WOMEN'S SUFFRAGE AND DIVERSE PERSPECTIVES THROUGH PROGRAMMING

Following last month's all-mail-in primary election, our nation prepares to celebrate 100 years since the passage of the women's suffrage amendment to the United States Constitution. This month also marks 106 years since Nevada helped lead the way to this equal rights reform. The national trailblazers who fought for this right will be highlighted in a documentary on the 19th Amendment. **The Vote: American Experience** airs **Monday and Tuesday, July 6 and 7 at 9 p.m.** It explores the final decade of the fight for women's right to vote in the United States. The program looks into the debate within the movement on how to best affect change, contrasting views including militant tactics versus hunger strikes and peaceful protests. Our award-winning 2014 local documentary on the Nevada women's suffrage movement is also available for on demand streaming at vegaspbs.org/shows.

As our nation has witnessed wide-spread debates about racism, Vegas PBS will offer historical insight and diverse perspectives on women's rights beyond suffrage. On **Daring Women Doctors: Physicians in the 19th Century** airing **Friday, July 10 at 11 p.m.**, we highlight the pioneering women who faced resistance in their pursuit of medical education. Then on **POV: We Are The Radical Monarchs**, a group of young girls in Oakland, California, are on the frontlines of social justice, earning badges for completing units on preserving the environment, disability justice and more. The documentary airs **Monday, July 20 at 9 p.m.**

Spotlight Series: Trailblazers

Throughout July

The 19th Amendment to the U.S. Constitution granted American women the right to vote and was ratified on August 18, 1920, ending almost a century of protest. Celebrating 100 years since the passage, Vegas PBS honors and commemorates those who fought for women's suffrage, the feminist movement throughout the 20th century and the stories of modern women who continue to shatter the glass ceiling and transform history. This month, we are pleased to air a slate of special programming that tell the inspiring stories of trailblazing women who have changed the course of history.

**The Vote:
American Experience**
**Monday and Tuesday, July 6
and 7 at 9 p.m.**

Learn the dramatic story of the hard-fought campaign waged by American women for the right to vote, a transformative cultural and political movement that resulted in the largest expansion of voting rights in U.S. history. In its final decade, movement leaders wrestled with contentious questions about the most effective methods for affecting social change, debating the use of militant and even violent tactics. Exploring how and why millions of 20th century Americans mobilized for — and against — women's suffrage, the film brings to life the unsung leaders of the movement and the controversies over gender roles and race that divided Americans then — and continue to dominate political discourse today.

**Secrets of the Dead:
Viking Warrior Queen**
Tuesday, July 7 at 8 p.m.

In 1878 the body of a great Viking warrior was found in Birka, Sweden. For a century, people assumed the body was that of a man until the 1970s when a young researcher observed the bones had female characteris-

tics. In 2017, a team of Swedish archaeologists astonished everyone by proving, through a DNA study, that the great warrior wasn't a man, but a woman. These DNA results completed a long field investigation to discover the truth behind the only female warrior and Viking battle strategist known to date.

The Queen Mother
Friday, July 10 at 8:30 p.m.

Wife, monarch and much-loved public figure — Queen Elizabeth was one of the most respected members of the British Royal family. This moving profile reveals the dramatic inside story of the Queen Mother's life, highlighting the moments of pain and upheaval that ultimately defined her legacy. Find out how she and King George VI steered the country through the darkness of World War II and how she later forged a new role for herself as the senior matriarch of the Royal Family. With testimonies from royal experts and insiders, as well as extensive archive materials, the special forensically examines the life of a woman with a will of iron, determined to protect the British monarchy.

This illuminating new special features the stories of extraordinary American heroines from the early years of feminism. Discover the rich biographies of 26 trailblazing American women who broke barriers in male-dominated fields at the turn of the 20th century, such as science, business, politics, journalism, sports, and the arts — including the first woman to found a hospital on a Native American reservation, serve in the U.S. Congress, become a bank president, earn an international pilot's license, lead scientific expeditions in the Arctic, sing opera at Carnegie Hall or direct a feature-length movie. Presenting history in a bold new way, the film brings extraordinary stories of daring and persistence back to life through rare archival imagery, captivating original artwork and animation, and interviews with historians, descendants and accomplished women of today who reflect upon the influence of these pioneers.

