MESSAGE FROM OUR PRESIDENT


A New Era of Local Public Affairs Begins




Kenny Rogers Farewell Concert Celebration: All In For The Gambler Saturday, February 26 at 6:30 p.m.







This historical documentary examines the experience of African American diplomats serving during the Cold War. At the height of the civil rights movement in the U.S., these men represented the best of American ideals abroad while facing discrimination at home. Colloquially referred to as "male, pale and Yale," the State Department fiercely maintained and cultivated the Foreign Service's elite character and was one of the last federal agencies to truly desegregate.
