The Rolling Stones: A Bigger Bang - Live On Copacabana Beach

Saturday, March 12 at 9:30 p.m.

On February 18th, 2006, The Rolling Stones performed from Copacabana Beach in Rio de Janeiro. With an audience of 1.5 million people, it was one of the biggest free concerts ever and a critical moment in Rock and Roll history. While Mick Jagger, Keith Richards, Ronnie Wood and the late Charlie Watts fired on all pistons from one track to the next, the crowd met their energy, waving Brazilian and British flags while rocking out in the tropical evening sunset.
