





Classic Albums: Pink Floyd: The Dark Side of the Moon Friday, August 6 at 10 p.m.

Listen as all four band members tell the story behind one of the greatest albums ever made. Pink Floyd's masterpiece and a monument of rock history, 1973's "The Dark Side of the Moon" claimed a place in the world's record books when it sold more than 30 million copies and spent 740 weeks in the U.S. charts. It transformed Pink Floyd from a band with a cult following to global stadium superstars. (Note for fans - stay tuned at 11 p.m. for Pink Floyd: Live in Venice)

Icon: Music Through the Lens Fridays (6-part series)

Featuring in-depth and often irreverent interviews with the world's best-known music photographers, journalists and musicians, this eye-opening series provides a thrill ride through the amazing world of music photography and poses the question – "What makes an image iconic?" Contributors include Danny Clinch, Gered Mankowitz, Jill Furmanovsky and musicians such as Alice Cooper, Nick Mason (Pink Floyd) and Ziggy Marley.

On the Cover August 6 at 9 p.m.

Music magazines played a pivotal role in elevating music photography to iconic status, providing a visual context for some of the world's greatest bands and their music. Explore the legacy of the early covers of Rolling Stone, Creem, NME, Mojo and Q. Journalists, musicians and publicists discuss the enduring appeal and importance of the printed page, with music photographers who shot many of the most iconic front covers telling some touching, scandalous and never-heardbefore stories about these images. Highlights include Chalkie Davies' story of how Elton John hoped to use an NME magazine cover to come out, a young Michael Jackson, Mick Jagger with a


leopard and the Stone Roses with a lot of paint. The episode also reveals how magazines covered the deaths of Kurt Cobain and David Bowie.

Check into Hotel del Coronado to see sensational finds in a stunning seaside setting. Hour 1 discoveries include a 1962 Baldessari oil "Sign for Rothko & Albers," a Fortuny Delphos gown, and a "Kitchen Debate" table with a signed Nixon photo. Hour 2 uncovers a 1915 San Diego Exposition poster, a Joan Crawford archive from around 1940, and a Margaret Bourke-White photograph of Gandhi.






