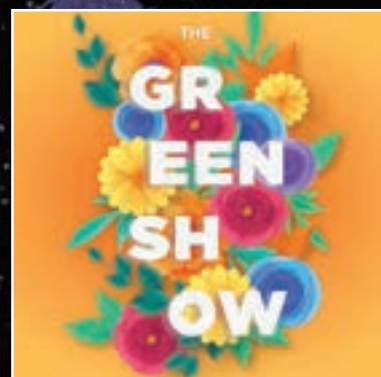

Vegas PBS is bringing you "The Summer of Mystery" — perhaps my favorite genre — and we're kicking off this month's schedule with a full slate of thrilling crime dramas and detective stories. **Endeavour on MASTERPIECE** returns for the last time on **Sunday, June 18 at 9 p.m.** Set in the early 70s, the final season finds Endeavour and Thursday entering a new era of change both professionally and personally. But if you're anxious to get back on the case, **Morse and the Last Endeavour: A MASTERPIECE Mystery Special** airs **Sunday, June 11 at 9 p.m.** This documentary gives a look behind the scenes of the **MASTERPIECE** show's production and the history of the original John Thaw series.

However, Ridley's return isn't welcomed by the entire force and the connection he sees between the murder and an old case brews turmoil.

Now available on **Vegas PBS Passport**, check out **D.I. Ray**. Rachita Ray, a British Asian policewoman new to homicide, is assigned to investigate the suspected honor killing of a young Muslim man. Produced by Jed Mercurio of "Line of Duty" fame and starring Parminder Nagra, watch the show The Guardian called a "fresh twist on the police drama." The film offers a glimpse into the struggles and triumphs of this community, showcasing their resilience, strength and activism. Right after at **10 p.m.**, **Independent Lens: Mama Bears** is a heartwarming and empowering documentary that follows a group of mothers who are fierce advocates for their LGBTQ children. The film captures their journeys, their struggles and their victories, showcasing the power of parental love and acceptance.
