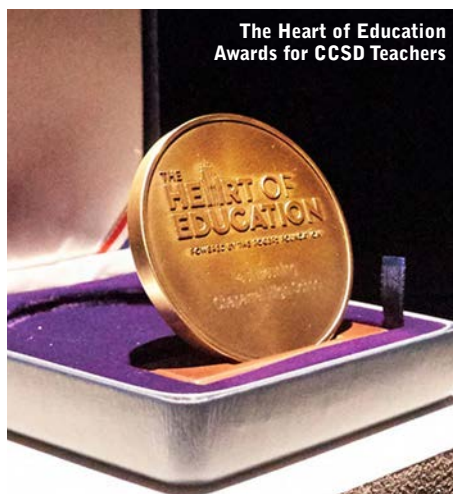

Throughout this rollercoaster year, a crew has had unprecedented access from boardroom to basement. Facing an uncertain future and questioning its very purpose, **Inside the Met** takes us deep inside a great institution as its 150th birthday makes history in ways no one could have predicted.