Hidden in American history, all-women's medical schools began to appear in the mid-19th century, long before women had the right

to vote or own property. This special highlights the intrepid, pioneering and diverse women who faced hostility and resistance in their pursuit of medical educations. This documentary examines how these women physicians greatly impacted their communities around the United States and internationally. It also demonstrates how women doctors exerted a long-lasting influence on the movement towards women's rights.

POV: We Are The Radical Monarchs

Monday, July 20 at 9 p.m.

Meet the Radical Monarchs, a group of young girls of color on the frontlines of social justice. Set in Oakland, the special documents this alternative to the Scout movement for girls of color, aged 8-13. Its members earn badges for completing units on social justice including being an LGBTQ ally, the environment and disability justice. Started by two, fierce, queer women of color, their work is anchored in the belief that adolescent girls of color need dedicated spaces and that the foundation for this innovative work must also be rooted in inter-dependent sisterhood, self-love and hope. The film follows the first troop of Radical Monarchs for over three years and documents the founders' struggle to respond to the needs of communities across the U.S. and grow the organization after the viral explosion of interest in the troop's mission to create and inspire a new generation of social justice activists.

In Their Own Words: Queen Elizabeth II **Sunday, July 26 at 10 a.m.**

Follow Queen Elizabeth II's remarkable life, from her youth — when few expected she'd ever wear the crown — to her uncle Edward VIII's stunning abdication and her father's subsequent coronation as King George VI. Witness her experiences during World War II, her own sudden ascension to the throne and her eventful reign of more than 60 years. She defines the role of a modern monarch, leading the Royal Family and her subjects through the challenges of post-war reconstruction, decolo-

nization, conflicts in South Africa, Northern Ireland and The Falklands, and the emotionally-charged days after Princess Diana's death. Among those interviewed are former Prime Minister Sir John Major, actor Sir Ben Kingsley, biographer Sally Bedell Smith, Academy Award®-winning screenwriter David Seidler (“The King's Speech”), director Stephen Frears (“The Queen”), President George H.W. Bush and Barbara Bush, historian John Julius Cooper, Secretary General of the Commonwealth Kamallesh Sharma, and the Queen's cousins Margaret Rhodes and Lady Elizabeth Anson.

July 22 The astonishing collar-camera footage reveals newborn Kalahari Meerkats below ground for the first time, unveils the hunting skills of Magellanic penguins in Argentina and follows the treetop progress of an orphaned chimpanzee in Cameroon.

July 29 See how the cameras capture young cheetahs learning to hunt in Namibia, reveal how fur seals on an Australian island evade the great white sharks offshore and help solve a conflict between South African farmers and Chacma baboons.

In the wake of the catastrophic asteroid impact believed to have wiped out the dinosaurs, Australia was set adrift on a lonely voyage across southern seas. How did it become the strange land that it is today? This final episode of the series traces the last 65 million years, revealing the events that shaped the Australia we now know. Prehistoric jungles retreated, replaced by eucalypt forests, grasslands and deserts. When humans first arrived, giant marsupials dominated the land and the Great Barrier Reef was yet to form. 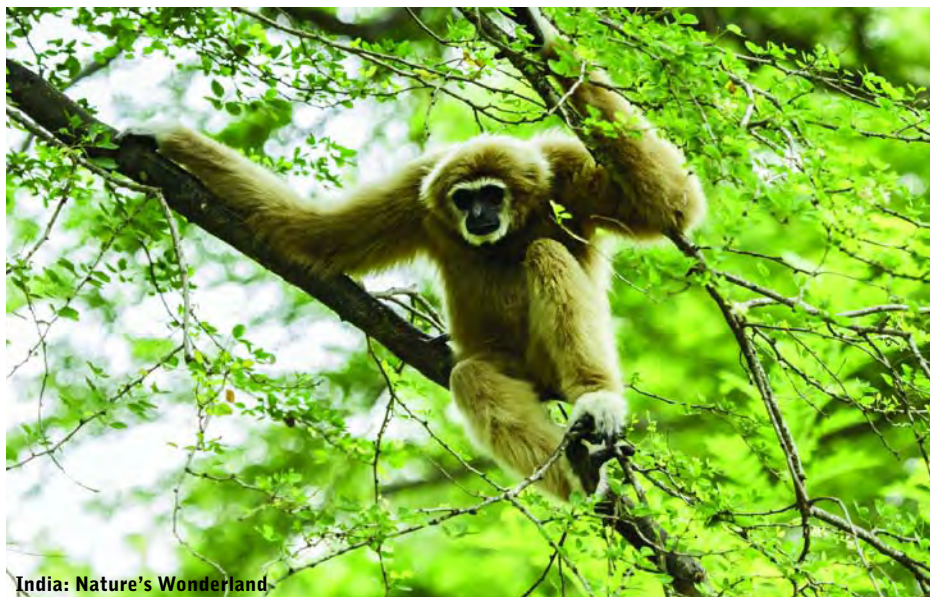
NOVA: Making North America

