For Black History Month, we have an exciting variety of series, documentaries and more lined up that celebrate the accomplishments of Black communities and icons in America. Developed by



Public Enemy frontman Chuck D, **Fight The Power: How Hip Hop Changed The World** recounts the origins of this bold and revolutionary art form through the voices of those who were there at the beginning, creating an anthology of how hip hop became a cultural phenomenon against the backdrop of American history: airing **Tuesdays at 9 p.m.** Stick around after the premiere on **January 31** for **African Americans: The Las Vegas Experience** at 10 p.m. This Vegas PBS original recounts what life was like for Black Las Vegans during the Civil Rights Era and how the social movements of the time period fueled change in our city.

Fridays this month feature **Making Black America: Through the Grapevine**, a miniseries led by Henry Louis Gates, Jr., about the vast social networks and organizations created by and for Black people beyond the reach of the "White gaze." Airs **February 3 and 10 at 9 p.m.** On **February 24 at 9 p.m.**, tune in to **Great Performances: The Magic of Spirituals** to discover the behind-the-scenes story of Jessye Norman and Kathleen Battle's famed concert at Carnegie Hall on March 18, 1990. Many wondered if the two singers would compete or join forces and sing together. Stick around after for **Marian Anderson: Once in a Hundred Years at 10:30 p.m.**, the inspiring life story of the African American contralto who performed in front of an audience of 75,000 at the Lincoln Memorial after being denied permission to perform at a racially segregated venue.

We'll also have an interview with the new mayor of North Las Vegas, Pamela Goynes-Brown, on **Nevada Week In Person** on **Saturday, February 18 at 6:30 p.m.** Goynes-Brown is the first Black mayor of North Las Vegas and currently the only Black mayor in all of Nevada.

Sunday, February 12 has an entire block from 10:30 a.m. to 5:30 p.m. of Black History Month programming, including Ida B. Wells: American Story; John Lewis: Get in the Way; In Their Own Words: Chuck Berry; Charley Pride: I'm Just Me: American Masters; Sammy Davis, Jr.: I've Gotta Be Me: American Masters; and Hollywood's Architect: The Paul R. Williams Story. That last one is of note as Vegas PBS is proud to be a Media Sponsor of the Nevada Museum of Art's exhibit of Paul Revere Williams' work. As a native Angeleno, I grew up with Williams' iconic designs across the city. When we moved here I was so excited to learn of his work across my new home town including the Guardian Angel Cathedral, La Concha Motel (which now serves as the lobby of the Neon Museum) and Berkley Square — Southern Nevada's first African American suburban community. Check out Dogs in the Wild, A Nature Miniseries, Wednesdays at 8 p.m. beginning February 8. This series travels the globe in search of the untamed species of canine that survive through cunning and tenacity. All-new NOVA episodes on Wednesdays at 9 p.m. include London Super Tunnel on February 1, Star Chasers of Senegal on February 8, Ancient Builders of The Amazon on February 15, and James Webb: Part II on February 22.



COVER FEATURE - BLACK HISTORY MONTH

Fight the Power: How Hip Hop Changed the World Premieres Tuesday, January 31! Tuesdays, February 7, 14 and 21 at 9 p.m.

This incredible narrative of struggle, triumph and resistance is brought to life through the lens of an art form that has chronicled the emotions. experiences and expressions of Black and Brown communities: hip hop. In the aftermath of America's racial and political reckoning in 2020, the perspectives and stories shared in hip hop are key to understanding injustice in the U.S. over the last half-century. Authored by Public Enemy's Chuck D, who famously labeled hip hop as "the Black CNN" for bringing the stories of the street to the mainstream, this story includes personal testimonies of the MCs, DJs, graffiti artists, filmmakers, politicians and opinion formers who created and shaped its direction as it grew from an underground movement in the Bronx to the most popular music genre in the U.S. and the fastest growing genre in the world today.















Making Black America: Through the Grapevine Two back-to-back episodes Fridays, February 3 and 10 at 9 p.m.

Despite the gains of legal desegregation, all-Black political and cultural movements, from Black Power to Black Twitter, provide a safe space for a community driven by class, sexuality and generational divisions to debate, organize and celebrate.

Independent Lens: Outta the Muck Sunday, February 12 at 11 p.m.

This is the story of a fiercely selfdetermined family in the deep south as it resists despair with love. It blends family, football and history in an intimate portrait of the Dean family, longtime residents of the historic town of Pahokee, Florida, and journeys back home with McKinley as he reconnects with his niece, Bridget, and nephew, Alvin, and explores their shared family history that spans seven generations.



Signing Black America Monday, February 20 at 11 p.m.

Discover the history and development of Black American Sign Language, a vibrant dialect that today conveys an identity and sense of belonging that mirrors spoken language varieties of the African American hearing community.

Great Performances: The Magic of Spirituals Friday, February 24 at 9 p.m.

Glimpse behind the curtain at opera legends Kathleen Battle and Jessye Norman's famed concert at Carnegie Hall on March 18, 1990, featuring performance clips and new interviews with opera star Angel Blue, Met Opera General Manager Peter Gelb and more.

Marían Anderson: Once in a **Hundred Years** Friday, February 24 at 10:30 p.m.

Marian Anderson, whose contralto singing voice dazzled international audiences, was a gifted African American woman who had to surmount innumerable, unwarranted obstacles before eventually achieving her dream.

Black Broadway: A Proud History. A Limitless Future Tuesday, February 28 at 10 p.m.

Join in to celebrate the legendary performances and roles made famous by Black artists as well as the new generation of Black Broadway stars. An accomplished cast performs classic songs from "The Wiz," "The Color Purple," "Company," "Porgy & Bess," "Ain't Misbehavin'" and more.






