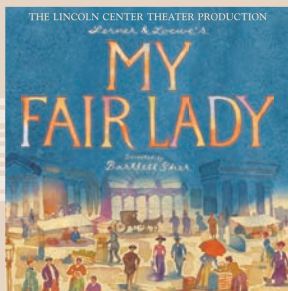

The War: A World Without War (a film by Ken Burns)

December 6 at 10 p.m.

This is the concluding part of a 7-part documentary. (All 7 parts are available on Vegas PBS Passport to stream.) A few weeks after the death of President Roosevelt shocks the country, Germany surrenders. Meanwhile, American sailors, soldiers and Marines endure the worst battle of the Pacific — Okinawa. In August, American planes drop atomic bombs on Hiroshima and Nagasaki, and the Japanese, too, surrender. Millions return home — to try to learn how to live in a world without war.

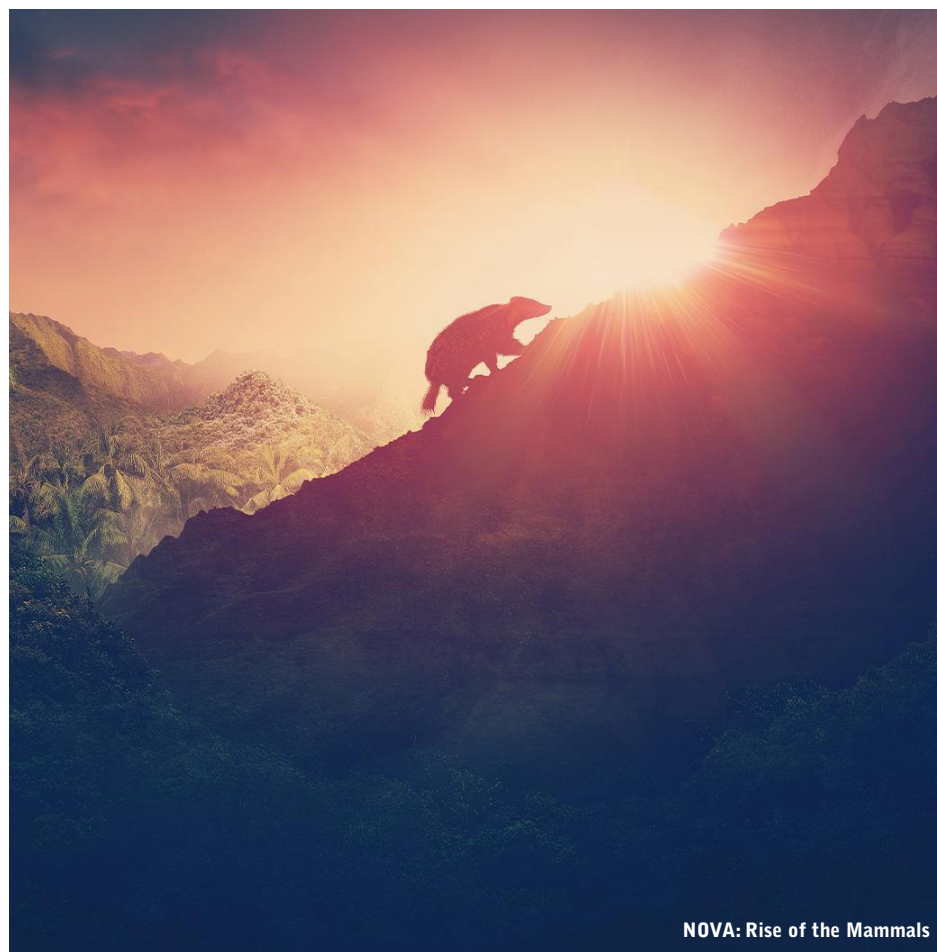

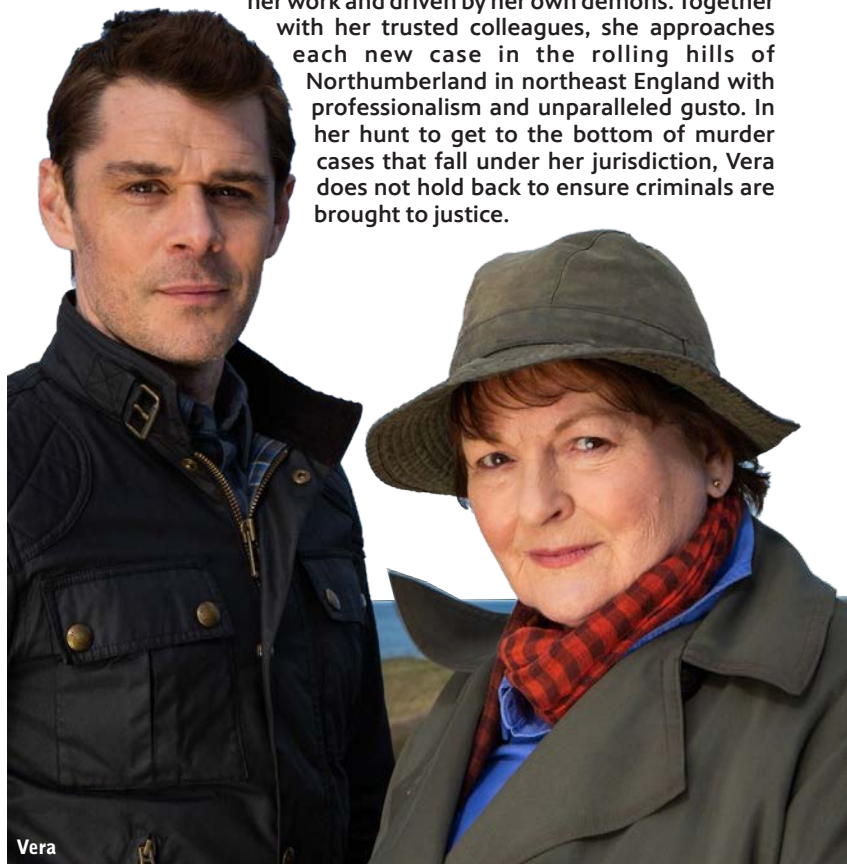

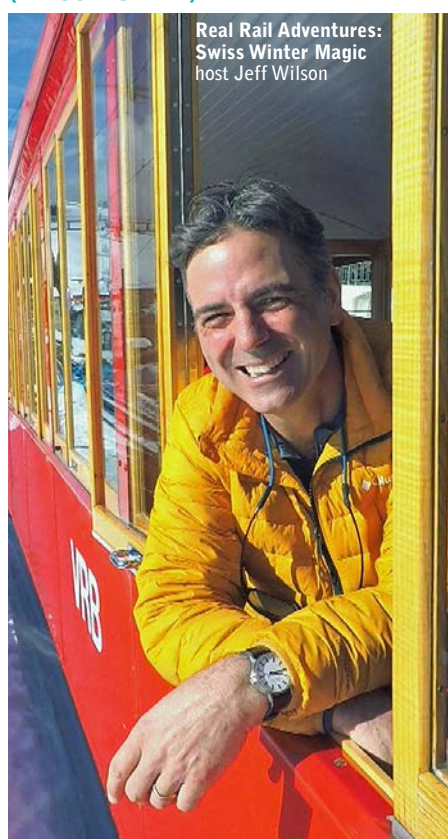
