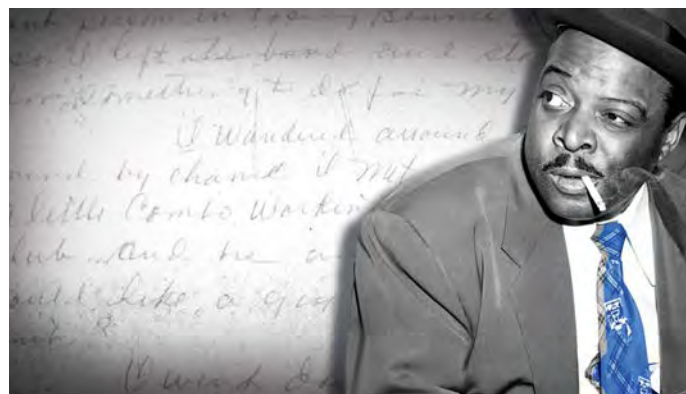

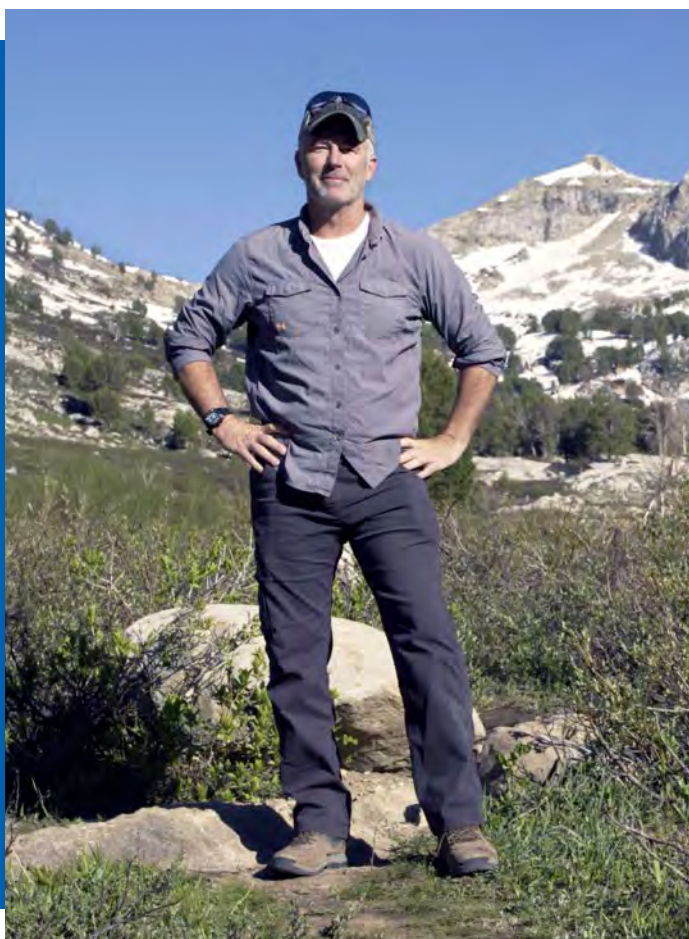

## Outdoor Nevada Season 5

### Wednesdays at 7:30 p.m. beginning September 15

**Previous seasons featured Sundays at 8 a.m. and 8:30 a.m. Leading into the new season, we'll revisit Season 4 from start to finish, with a marathon of stacked episodes on Sunday, September 12 from 8 a.m. to 1 p.m.**

Close on the heels of a moving and exciting fourth season, which featured the historic Pioneer Saloon, the Hoover Dam and Gold Butte National Monument to name a few, **Season 5** promises to take viewers to some of Nevada's finest and most breathtaking outdoor destinations. The series will visit Lamoille Canyon in the Ruby Mountains, the Cowboy Arts & Gear Museum in Elko, the Kit Carson Trail, the Big Dunes in Amargosa Valley and many more one-of-a-kind adventures available to everyone. Hosted by John Burke, **Outdoor Nevada** is a showcase of Nevada's ideal climate and varied environments that provide endless inspiration for exciting outdoor adventures. **(Repeats Saturdays at 3 p.m.)**

### **The National Parks: America's Best Idea (a 6-part film by Ken Burns)** Wednesdays at 3:30 p.m.

Discover the history of the U.S. National Parks system, including the initial ideas which led to the world's first national parks and the expansion of the system over 150 years. **(Repeats Sundays at 9:30 a.m., except September 12 and 26)**

### **The Scripture of Nature (1851-1890, Part 1) September 1**

Follow a study of the first ideas which led to the establishment of America's national parks, with an emphasis on the work of John Muir and the exploration and preservation of Yosemite and Yellowstone.

### **The Last Refuge (1890-1915, Part 2) September 8, at 2:30 p.m.**

Americans begin to question the nation's rush across the continent that has devastated forests and ravaged animals. Conservation's greatest champion is Theodore Roosevelt, who audaciously sets aside 800,000 acres of the Grand Canyon.

### **The Empire of Grandeur (1915-1919, Part 3) September 15**

Stephen Mather accepts the offer to oversee the national parks for one year. He launches a campaign to publicize the parks as a unified system and to persuade Congress to create a single agency to oversee it: the National Park Service.

### **Going Home (1920-1933, Part 4) September 22**

Mather and Albright ally themselves with the automobile to "democratize" the national parks. Horace Kephart and George Masa launch a campaign to save the forests of the Smoky Mountains from destruction by establishing a national park.