This illuminating four-part series illustrates how we experience Earth's natural forces. Although we can't immediately feel the motion of Earth's fundamental forces, we witness the consequences, such as tidal bores surging through the Amazon rainforest or the intense and ruinous power of hurricanes.

Shape July 22

We can't directly see the forces that govern Earth, but we can see their shadows in the shapes of nature that surround us. If we understand why these shapes exist, we can understand the rules that bind the entire universe.

Elements July 22

The forces of nature make Earth a restless planet, but they also turned our ball of rock into a home for life. How did our planet's ingredients, the chemical elements, come together and take that first crucial step from barren rock to a living world?

Wild Weather

Wednesday, July 22 at 11 p.m.

The best way to truly understand weather is to get inside it. This awe-inspiring documentary takes you into the eye of the storm with revealing and ambitious experiments that show weather as it's never been seen before. A global group of experts are introduced who risk their lives to demonstrate the power of wind, water and temperature — taking these simple "ingredients" and transforming them into something spectacular and powerful for everyone to understand. Among the team's meteorological miracles: recreating a desert dust storm and a dangerous fire whirl; firing a probe into the center of a tornado; creating visual representations of thunder's destructive power; and triggering a fast-moving avalanche that uncovers secrets about the powder cloud's acceleration. It will forever change the way you think about the elements.

America's national parks spring from an idea as radical as the Declaration of Independence: that the nation's most magnificent and sacred places should be preserved, not for royalty or the rich, but for everyone. This stunning six-episode series was filmed over the course of more than six years at some of nature's most spectacular locales — from Acadia to Yosemite, Yellowstone to the Grand Canyon, the Everglades of Florida to the Gates of the Arctic in Alaska. It is also a story of people: people from every conceivable background — rich and poor; famous and unknown; soldiers and scientists; idealists, artists and entrepreneurs; people who were willing to devote themselves to saving some precious portion of the land they loved.

July 5 Join a journey through India to discover its rich culture and rare wildlife. Experience a ritual tiger dance and see lions, elephants and India's only ape — the hoolock gibbon. Then climb to the Himalayas where the Ganges River begins.

July 12 Continue exploring India and meet a man who spent 30 years planting his own rainforest. On the way, encounter demoiselle cranes, tahr goats, one-horned rhinos, the tiny pika and lion-tailed macaques. Witness the mass hatching of olive ridley turtles.

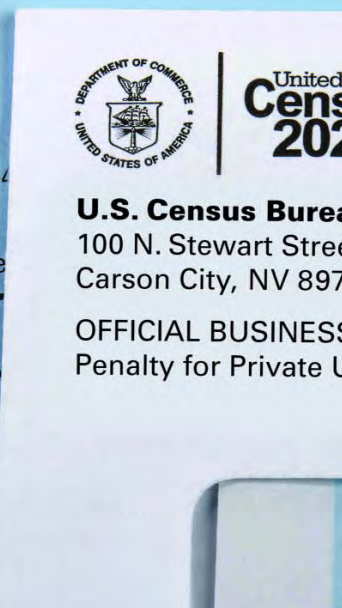
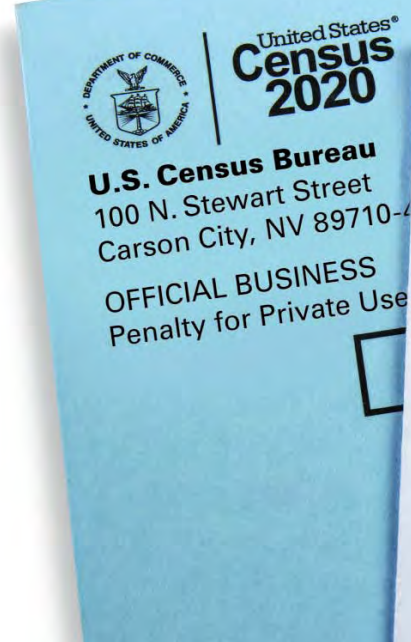

