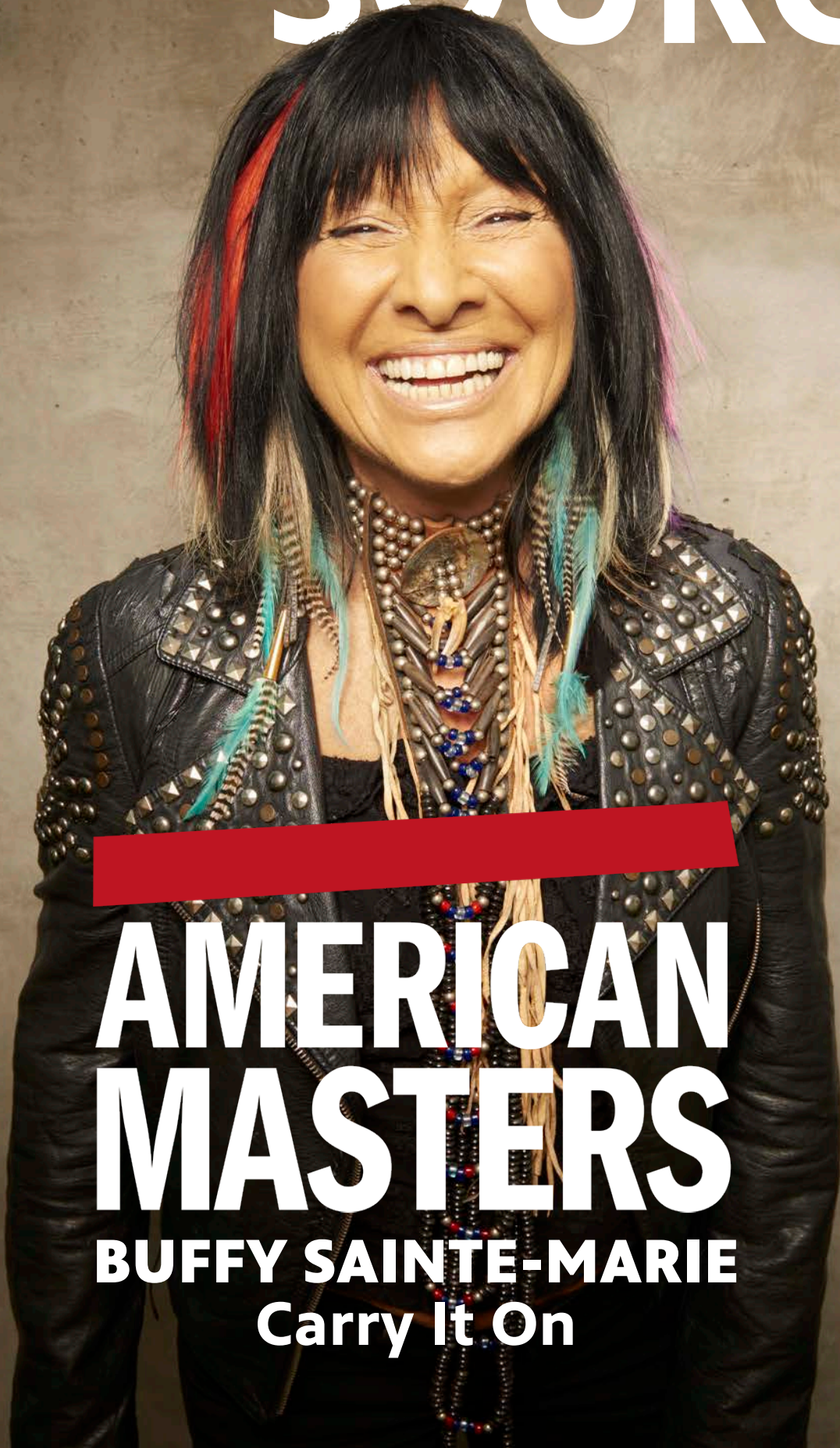

MESSAGE FROM OUR PRESIDENT & GENERAL MANAGER

Commemoration and Preservation

While July is the month filled with fervent celebration of American history, November compels us to think about our civic duties and the sacrifice many have made through their service in the armed forces. We also take this time of year to honor and celebrate the perseverance of Native culture. These are all topics that reveal greater complexities every time they arise. As such, we've done our best to provide programming that meets the standards that the subject matter merits.

