

Nashville Metropolitan Action Commission's P.O.W.E.R. Youth Program

Nashville PBS hosted its first P.O.W.E.R. Youth student interns this summer who provided over 275 hours of support to our staff and community. The program's theme, P.O.W.E.R. (Providing Opportunities for Wealth-building and Economic Resilience for youth and young adults) was created by a peer youth leadership team based on how they view themselves and their futures. Students placed at Nashville PBS learned about public television, nonprofit operations, and developed professional workplace skills all while earning an income over the summer months.





The Cavern Sessions, Season 3


Premieres Sat, Sept 14 at 6:30pm

Viewers will be transported to Botswana's wild Okavango Delta where a team of international and local filmmakers use the latest filming technology to follow lions, leopards and cheetahs day and night, revealing the lives of big cats like never before. Filmed in one of the most dynamic locations on the African continent, the show captures the big cats' battle to survive through dramatic changes within their families and their home. An elite camera team documents the lives of individual lions, cheetahs and leopards for six months, over two extreme seasons.



The American Vice President

Tues, Oct 1at 8pm

Despite the assassinations of four U.S. presidents (Lincoln, Garfield, McKinley, Kennedy), the in-office deaths of four (Harrison, Taylor, Harding, FDR), the wounding of two (T. Roosevelt, Reagan) and attempts on the lives of several others, before 1963, the unthinkable was unaddressed in the U.S. Constitution. For the first two hundred years of America's democracy, it was not a foregone conclusion that the vice president would step in to replace the president in times of crisis. The office itself has been an afterthought, a punchline, and an Achilles heel for the president. But vice presidents of the United States have also acted as stabilizers, tiebreakers and architects of critical policy despite the office being described by one disgruntled VP as "not worth a bucket of warm spit." So what happens when the President of the United States can't fulfill their duties due to death, illness or incapacity?




NOVA: The Solar System



SPOTLIGHT - MIKE SHEA

Mike Shea, a Nashville native, is a Project Manager and Sales Representative at Joslin and Son Signs, a company renowned for designing, manufacturing, and installing custom signs that have shaped the landscape of Nashville. He has been guiding Nashville PBS through the process of designing and installing our new marquee building sign, ensuring it honors our legacy while embracing the future and providing a strong visual footprint that connects the old with the new.



On growing up in Nashville:

"I was born and raised in West Meade, Nashville, behind the Belle Meade Methodist Church. I come from a large Catholic family—I was the only boy with six sisters. Growing up in that neighborhood was incredible. It was a time before cell phones, where we rode bikes, played kick the can with about 20 kids on weekends, and had a mix of friends from both public and private schools."

On his parents' impact on the Nashville community:

"My mother, Iris Imogene Cooper Shea, was an extraordinary nurse. She worked at Clover Bottom Hospital, where she became the director and was highly respected for her expertise in caring for patients with mental disabilities. My father, Edward Joseph Shea, was the Executive Vice President of the Nashville Chamber of Commerce during the 1960s, a pivotal time for the city. He was involved in major decisions that shaped Nashville, including efforts to promote civil rights and end segregation. He also played a key role in getting liquor-by-the-drink laws passed, which was crucial for the city's economic growth."

On his connection to Nashville PBS:

"For the Love of Nashville" is about celebrating and preserving the unique character of our city. My work in signage is a part of that—helping to shape the visual identity of Nashville while respecting its history.

Growing up, WDCN / Channel 8 (now Nashville PBS) was a big part of my life. I remember watching it when I was home sick as a kid, but what really stands out is how it connected me with my father. Despite coming from different worlds—his being more intellectual and mine more athletic—shows like Monty Python brought us together. We would sit and laugh together, finding common ground through the humor."

On his hopes for Nashville PBS:

"My hope is that Nashville PBS continues to be a bridge between the past and the future of Nashville. As the city evolves, it's important to keep telling the stories that make Nashville unique—stories about our neighborhoods, our history, and our people."

In Closing:

"It's been a pleasure to share my story, and I'm proud to be a part of Nashville's growth and history. And of course, I couldn't do it without the support of my wonderful wife, Angela, and our children—our daughter Lucy, and our sons Cooper, Grady, Leon, and Young. They keep me grounded and are my biggest cheerleaders. And of course, I have to give a shoutout to my team at Joslin and Son Signs, who have been with me every step of the way."
