The Excitement of a New Year

I love lists! Like so many others, I enjoy reflecting on the year that has just come to a close and look forward with anticipation to the months ahead. This is prime list-making time!

We are broadcasters with much to offer "beyond the broadcast." In our mission to inform and engage with our community, we direct our efforts to four core areas of our business: Education, Workforce Training, Technology, and Original Content.

In 2022 we will continue to host educational workshops for children, parents, care providers and teachers; our Special Needs Library will continue to lend hard-to-find resources to teachers, families, and those serving individuals with special needs; and there will be new episodes of **Vegas PBS STEAM Camp**, our locally produced program that tackles the tricky science, technology, engineering, arts, and math questions that challenge many a parent.

We are expanding our commitment to Workforce Education and I am very proud of a new collaboration with the Clark County School District and the Juvenile Justice System to pilot a program bringing job readiness to incarcerated youth. We are piloting a second program in collaboration with the Nevada Welfare Department to connect dislocated workers and new job seekers to earn industry-recognized credentials that help put them on a path to employment. We will also continue to support a wide variety of career training programs, including OSHA and other compliance certifications. Our Lifelong Learning courses offer a broad selection in areas such as health, wellness and design, and I encourage you consider enrolling at **vegaspbs.org/lifelonglearning**.

Our technology center will upgrade our Master Control System this year, and we are raising funds to transition our current broadcast equipment to the new ATSC 3.0 protocol. I will share more about this in a future column, but one immediate result will be a broader reach into our service area, particularly into the remote rural communities.



We are committed to local programming and will extend the coverage on **Nevada Week** with more reporting from the field. As of this writing, I am also cautiously optimistic that we will have the funding to bring **Outdoor Nevada** back for two more

seasons! In addition to those two important programs, we have a number of concepts we are excited to pilot and test.

As for broadcast, this month offers something for everyone. Whether you are kicking off the year with a renewed commitment to fitness or are ready to settle in with compelling new dramas, I think you will find that we have you covered. In addition, you'll find programming from acclaimed scholar Henry Louis Gates, Jr., that celebrates our history and diversity around Martin Luther King Jr. Day and programming that honors International Holocaust Remembrance Day.

We have a lot to accomplish in the coming year. I have a lot of lists on my desk and it gives me tremendous energy. I am grateful for the talented and collaborative team at Vegas PBS, and am extremely grateful that my husband and I have found this strong and vibrant community, filled with a positive outlook and welcoming spirit. It is through your sustained investments that we will continue to educate, inspire and uplift our great community. I will keep you updated on these initiatives in this column and, meanwhile, I thank you for your ongoing support.

HOLOCAUST REMEMBRANCE DAY



Sunday, January 30

Remembering the Holocaust: Las Vegas Survivors **Tell Their Stories** at 10 a.m.

Between 1945 and 1952, more than 80,000 Holocaust survivors immigrated to the United States. Nearly 350 survivors live in the Las Vegas area. Though they survived the Holocaust, most have not escaped the pain. These are the recollections of Las Vegans who wanted to share their stories.



Harbor from the Holocaust at 11 a.m.

In a Holocaust story of hope, 20,000 Jews find refuge in Shanghai during World War II. The film explores the relationship of the refugees and their host city, and the survivors who carried on the traditions that would have been consigned to oblivion.

Escape from Treblinka: The Joseph Polonski Story **Debuts on International Holocaust Remembrance Day, Thursday,** January 27 at 7:30 p.m.

This movie chronicles the life of Joseph Polonski from a young child in Silvaki, Poland, to the Jewish Ghetto and ultimately to Treblinka, the most rigorous death camp created under the Nazi regime. Keen intellect and some luck allowed Joseph to escape from Treblinka (one of only two known escapees) after which he served as an officer in the resistance, fighting Nazis until the liberation. After being placed in a DP (displaced persons) camp, Joseph learned electronics in a German ORT School and immigrated to the United States in 1949. With only the shirt on his back and \$10 given to him from a distant relative, Joseph built a thriving business and a loving family. This story is a true testament to determination, true grit and the life of Freedom he found in America.