Election Day is on Tuesday, November 8. If you haven't cast your vote already, Vegas PBS is here to provide you with reliable and relevant information about the election. Last month we hosted **Nevada Decides**, a live debate in cooperation with Nevada Public Radio featuring Nevada's 4th Congressional District Representative Steven Horsford and challenger Sam Peters. We also conducted a Candidate Conversation with Congresswoman Dina Titus. You can stream these episodes on our website at vegaspbs.org/election. On Election Day, **PBS NewsHour** will provide live coverage of the results beginning at 5 p.m.

We'll be observing Veterans Day through Stories of Service, programs that honor those who have answered the call of duty. On **Tuesday, November 8 at 9 p.m.**, tune in for **Remembering Vietnam: Las Vegas Veterans** and **The Greatest Generation Goes to War: Las Vegas' Memories of WWII** right after at 9:30 p.m. These locally produced documentaries remind us that those who risked their lives during pivotal moments in history reside among us as our neighbors and fellow citizens. Other programs of note include **Elvis and the USS Arizona** on **Sunday, November 6 at 3 p.m.**; **Remember Pearl Harbor** on **Sunday, November 6 at 4 p.m.**; **USO - For the Troops** on **Friday, November 11 at 9 p.m.**; and **Walk with Frank** on **Friday, November 11 at 10 p.m.**

An all-new **American Experience** special premieres on **Monday, November 14 at 9 p.m.** A tale that unfolds like a political thriller, **Taken Hostage** recounts the harrowing 444 days when 52 American diplomats, Marines and citizens were held hostage at the U.S. embassy in Tehran. This two-part special shows how the Iran hostage crisis forever changed American relations in the Middle East, as a steady ally suddenly became an enemy.

Longtime PBS watchers will likely recognize the woman gracing the cover of this edition of **Source**. Buffy Sainte-Marie made her first appearance on **Sesame Street** in 1976 and became a regular cast member through 1981. Sainte-Marie wanted to teach children that Indigenous people weren't props of a bygone era, but a diverse group of people still living in this country. **Buffy Sainte-Marie: Carry It On: American Masters**, airing on **Tuesday, November 22 at 9 p.m.**, is just one of many programs we have scheduled during Native American Heritage Month. Other shows include **The Horse Relative** on **Thursday, November 10 at 4:30 p.m.**, **N. Scott Momaday: American Masters**, on **Sunday, November 13 at noon** and **Groundworks** on **Sunday, November 13 at 11 p.m.** See more titles on page 6.

NOVA: Nazca Desert Mystery **Wednesday, November 2 at 9 p.m.**

One of the world's greatest ancient enigmas, the Nazca lines are a dense network of criss-crossing lines, geometric shapes, and animal figures etched across 200 square miles of Peruvian desert. Who created them and why? Ever since they were rediscovered in the 1920s, scholars and enthusiasts have raised countless theories about their purpose.

The Lost Salmon **Thursday, November 10 at 3:30 p.m.**

This documentary, which includes wondrous scenes, focuses on the disappearance of salmon on the Pacific Coast and steps that can be taken to keep the species alive. During the journey, we learn about Native American culture, the history of habitat destruction and new scientific breakthroughs.

The Horse Relative **Thursday, November 10 at 4:30 p.m.**

Follow the difficult path Native people and their horse relatives traversed as foreigners settled the surrounding lands, and learn how the Dakota people of Minnesota are working to keep their cultural identity thriving.

N. Scott Momaday: Words from a Bear: American Masters **Sunday, November 13 at 12 p.m.**

Delve into the enigmatic life and mind of the Pulitzer Prize-winning author and poet N. Scott Momaday, best known for "House Made of Dawn" and a formative voice of the Native American Renaissance in art and literature.

Groundworks **Sunday, November 13 at 11 p.m.**

Meet four California Native co-creators of the Groundworks project — an immersive, yearlong media collaboration that culminated with a performance on Alcatraz Island on San Francisco's first official Indigenous Peoples' Day in October 2018. While weaving together these artists' stories, we also explore land management issues, water rights and food security.

Discover the cosmological secrets behind America's ancient cities. Scientists explore some of the world's largest pyramids and 3D scan a lost city of monumental mounds; Native elders reveal ancient powers of the sky.

Resistance, survival and revival are revealed through an empire of horse-mounted Comanche warriors, secret messages encoded in an Aztec manuscript and a grass bridge.
