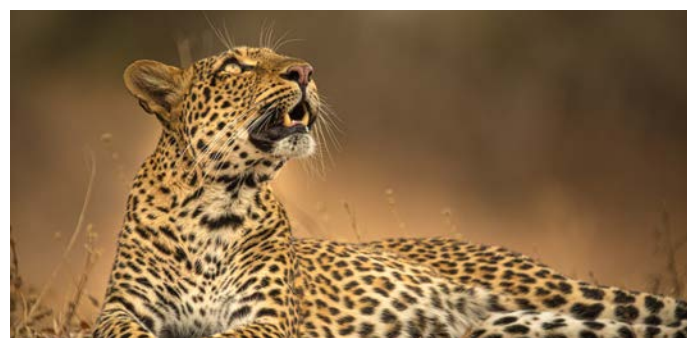

Grow, Ride, Rattle and Bighorn, April 14

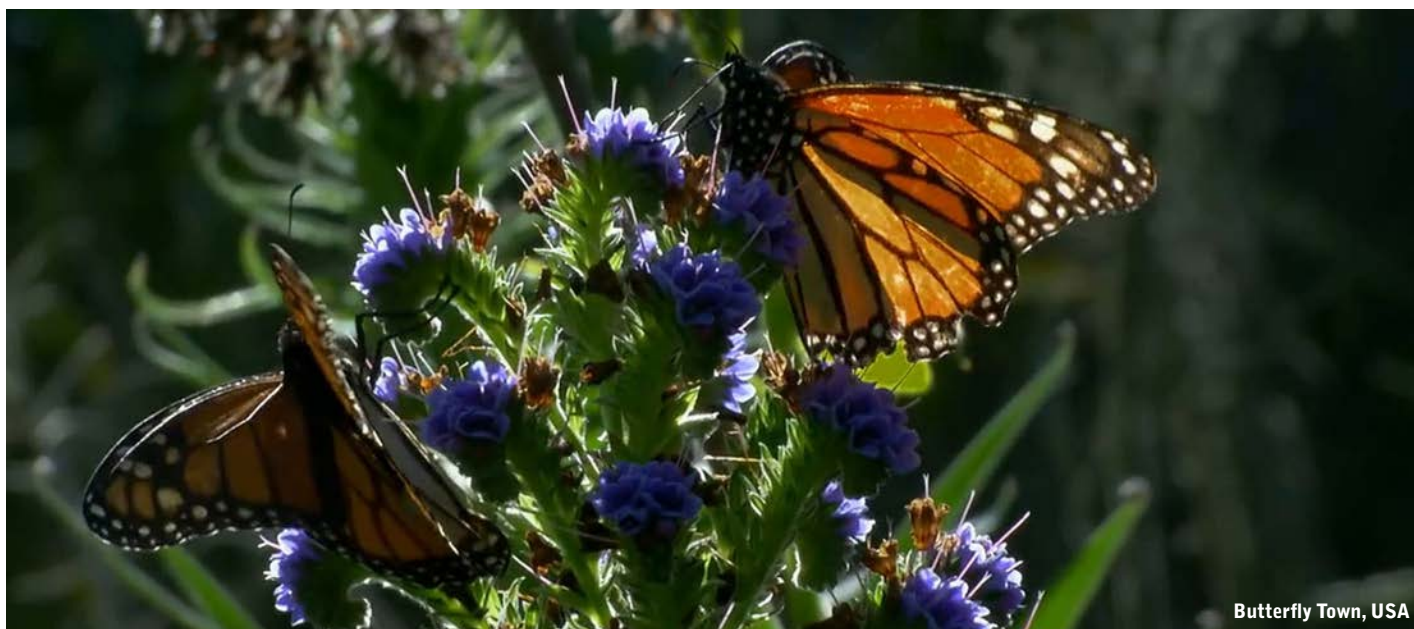