### **Great Nature (1933-1945, Part 5) September 29**

Franklin D. Roosevelt enters battles to create national parks on the Olympic Peninsula, Florida's Everglades and California's High Sierra. George Melendez Wright begins arguing that the parks are not doing enough to protect wildlife.

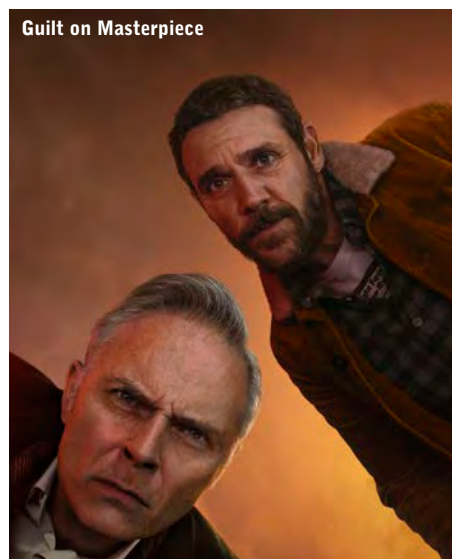



Boxer Cassius Clay rises up the ranks to win gold at the 1960 Olympics. He turns professional, sharpening his boxing skills and honing his genius for self-promotion. In 1964, he upsets Sonny Liston to become heavyweight champion.

## **Round Two: What's My Name? (1964-1970) Part 2**

**Monday, September 20 at 8 p.m.**

Cassius Clay joins the Nation of Islam and takes the name Muhammad Ali. When he refuses induction into the Army, he is stripped of his title and forced into exile. After three years he returns to the ring.

## **Round Three: The Rivalry (1970-1974) Part 3**

**Tuesday, September 21 at 8 p.m.**

Muhammad Ali battles Joe Frazier and the U.S. government. He loses to, and then defeats Frazier, but to become champion again he will have to beat George Foreman.

## **Round Four: The Spell Remains (1974-2016) Part 4**

**Wednesday September 22 at 8 p.m.**

Muhammad Ali shocks the world by defeating George Foreman, winning back the heavyweight title and becoming the most famous man on Earth. After retiring in 1981, he travels the world spreading his Islamic faith, and becomes a symbol of peace and hope.

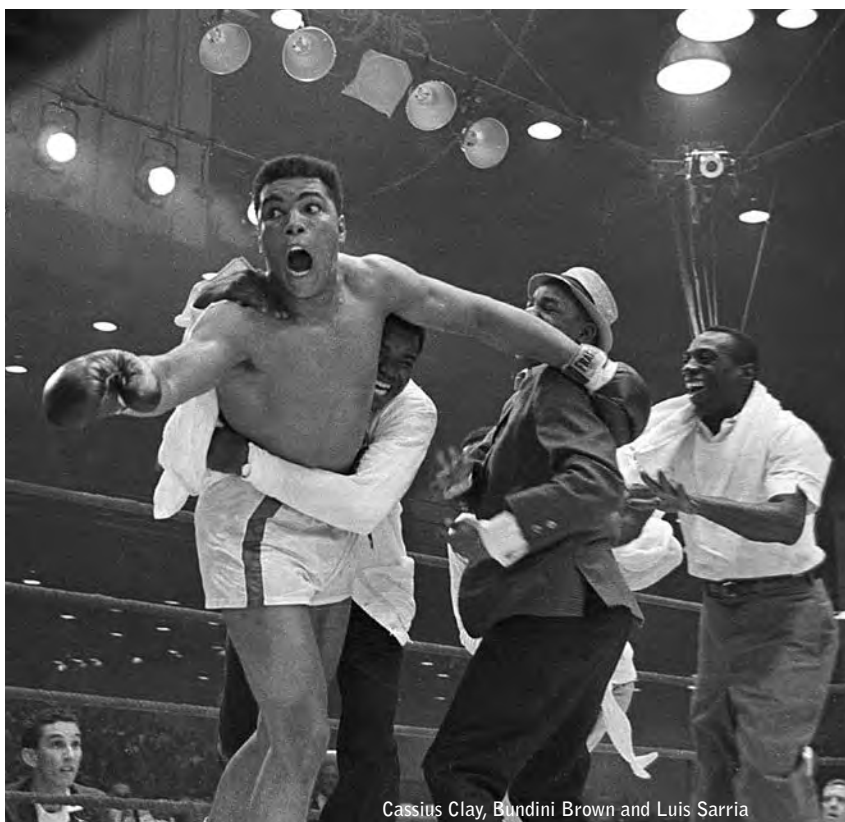

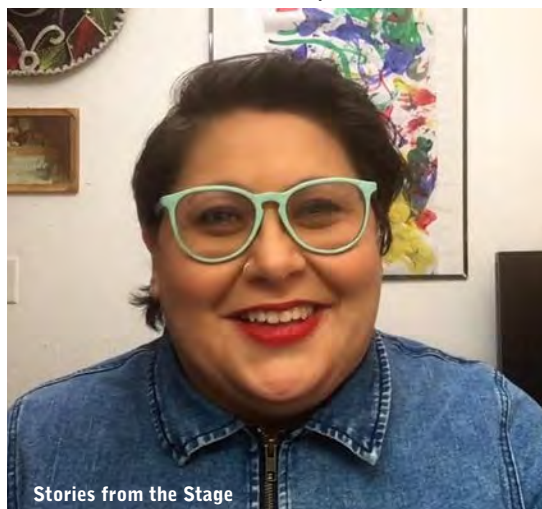
