




Inside the Met Friday, May 21 at 9 p.m. (Part 1) and 10 p.m. (Part 2), and Friday, May 28 at 9 p.m. (Part 3)

This three-part observational documentary series begins as the largest art museum in the Americas prepares to celebrate its 150th birthday with a treasure trove of landmark exhibitions. When COVID strikes, New York and the world — shuts down. For the first time in its history, the Met closes its doors. Then comes another crisis: in the wake of the killing of George Floyd, there are urgent demands for social justice. Throughout this rollercoaster year, a crew has had unprecedented access from boardroom to basement. Facing an uncertain future and guestioning its very purpose, Inside the Met takes us deep inside a great institution as its 150th birthday makes history in ways no one could have predicted.

The Heart of Education Awards for CCSD Teachers Sunday, May 23 at 8 p.m.

The Smith Center's sixth-annual Heart of Education Awards will recognize outstanding Clark County School District (CCSD) educators who go above and beyond for their students and schools. Southern Nevadans have especially good reason to appreciate teachers this year. Since the pandemic struck, CCSD teachers continue to rally in unprecedented ways — adapting to virtual classrooms and finding creative ways to support and encourage students from a distance. Hundreds of award finalists will be recognized at this event. The top 20 teachers will each receive a \$5,000 cash award, as well as a \$1,000 donation to a school program of their choice.
