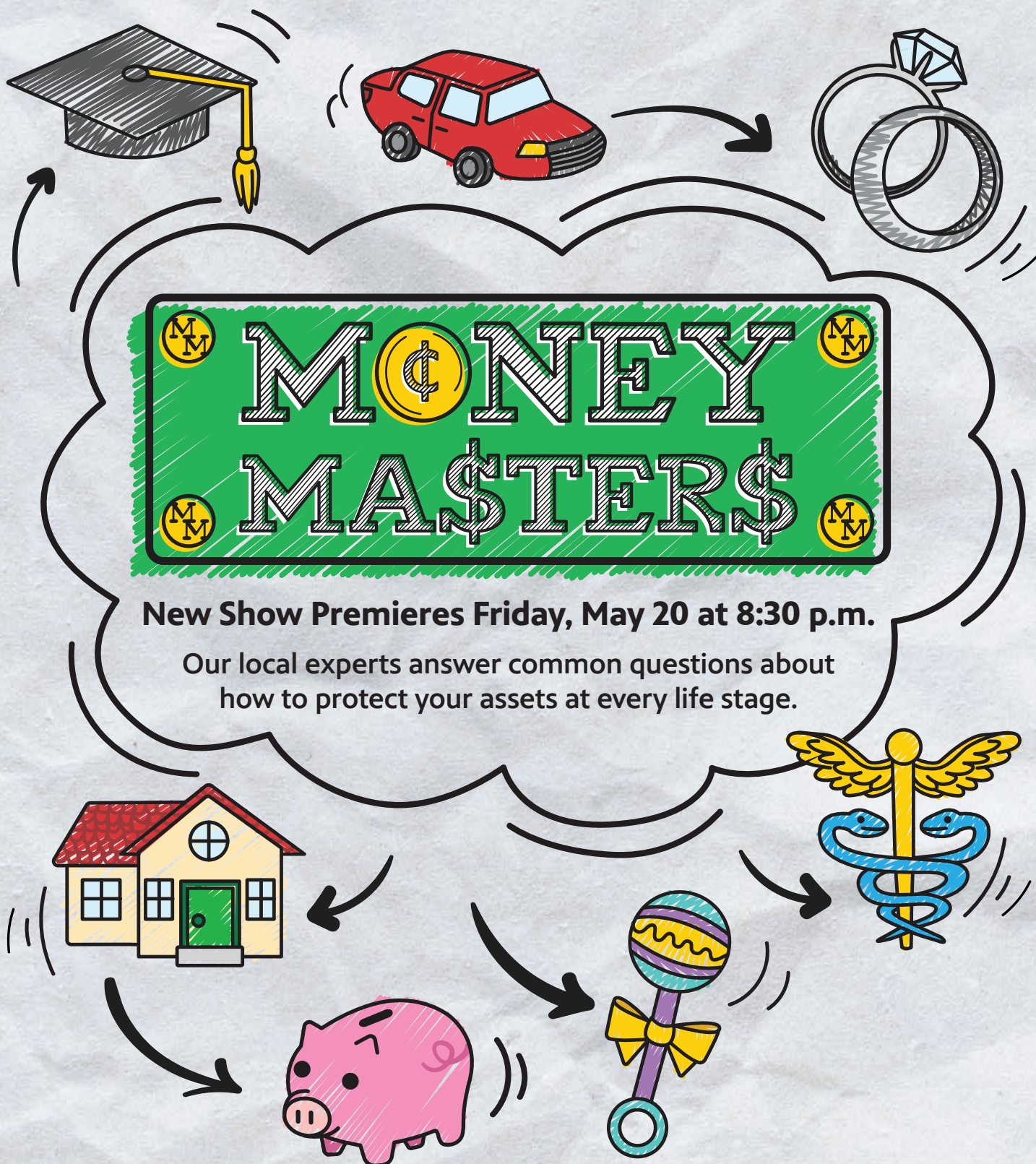

I have wanted to have WORLD included in our over-the-air service since starting at Vegas PBS, and I am very pleased to bring that goal to fruition. Expanding the WORLD reach provided an opportunity to review our manpower and resource allocations and as of May 31 we will sunset our two reprise channels **Rewind** and **Jackpot!**.

Among our remarkable new programs and specials this month, we also celebrate Asian American and Pacific Islander (AAPI) Heritage Month. Currently available to our viewers on **Cox Cable 114**, WORLD will present more than 50 films to celebrate AAPI Heritage in May, including **America ReFramed: Chinatown Rising** and **Local, USA: A Tale of Three Chinatowns**. Our AAPI Heritage programming on **10.1** includes **American Masters: Tyrus Wong** and **American Masters: Waterman Duke: Ambassador of Aloha**. Turn to page 15 to see more titles.

Spring is certainly putting a new skip on our step. It gives me great joy to share the energy and excitement at the station with you, our loyal members and supporters. Thank you for your continued commitment to our mission and allowing us to share the stories of our local community with the world.
