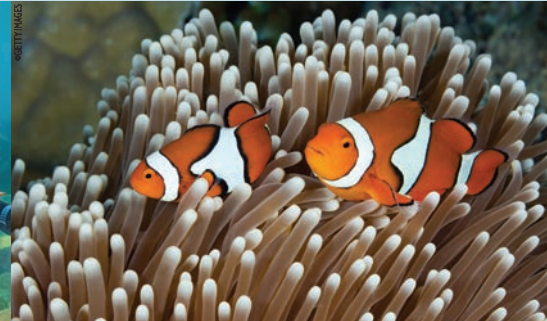

Great Migrations, hosted by Henry Louis Gates, Jr., explores the vast journeys of African Americans who left the South in pursuit of opportunity, freedom and dignity. Gates' storytelling guides us across the country and decades. Through powerful personal stories and historical context, this documentary asks: Is there even such a thing as a promised land?

Forgotten Hero: Walter White and the NAACP: American Experience dives into the creation and legacy of one of the most influential civil rights organizations in American history. Walter White, who led the NAACP for 25 years, clung to the belief that the United States held the seeds of its own redemption. The NAACP and its leading advocates created a blueprint for America to follow to live up to its ideals.

The Disappearance of Miss Scott: American Masters sheds light on the life of Hazel Scott, a trailblazing jazz musician, actress, and activist who broke barriers in Hollywood and the music industry. But a disastrous appearance before the House Un-American Activities Committee caused her career to falter. How could someone who made such an impact vanish from American pop culture?

Each of these programs is a window into history, a celebration of Black culture, and a reminder of the ongoing journey toward equality. This February, we invite you to explore these remarkable stories with us and reflect on the powerful legacies they represent.
