Fall is a special time of year, isn't it? Classes have resumed, temperatures are beginning to drop and at Vegas PBS we are getting ready to roll out some of our best events and programming.

First, I'd like to begin by announcing an exciting collaboration with Nevada Public Radio to host a series of political debates. **Nevada Decides** will cover the issues that will play a critical role in our state's midterm elections and will be simulcast on 88.9 KNPR and Vegas PBS 10.1. On a national level, **PBS NewsHour** will bring you regular updates on the races for seats in the Senate and House. As we approach Election Day, be sure to check vegaspbs.org for the latest updates.

Daniel Tiger Be My Neighbor Day returns once again to the Lawn at Downtown Summerlin on **Saturday, September 24** from **10 a.m. to 2 p.m.** This free, fun-filled day allows attendees to engage in acts of kindness and take part in family-friendly activities. PBS KIDS' beloved characters Daniel Tiger and Katerina Kittycat will be on stage for guest appearances throughout the day. Visit vegaspbs.org/bemyneighbor for more information. See you there!

In order to bring you more of your favorite shows, there will be a small adjustment to our daytime schedule. Starting **Monday, September 5**, the weekday children's lineup on 10.1 will end at 1 p.m. and general audience programming will move up to take its place. The VEGAS PBS KIDS 10.3 schedule will continue to offer the same, great 24/7 PBS KIDS lineup, and activities will still be available on-demand with the PBS KIDS Video and PBS KIDS Games apps.

With more of us working remotely after the pandemic, many have taken this as an opportunity for home improvement. Some have even gone so far as to buy unique but dilapidated homes and bring them back to their former glory. That's exactly what Dick Strawbridge and his partner Angel Adoree did on **Escape to the Chateau**. Starting on **Friday, September 9 at 11 p.m.**, watch as the U.K. couple renovate a 45-room chateau in northern France that has no electricity, water or proper plumbing. We are getting a head start on **Friday, September 2, at 9 p.m., Raúl Julia: The World's A Stage: American Masters** explores the life and career of the beloved actor from Shakespearean plays to "The Addams Family." On **Wednesday, September 21 at 11 p.m., La Frontera with Pati Jinich** follows the James Beard Award-winning chef to the U.S.-Mexico border where she experiences the region's rich cuisine. Starting **Thursday, September 22 at 3:30 p.m., Wonders of Mexico** explores the amazing wildlife and culture of Mexico from the Yucatan to the deserts in Sonora. Be sure to tune in on **Friday, September 30 at 9 p.m.** for the **35th Hispanic Heritage Awards**, followed by **Great Performances: Roots of Latin Jazz at 10 p.m.**

This month also sees the release of the latest project from famed documentarian Ken Burns, **The U.S. and the Holocaust**. Produced by Burns, Lynn Novick & Sarah Botstein, this program examines the rise of Hitler and Nazism in Germany in the context of global antisemitism and racism, the eugenics movement in the United States and race laws in the American south. The series sheds light on what the U.S. government and American people knew and did as the catastrophe unfolded in Europe. The three-part series begins on **Sunday, September 18 at 8 p.m.**

Harbor from the Holocaust Monday, September 5 at 10 p.m.

In a Holocaust story of hope, 20,000 Jews find refuge in Shanghai during World War II. The film explores the relationship of the refugees and their host city, and the survivors who carried on the traditions that would have been consigned to oblivion.

Sunday, September 25 at 8:30 a.m.

Between 1945 and 1952, more than 80,000 Holocaust survivors immigrated to the United States. Nearly 350 survivors live in the Las Vegas area. Though they survived the Holocaust, most have not escaped the pain. These are the recollections of Las Vegas who wanted to share their stories.



Escape from Treblinka:
The Joseph Polonski Story

Escape from Treblinka: The Joseph Polonski Story Sunday, September 25 at 9:30 a.m.

This movie chronicles the life of Joseph Polonski from a young child in Silvaki, Poland, to the Jewish Ghetto and ultimately to Treblinka, the most rigorous death camp created under the Nazi regime. Keen intellect and some luck allowed Joseph to escape from Treblinka (one of only two known escapees) after which he served as an officer in the resistance, fighting Nazis until the liberation. After being placed in a DP (displaced persons) camp, Joseph learned electronics in a German ORT School and immigrated to the United States in 1949. With only the shirt on his back and \$10 given to him from a distant relative, Joseph built a thriving business and a loving family. This story is a true testament to determination, true grit and the life of Freedom he found in America.
