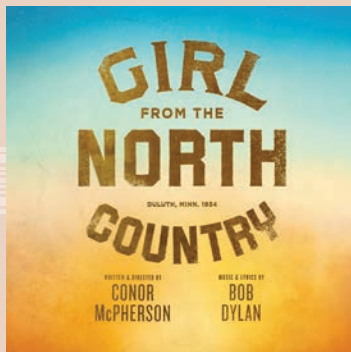

Warm Welcome

In the 1970s, WPBT, a PBS member station in Florida, launched **¿Qué Pasa, USA?** (Spanish for "What's Happening, USA?"), a bilingual sitcom that told the story of a Cuban-American family adjusting to life in Miami. It was a springboard for young actors like Steven Bauer and Andy Garcia, and the use of code-switching made it a first of its kind on American television. In 2002, when I was Chief Content Officer at KCET in Los Angeles, we brought **American Family** to PBS stations across the country. Breaking ground again, **American Family** was the first drama series featuring a Latino cast to ever air on broadcast television.

While sitcoms and contemporary scripted dramas may not be the first things you think of when thinking about PBS programs, the underlying ethos is in perfect alignment with the mission and goal of public broadcasting: to reflect, represent and serve all members of the public. The Hispanic population in Clark County has climbed from single digits in the midcentury to now about 34%. The first non-Native American on record to explore the Las Vegas Valley was Mexican scout Rafael Rivera, who has a street named after him in the southwestern portion of Las Vegas. “Las Vegas” itself is a phrase borrowed from the Spanish language.

Bienvenidos a Las Vegas (Welcome to Las Vegas), the newest Vegas PBS Original, is a powerful and engaging documentary exploring the history of Hispanic and Latino communities in Southern Nevada, be they entrepreneurs, entertainers or activists. This program commemorates the stories of Hispanic and Latino Las Vegans and their incredible tales of persistence and ingenuity. We specialize in connecting communities with each other and this is one more way we can celebrate our neighbors' histories.

I can't talk about **Bienvenidos a Las Vegas** without also giving kudos and recognition to host and producer, Maria Silva. A lifelong Las Vegan, Silva has had a consistent newsbeat on the development and evolution of Vegas. That experience, combined with her unbridled enthusiasm, brings a specialized expertise that you frankly won't find anywhere else.

Tune in on **Tuesday, April 23 at 9 p.m.** to watch **Bienvenidos a Las Vegas**, find it online at vegaspbs.org/shows, or stream it on the PBS App.

Vegas All In also continues this month, featuring the people who make Las Vegas a world-renowned city. One of my favorite segments on the show so far features UNLV history professor Michael Green delivering a fascinating biography of the Sahara casino. I'd also like to thank everyone who came out to **The Big Party!** It was a wonderful evening celebrating the power of public media to make a difference in the world.
