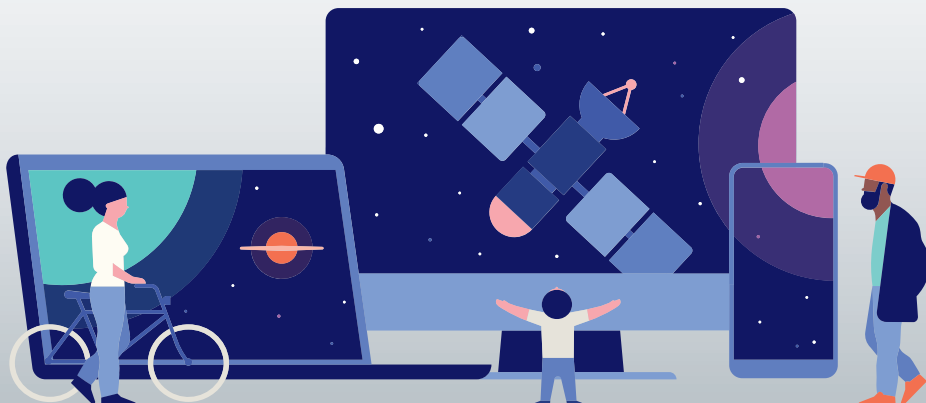

A Message from the General Manager

Hyper-Local

In 2020, the pandemic, business and school closures, and an emotional election campaign are reshaping what we consider normal in Southern Nevada. Despite these seismic shifts, we still expect our children to be educated, public health to be preserved, jobs to be created and to enjoy some downtime. Throughout this tumultuous time, Vegas PBS is using the resources members provide to create new services to respond to the crisis.

This fall, a statewide teacher education resource will support distance education. **OnePlaceNV** now houses over 300,000 online digital assets for at home learning and teacher assignments. Indexed by subject and grade level, this collection of videos, lesson plans, worksheets and sample tests are drawn from PBS and other resources

Our **Nevada Week** and **Community Calendar** programs have combined on air programming and online referral resources to provide personal health education about the evolving COVID-19 and links to our fellow nonprofits who are helping those in need. Over 150 messages a week on our channels achieve over 2.3 million views a week!

Locally produced programs from Vegas PBS allow our community to celebrate our history, access resources and dedicate ourselves to helping Las Vegas, once again, reinvent itself by focusing on what's important: our community. Through you, we are pleased to provide education, civic engagement and public health program services during this crisis, plus local entertainment to remind us what the future will offer when we overcome the virus and once again reinvent this unique desert oasis.
