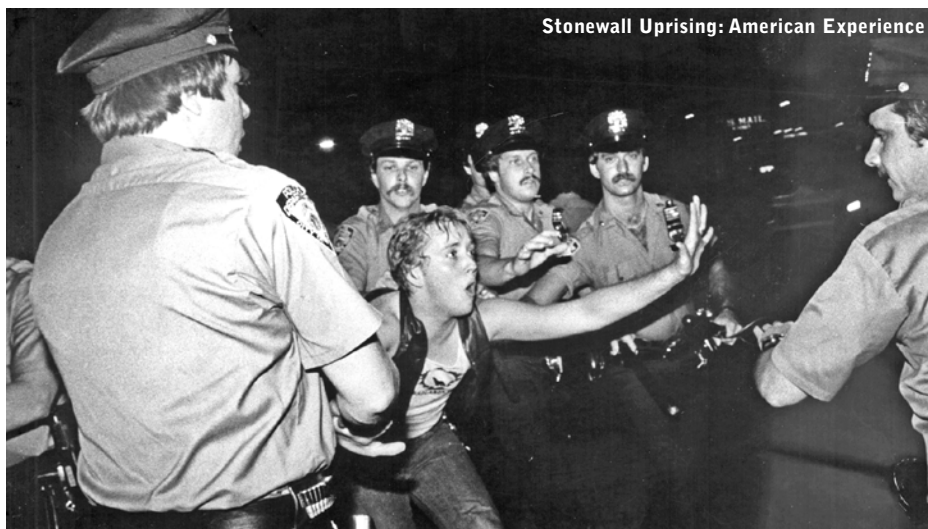

One Woman, One Vote

Monday, June 8 at 10 p.m.

Women's suffrage was a 72-year struggle that finally attained nation-wide victory in 1920 with the ratification of the 19th constitutional amendment prohibiting sex discrimination at the polls. Up to this point, women met, organized, marched, fought amongst themselves, lobbied and protested. They were threatened, attacked, beaten, tried, arrested and placed in solitary confinement for their actions. In retaliation, they fought harder. Oscar-winning actress Susan Sarandon narrates this documentary that examines the struggle for a woman's right to vote. Segments focus on influential figures in the women's suffrage movement, including Elizabeth Cady Stanton and Alice Paul; opposition from both men and women who feared the women's vote would ignite a social revolution; and the U.S. Senate's passage of the 19th Amendment by a single vote.

Great Performances at the Met: Agrippina

Friday, June 12 at 9 p.m.

Handel's tale of intrigue and impropriety in ancient Rome receives its first Met performance, starring mezzo-soprano Joyce DiDonato as the controlling, power-hungry Agrippina and Harry Bicket conducting. Although based on serious events, Handel crafted a black comedy offering a lighthearted and satirical spin. Sir David McVicar's production ingeniously reframes the action of the abuse of power to "the present," where it should loudly resonate. The all-star cast features mezzo-soprano Kate Lindsey as Agrippina's son and future emperor Nerone, soprano Brenda Rae as the seductive Poppea, countertenor Iestyn Davies as the ambitious officer Ottone and bass Matthew Rose as the weary emperor Claudius. It is interesting to note that the son of Agrippina is portrayed by a woman. In fact, the role was originally performed by a male castrato singer.

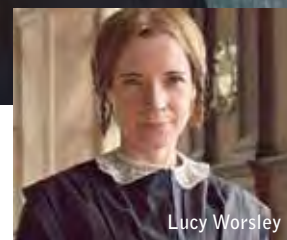

addition, Rick chronicles the brutal measures the leaders used to enforce their ideologies and discusses the horrific consequences of genocide and total war. And yet despite all this, inspiration can be found by those who resisted. Along the way, Rick visits poignant sights throughout Europe relating to fascism and talks with Europeans whose families lived through those