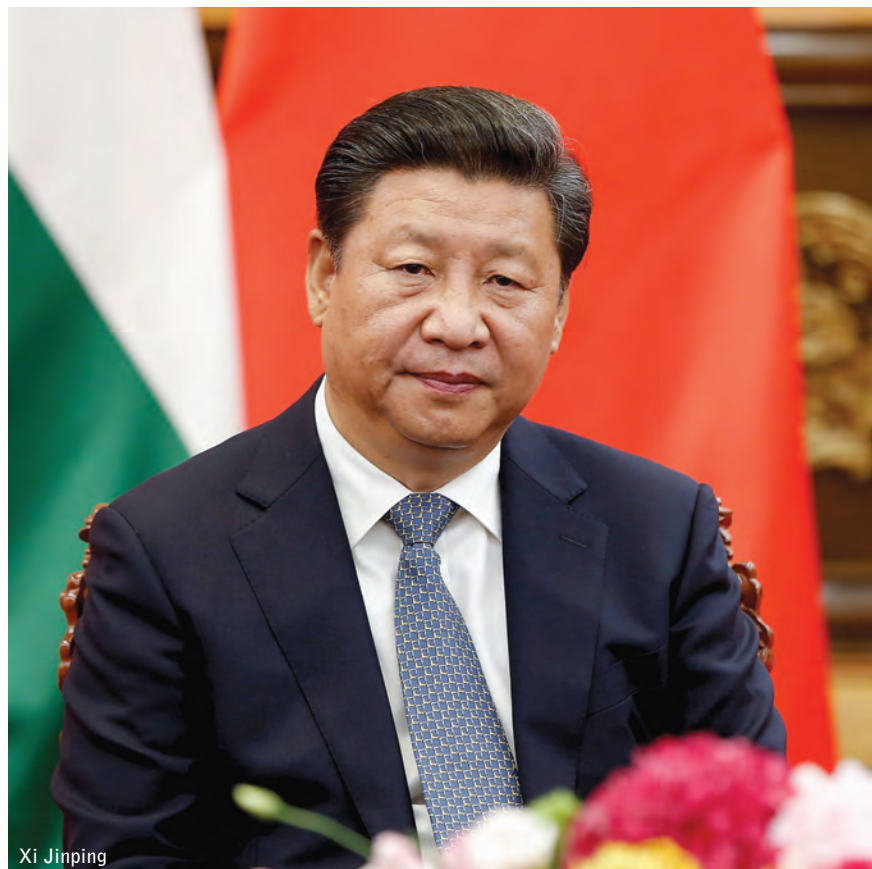
The 2020 Census count began in January, a once-a-decade operation in which every household in the United States is asked to answer a short series of questions that will influence policymaking and planning for the next decade. The census results are vital for communities as they help determine federal funding in many areas such as highway planning and construction, school funding, infrastructure and healthcare.

While parts of Nevada are exceeding national census response rates, rural counties are falling far behind. COVID-19 may be at least partly to blame. In this new local special, we discuss how the pandemic has shifted the way census takers reach out to rural families. Plus, 2020 is the first digital-first census year. We look at how the online answer form has affected response rates. Daniel Liden, Director of Data and Analytics at Kenny Guinn Center for Policy Priorities, joins us in the discussion.

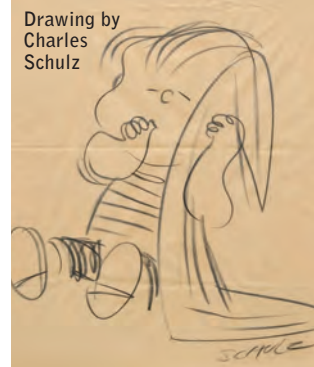
