This original series was brought to **PBS** as a **Walter Presents** series, which is a curated collection of award-winning international drama, hand-picked by Walter Iuzzolino, a TV connoisseur who travels the globe looking for the next big hit. ▲ **Death in Paradise** star Ben Miller swaps Saint Marie for Cambridge in the stylish new six-part crime drama series **Professor T** based on the original Flemish-language program of the same name. This new series is set against the stunning backdrop of one of the world's most prestigious educational institutions, Cambridge University. Ben stars as the eccentric but brilliant criminology professor Jasper Teerlinck who becomes a reluctant detective, solving crimes in Cambridge and beyond. The Professor is outstanding in his field, but often finds himself sidetracked by personal problems, including OCD, flights of fancy and his forthright mother, Adelaide.

Ben notes "I saw the original Belgian series and loved so much about it, and I love how Jasper is this very unusual criminal psychologist. The stories and puzzles are really intriguing, but what I love most of all is that every character has a proper backstory. Jasper's is revealed little by little."

Describing the show's appeal, Ben says: "**Professor T** has it all: intriguing murders, dreaming spires, and a cast of unforgettable characters, each with their own fascinating secrets. You don't have to be a professor of criminal psychology to know the audience will love it."

The opening episode sees the Professor unwillingly caught up in a police investigation when Diana Tyson is attacked on the university campus. DI Lisa Donckers thinks the attack is very similar to one that occurred years beforehand. And she reckons the Professor is just the man to crack the case.

Joining Ben Miller is Emma Naomi as DI Lisa Donckers, an old student of the Professor's. Other cast members include Frances de la Tour and Barney White. Frances plays Jasper's overbearing mother, while Barney is police sidekick Dan Winters.

This series is directed by Belgian director Dries Vos and produced by Robin Kerremans and Dimitri Verbeek. It is executive produced by Walter Iuzzolino and Jo McGrath from Eagle Eye Drama — a newly formed production company, launched by the team behind global drama brand **Walter Presents**.

VEGAS PBS STEAM CAMP

Distance learning became the norm in 2020 for many students, as a result of school closures during the height of the pandemic. Vegas PBS found a way to bring Science, Technology, Engineering, Arts, and Math curriculum directly to students through Vegas PBS STEAM Camp. The weekly broadcast series for children ages 6-8, uses interviews with community experts, interactive at-home STEAM challenges, and literacy extensions to support inquiry-based learning and conceptual understanding.



VEGAS PBS KIDS WRITERS CONTEST Presented by Janice Allen

Vegas PBS' yearly contest is designed to promote the advancement of children's literacy skills (K-5) through hands-on, active learning. In lieu of an in-person awards ceremony, winners were celebrated in a 30-minute program, hosted by Chet Buchanan. The program features story highlights — from fairy tales about unicorns, to nonfiction about a foster family, to poetry about what it means to have a home.



#VEGASSTRONG: CONNECTING DURING COVID-19

October 1, 2020, was the third anniversary of the mass shooting at the Route 91 Harvest Country Music Festival in Las Vegas. With COVID-19 limiting in-person interactions, this special examines the resources available for those impacted, honors the lives lost, and discusses the importance of staying connected to achieve long term healing and resiliency.

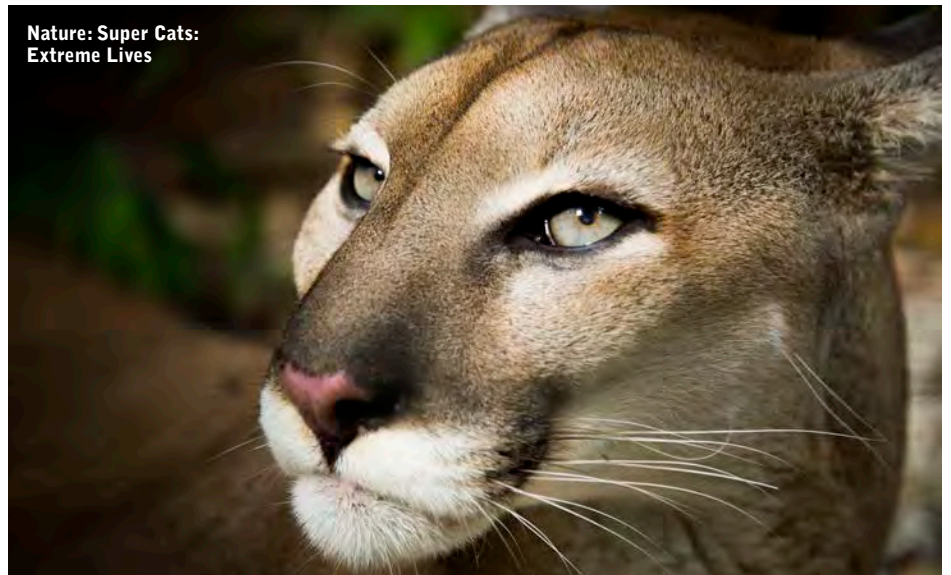

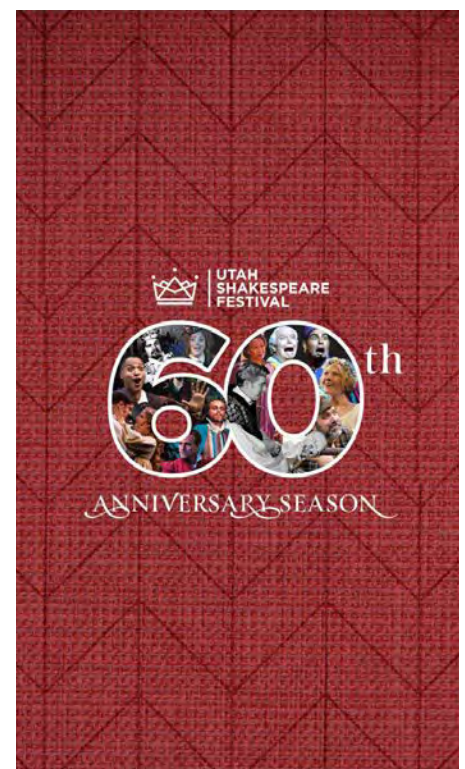
